SKETCHY was closest in pursuit from the two path, pressed briefly then stalked once again up the backstretch, challenged nearing the seven-sixteenths pole, put a head in front dueling on the far turn, kicked clear in upper stretch and held well over the runner-up. LOUIS THE CHAMP stalked along the rail, got boxed in on the far turn behind the leader, angled out at the top of the lane, chased determinedly after the winner down the stretch but had to settle for second best. MALIBU ROCKS sent to the front and moved inside, showed the way up the backstretch, dueled around the far turn, yielded to the winner in upper stretch, weakened in the furlong grounds but kept on for a clear third. AMERICAN GLORY (GB) stalked the speed from the two path, raced between rivals leaving the backstretch, drew alongside the top pair three deep into the far turn, moved back to the two path around the bend and weakened down the lane and lost the crop in the final fifty yards. EXCEL CALCULATOR lagged behind early and moved inside, remained well back to the quarter pole, cut the backstretch, could not sustain the bid around the far turn, followed outside rivals into the lane and flattened out.

MAXIMUN GOLD chased the top pair from inside, moved up to challenge at the half-mile pole, took over around the bend, showed the way with a pair of rivals to the outside coming into the stretch, drifted out a bit late and held gamely. NIKOLINA dueled from outside then vied three deep to the turn, lost touch with MAXIMUN GOLD briefly midway around the bend, re-bid three deep with a quarter mile remaining, fought three deep down the lane, brushed with DONTELLOURWIVES late and finished a game second. DONTTELLOURWIVES raced up close, traveled two into the turn, moved inside then between rivals at the quarter pole, fought between runners down the stretch, had the rider lose the crop past the sixteenth pole, then got bumped and put in tight approaching the wire. APPROVAL RATING came away well but became rank early and dropped back off the pace, trailed two wide through the turn and passed tired rivals. SEXZIE dueled inside a rival off the rail then between foes past the half-mile pole, could not keep up with the new leader midway around the bend, chased four into the lane and faded. ICONS ONLY showed early speed from outside then stalked the top trio up the backstretch, went four wide around the bend and weakened. THERE WAS A STEWARDS' INQUIRY INVOLVING THE STRETCH RUN. FOLLOWING A REVIEW, THE STEWARDS RULED IN A MAJORITY DECISION THAT ALTHOUGH MAXIMUN GOLD DID DRIFT OUT AND PUT DONTTELLOURWIVES IN TIGHT QUARTERS LATE, THE INCIDENT DID NOT WARRANT A DISQUALIFICATION.

HAPPYASACLAM (IRE) bumped with inner rival at the start, stalked three then two wide around the first turn, followed the top pair outside a rival up the backstretch, rounded the second bend two then three wide, challenged from outside into the lane, took over shortly after and held gamely to the wire. DOUBLE CAPPUCCINO raced up close in the two path, pressed from outside up the backstretch, dueled around the far turn and put a head in front at the guarter pole, lost command in upper stretch but continued to fight back from inside and stayed on to the wire. G'ORO bumped leaving the gate, settled inside, raced in range while angling out at the quarter pole, launched a bid in upper stretch, fought three deep into the final sixteenth and got outgamed by the top pair. NAKOTA (IRE) traveled along the rail towards the rear early on, stayed on the fence through the far turn, tipped out at the top of the lane, kept on trying through the final furlong but lacked the needed final kick. CATHOLIC CAT raced two wide near the back of the pack, made progress around the far turn before getting floated out at the quarter pole, chased within striking distance down the lane but finished evenly late. BIG LEAP stalked from inside to the far turn, chased two wide past the five-sixteenths marker, was ridden along into the lane and weakened. BOUGIE LIKE set the pace from inside, took pressure up the backstretch, lost command dueling on the far turn, yielded at the top of the lane, got put in tight at the eighth pole and faded. HOLLY GOQUICKLY (FR) trailed from the rail position around the first turn, went two wide into the second bend, got floated out at the quarter pole, bobbled shortly after and had the rider lose his right iron, Hernandez regained his footing in upper stretch, was eased in the final furlong and walked off. THERE WAS A STEWARDS' INQUIRY INVOLVING THE INCIDENT BETWEEN GORO, CATHOLIC CAT AND HOLLY GOQUICKLY (FR) LATE ON THE TURN. FOLLOWING A REVIEW, THE STEWARDS RULED THAT NO ACTION WOULD BE TAKEN.

