YELLOW SUN DRESS stalked the leaders to the turn outside a rival, got brushed by PRIME AND READY in between the five-sixteenths and quarter pole, angled out and rallied five deep into the final sixteenth and dug in for the win approaching the wire. SPECIAL FLOWER vied three deep up the backstretch, dueled two wide through the turn, inched ahead in upper stretch, resisted into the final strides but could not fend off the winner. HEADED FOR OM bumped leaving the gate, stalked the speedsters from the fence, got shuffled back at the seven-sixteenths pole, hugged the rail to the stretch, rallied from the fence and got put in a bit tight having to pause at the eight pole but was able to get through, then finished well and missed second. PRIME AND READY bumped with inner rival at the start, vied for the lead inside a pair of rivals, came under urging when failed to keep up with the outer pair leaving the backstretch, brushed outer rival past the five-sixteenths pole, took aim two wide into the lane, tipped out in upper stretch, rallied between in deep stretch and got outkicked. PRINCESS MIDNIGHT sat off the pace on the inside, traveled two wide late on the bend, angled out into the lane and upper stretch, finished well but ran out of ground. CORPORAL VIOLETTE (IRE) vied between rivals in the early going, dueled along the rail around the bend, fought to midstretch and weakened in the final sixteenth. THIRSTY DESTINY raced in range to the turn, lost ground two then three wide around the bend, tipped out into the lane and weakened. MS MCWHINNEY unhurried in the beginning, trailed along the inside then two wide on the turn and was never a factor.

CASH CALL bumped with COOEY leaving the gate, was closest in pursuit up the backstretch, challenged from outside midway around the bend, inched ahead in upper stretch and maintained a short advantage over COOEY to the wire. COOEY bumped with CASH CALL at the start, sprinted to the front, took pressure around the turn, lost command in upper stretch, fought back from inside and stayed on gamely to the wire. INTO THE HALL stalked the pacesetter outside a pair of rivals, bid three deep around the turn, could not sustain the challenge in upper stretch but finished willingly behind the top pair to the line. EASTWICK chased between in the opening stages, lost ground two then three wide on the turn and faded out of contention. CASSIN'S ROSE chased along the fence inside a pair of rivals, lost ground under coaxing on the turn, tipped out into the lane and weakened.



FIRENZE FLAVOR tracked in the two path around the first turn, remained in the two path into the far turn, angled three then four wide around the second bend, stormed to the front with a furlong remaining, kicked clear into deep stretch and held over the late run from the runner-up. SUNSET GRAZEN settled next to the fence, saved ground through the far turn, angled out in the lane, finished well and drew alongside the winner late but ran out of time. EMPRESS MATILDA (GB) raced outside the pacesetter three deep, chased in the three path through the far turn, challenged in upper stretch but flattened in the late stages. RESOLVE rated in the two path then moved up to press the pace early on the backstretch, chased in the two path around the far turn, stayed within range to midstretch, then weakened in the last sixteenth. ATIA was a bit keen stalking in hand from inside, waited next to the fence leaving the second bend, put the brakes on when lacking room in upper stretch, gained a clear path past the eighth pole and kept trying to the wire. PREEM was bothered by RESOLVE coming out a bit at the start, sent for the front and crossed over once clear of the field, took pressure early on the backstretch, cleared midway around the far turn, challenged again in upper stretch, lost command at the eighth pole and folded.

DEVILNTHEBLUEGRAS rated along the inside, moved out and drew alongside the top pair on the backstretch, dueled outside SUNSET STORM around the far, seized control in upper stretch, drew clear at the eight pole and was kept busy to the line. SUNSET STORM dueled from outside, inched ahead past the five-eighths pole, fought even terms leaving the backstretch, put away inner rival but had to contend with DEVILNTHEBLUEGRAS to the outside around the far turn, relinquished the lead in upper stretch and churned on through the final furlong to retain second. FAST SERVICE got pinballed leaving the gate, chased four then three deep around the clubhouse turn, spun three wide into the lane and kept on for a clear third. PRECEDENT LUKE broke out and bumped, stalked three deep around the first turn, dropped back on the backstretch, faded around the far turn, eased in the furlong grounds and walked off.

PRINCESS SNOW vied three deep into the first turn then took a stalking position in the two path, crept closer in the middle stages, bid two wide with three furlongs left to run, took over at the five-sixteenths pole, came in slightly to bother AURATIUM at the quarter pole, kicked away in upper stretch and held safely under hand urging and flagging from the left handed crop. WORD PLAY (GB) slipped a bit at the start and bumped leaving the gate, tucked inside at the back, went between rivals into the far turn, tipped out at the quarter pole, finished full of run to gain second but could not reach the winner. MS BRIGHTSIDE (IRE) settled inside, rounded the far turn two then three wide, summoned a mild rally and earned the show honors. NOTIME FOR SQUALLS stalked in the two path, was closest in pursuit turning into the stretch but flattened to fourth. IRISH ROSE bumped leaving the gate, raced two wide near the back, checked and altered out at the quarter pole and could not rally after. HAPPYASACLAM (IRE) went up to challenge for the lead inside a pair of rivals then stalked into the backstretch, remained inside to the far turn, altered out from behind AURATIUM at the quarter pole and weakened. UPCHARGE allowed to settle in the two path early on, traveled three deep leaving the backstretch, exited the far turn in the two path and failed to menace. AURATIUM vied between rivals then cleared around the first turn, challenged by outer rival at the three-eighths pole, lost command at the five-sixteenths marker, got put in tight at the quarter pole and faded down the lane. IMPRACTICAL DIVA unhurried in the beginning and moved to the inside, got put in tight entering the far turn, checked past the three-eighths pole and had little left for the stretch run.

GARDEN PARTY bumped leaving the gate, pulled hard shortly after then settled in the two path, chased three deep leaving the backstretch, took aim still three wide into the lane, put a head in front in upper stretch, cleared midstretch and held over rivals on both sides late. O K ROSE settled along the rail, moved into range late on the backstretch, lacked room on the far turn, remained stuck behind rivals in upper stretch, gained an opening past the eighth pole, rallied inside the winner late but ran out of time. WINTER SNOW unhurried in the beginning from inside, hugged the rail through the far turn, steered out in upper stretch, closed in three deep approaching the wire but was too late. WILD CAT DANZING sat off the pace outside a rival, drew closer in the middle stages, ran into traffic on the far turn, angled to the inside, steered back out at the three-sixteenths pole and finished evenly late. SEI BELLA raced in range in the three path, picked up stride leaving the backstretch, challenged at the five-sixteenths pole, dueled into the lane, led briefly in upper stretch but offered little resistance when challenged by GARDEN PARTY and flattened in the late stages. around the far turn, chased four wide coming into the stretch and flattened out.
