CERTITUDE (FR) chased keenly in hand near the inside then in the two path early, was closest in pursuit up the backstretch, latched onto the leader at the quarter pole, kicked clear in upper stretch and held safely in deep stretch. THE WHITE LADY (FR) trailed along the inside then two wide on the clubhouse turn, remained two wide into the far turn, went between runners midway around the bend, tipped out into the lane, chased after the leader in tandem with DEFIANCE in the final furlong, lacked the needed late kick to reach the winner but was able to edge DEFIANCE for second. DEFIANCE settled next to the fence, moved into range along the inside then two wide late on the far turn, tipped out in upper stretch, finished willingly inside THE WHITE LADY (FR) down the lane and got outkicked for second. SUPER ELLIE broke a hair slow, sat off the pace in the two path, chased two then three wide around the far turn and failed to rally. CORPOSO stumbled leaving the gate, sat off the pace on the inside, trailed leaving the far turn, steered out in midstretch and passed a tired rival. SOHO cleared from outside and steered across, controlled the pace up the backstretch, challenged by CERTITUDE (FR) at the quarter pole, relinquished the lead entering the lane and folded.

MISS PRACTICAL chased along the inside then paused briefly and altered out from behind a rival, gained three then four wide around the bend, closed in and drew alongside the leader at the sixteenth pole and drove past late. DARLIN TAMI dueled from inside, inched ahead on the turn, cleared at the top of the stretch, confronted by MISS PRACTICAL while drifting in a bit in deep stretch and could not fend off the winner. RIDE ELBOW RANCH brushed leaving the gate, stalked from inside, tipped out at the quarter pole and finished evenly down the lane. BRANDON'S GIRL brushed at the start, began to climb while chasing outside a rival and dropped back, trailed next to the fence through the turn and offered a mild response to earn a minor award. GRETA'S GHOST showed brief speed then chased outside a rival to the turn, navigated the bend in the two path, angled out into the lane and lacked a rally. TIMEKEEPER'S CHARM was off slow to begin, chased from off the pace, rounded the bend four then three wide, failed to threaten in the lane, bled following the race and walked off. KAPALUA RIDE dueled outside DARLIN TAMI up the backstretch an around the turn, yielded at the top the lane and weakened. SAV'S THIRSTY STAR forwardly placed outside rivals early, chased three wide around the turn then moved into the two path late on the bend and fade out of contention.

RUN FOR KIDDER tracked off the rail, chase two wide then along the inside on the turn, tipped out in upper stretch, drew alongside the leader past the eighth pole and dug in to overhaul the runner-up. BINGING took a bump from outer rival early, stalked two wide to the turn, challenged from outside approaching the five-sixteenths pole, seized control entering the lane, put away HOTHEAD In upper stretch, came under threat from RUN FOR KIDDER midstretch and got outkicked in the final sixteenth. DYNODAVE coaxed along early from off the pace, navigated the turn in the two path, moved out under left handed urging in the lane, switched to the right hand in the final furlong and finished willingly to gain third and whittle the gap on the top pair late. HOTHEAD dueled for the lead from outside then cleared at the half-mile pole, challenged by BINGING nearing the five-sixteenths pole, lost the lead entering the lane and flattened to fourth. HORNSBY bumped with CAPTAIN WILLIS shortly after the start, drifted in and bumped BINGING not too long after, went up to duel for the lead from inside, got put in tight by HOTHEAD and took hold approaching the half-mile pole, chased on the inside into the turn, dropped back around the bend and tired. CAPTAIN WILLIS got bumped leaving the gate, bothered by outer rival shortly after, trailed up the backstretch, raced along the rail then two wide on the turn and was never a factor.

FINAL STORM became fractious in the gate, trailed inside a rival early, went three wide into the turn, eased out to the five path around the bend, stormed to the front in upper stretch, held a short lead over DISOBEY into the last sixteenth and edged clear. DISOBEY pulled the rider along in the early going, angled to the inside, hugged the rail around the bend, put in a rail bid at the three-sixteenths pole, fought inside FINAL STORM into deep stretch and got outkicked. MICI'S EXPRESS raced outside a rival at the back early on, went four wide into the turn, exited the bend in the six path, challenged in upper stretch but flattened in the late stages. RUNKERRY set the pace under pressure up the backstretch, moved clear on the turn, challenged from both sides in upper stretch, offered little resistance and weakened in the late stages. HAVOC stalked off the rail or outside a rival, chased three then four wide on the turn, put in a mild bid between rivals in upper stretch but was no match in the furlong grounds. UNBRIDLED VISION chased in the two path into the turn, ran into traffic on the turn, raced a bit off the rail into the lane and flattened out. DEVIL BE ME pressed the pace from outside, chased two then three wide on the turn, tired in upper stretch, bled following the race and was transported off the track via equine ambulance.

WHATMAKESSAMMYRUN rated off the rail then outside rivals, tracked three deep through the turn, tipped out at the top of the lane, took over midstretch and inched ahead late. DONCIC stalked outside a rival then three deep into the turn, challenged three deep at the quarter pole, put a head in front in upper stretch but got outkicked by the winner in deep stretch. BOB'S BLUE MOON stalked the top pair early, had to take up behind a rival past the half-mile pole, bid between foes with a quarter mile remaining, battled into deep stretch but could not find the needed late kick. CAT THE CONFIDANTE (IRE) broke out, stalked in the two path, bid three deep at the five-sixteenths pole, duelled two wide late on that bend, took over in upper stretch, drifted in a bit in the furlong grounds, remained clear into the final sixteenth, came under threat from INNOVATIVE in the final moments but was able to hold on. INNOVATIVE stalked from the rail position, tipped two wide approaching the quarter pole, stayed within range into the final furlong, put in a late bid and missed in a narrow photo. CAILIN DANA tracked off the inside, three deep in the middle stages, ran into traffic on the far turn, rallied between rivals in the lane then angled out and finished well for the show honors. NAFISA pressed from outside early, stalked up the backstretch, drew alongside the leader again on the far turn, took over at the quarter pole, lost command in upper stretch and flattened to fourth. CHURCH LADY (IRE) broke a step slow, moved off the fence quickly, had to take up behind a rival around the first turn, waited along the fence through the second bend, moved out a bit in the lane and offered a mild rally. TIME TO SHINE settled inside, tipped two wide exiting the far turn, moved out further in the lane and lacked a rally. SUNSET BEAUTY settled outside a rival, between foes in the middle stages, chased two then three wide on the far turn, got bothered a bit by inner rival midstretch and could not rally. KITTY MARREN sat off the pace two, three, then four wide on the first turn, got crowded between rivals at the five-sixteenths

pole, trailed next to the fence into the lane and failed to menace. DON'T TEMPT HER reserved in the two path, drew closer outside rivals in the middle stages, traveled three then four wide on the far turn and had little left for the stretch run. LIL MISS BEHAVING showed the way early under pressure, cleared on the backstretch, took pressure on the far turn, lost command at the quarter pole, chased the top pair into the lane and folded.

BLISSTERINTHESUN raced up close outside a rival, chased three wide around the bend while falling out of range, churned on down the lane and got outkicked for second. LADY RIDER off slow to begin, chased off the pace, traveled four then three wide on the turn, tipped out further in the lane and kept on but needed to find more. MISS MICHE LADA forwardly placed up the backstretch inside a rival, chased two wide through the turn and weakened in the lane. PARADE DOWN BROAD raced outside a rival off the pace, driven two wide into the lane and proved no menace. LUCKY NEA traveled near the back early on while moving

to the inside, tipped two wide into the turn then moved quickly into the three path, stayed off the rail to the stretch and never got involved.