WOODBINE WAY vied between rivals to the turn, emerged clear at the five-sixteenths pole, showed the way into the final furlong and held safely under right handed urging and steady handling. TESSA (GB) raced in range out wide, drew closer three deep into the turn, bid four wide on the turn, chased two wide into the lane, finished determinedly through the final furlong but could not reach the winner. ROSES R BLUE broke a step slow, advanced four wide around the turn, closed well through the lane but could not get to the top pair. I'M A RISQUE GIRL stalked between then outside a rival leaving the backstretch, went between foes at the five-sixteenths pole, chased along the rail turning for home, angled off the fence in upper stretch and could not produce a late bid. ROMAN EMPRESS popped the stall doors open but did not leave the gate, climbed early and dropped back, altered seven wide past the three-eighths pole,



went five wide into the lane and improved position. SPREAD THE RISK climbed early under coaxing, angled in on the turn, tipped three wide around the bend and failed to menace. AMANDA ROSE got squeezed between rivals early, chased two wide into the turn, dropped back and moved out around the bend, came four wide into the stretch and had little left for the drive. ASSEMBLED STORM away quickest from the gate then vied three deep up the backstretch, could not kick on with the leader at the five-sixteenths pole, chased three then two wide to the stretch and tird. YACOWLEF (IRE) tracked from inside out of range, drew closer on the far turn, tipped out and came three wide into the lane, bid three deep in upper stretch, put a head in front and maintained a short lead over KERRY GOLD to the wire. KERRY GOLD was closest in pursuit through both turns, bid between rivals in upper stretch, fought with inside the winner through the final furlong but could not summon the needed late kick. HURRICANE CLOUD (GB) sat off the pace in the two path outside the winner on the first turn, drew closer while angling out on the far turn, spun four wide into the lane, finished well in the stretch run and but could not get by the top pair. BIZZEE CHANNEL traveled in the two path well off the pace, remained two wide through the far turn and showed a mild response to earn a minor award. MACKINNON raced three deep near the back into the first turn, asked two wide around the second bend, tipped out into the lane and improved position. BRAZENLY sat off the pace four then three wide early, moved into range widest in the middle stages, chased five, four, then three wide around the far turn, finished well down the lane but had to settle for second best. MONGOLIAN MAX unhurried in the beginning along the inside, trailed up the backstretch, advanced around the far turn, swung out leaving the bend and was along for the show honors. KAWAZAKI (IRE) tracked two wide out of range, moved into striking distance in the middle stages, bid three wide at the quarter pole, dueled outside OVER THE OCEAN down the stretch and dug in to best the runner-up. OVER THE OCEAN was closest in pursuit early on, applied pressure from outside midway up the backstretch, dueled and took over on the far turn, held a short lead over rivals on both sides approaching the stretch, dueled inside KAWAZAKI (IRE) down the lane and yielded grudgingly. NAISMITH broke a step slow, reserved on the inside early, went two wide into the far turn, made progress while angling out to the five path, kept on down the lane and gained third. BIG JUANITO traveled in mid-pack outside a rival, drew closer past the half-mile pole, chased two to three wide around the far turn, angled out into the stretch and failed to produce a bid. SMOOTH SALUTE trailed in the two path, passed a rival on the backstretch, angled five wide around the far turn and showed a mild response to improve. SIX MAGPIES (IRE) scrambled leaving the gate, angled to the inside racing towards the rear, ran into traffic from the five-sixteenths pole to the quarter pole, chased three deep into the lane and failed to rally. ANDREADYTORUMBLE off slow to begin, settled next to the fence, got shuffled back on the far turn, tipped two wide and chased between rivals exiting the bend and failed to menace down the lane.
