DAY AND AGE showed the way early from the fence under pressure, dueled past the halfway point, fought head to head to the top of the stretch, inched ahead from outer rival, met challenges from a pair of rivals in deep stretch and gamely prevailed. BROSKI (IRE) stalked from inside, waited for room behind the leaders on the far turn, got boxed in from upper to midstretch, tipped out in the furlong grounds, bid between rivals deep stretch and just missed. CUBAN CONFUSION (GB) came in and bumped early, tugged two then three wide around the first turn, stalked three deep leaving the backstretch, bid thee deep with a quarter mile remaining, battled outside rivals into deep stretch and could not summon the needed final kick. CATCH THE BREEZE came in and bumped shortly after the start then got bumped and had to steady not too long after that, settled in the two path, crept closer in the middle stages, gained while angling four wide around the far turn, bid in upper stretch but flattened out in the late stages. MUTAZ prominent early pressing the pace keenly from outside, moved up on even terms past the half-mile pole, dueled around the far turn, drifted inward while trying to correct in upper stretch, steadied past the half-mile pole and churned on to the wire. TAPIT DYNASTY bumped twice shortly after the start, stalked in the two path, between foes into the far turn, remained two wide to the stretch and weakened. MIDNIGHT STRIKE got bumped and had to steady early then pulled along the inside, chased out of range up the backstretch, saved ground through the far turn and lacked a rally. REDIAL got bumped shortly after the start then put in tight and squeezed back early, traveled near the back on the inside, hugged the rail to the stretch and had little left for the drive. WOLF AWAY trailed three wide around the clubhouse turn, remained off the rail to the stretch and never got involved.

SELF SUFFICIENT vied between rivals for a bit then dueled from inside a rival up the backstretch, fought a bit off the rail around the bend, stayed on to midstretch, then weakened in the last sixteenth. SHADY TIGER stalked in the two path into the turn, steered out to the five path and flattened out. MOMAD showed early speed inside the top pair then chased up the backstretch, came under a ride saved ground on the turn, exited the bend in the two path and weakened.

CAROL'S COMIC raced in range outside a rival, chased three then four wide around the turn, rallied to the front midstretch, drifted out late and held over the runner-up. HALO UNCLE sat off the pace outside rival, eased out to the four path around the bend, angled out further at the top of the stretch, finished determinedly outside CAROL'S COMIC while getting floated out a bit by that rival late and failed to go by. IDIOT'S GOLD got bumped with outer rival early on the backstretch, stalked the top pair to the turn, got boxed in while racing in the two path around the turn, roused late on the bend and angled in entering the stretch, bid from inside but got outkicked by the top pair. HAVOC forwardly placed outside a rival in the early going, chased three deep or three wide on the turn, challenged in upper stretch but flattened out in the late stages. HARCYN bumped with IDIOT'S GOLD and steadied early, raced in range along the inside into the turn, chased two wide leaving the bend, altered in from behind rivals past the eighth pole and flattened out. GOLDENSUNRISE dueled from outside, put away inner rival past the five-sixteenths pole, showed the way in the two path coming into the stretch, clung to a short lead at the eight pole, yielded midstretch and weakened in the last sixteenth. TAMARANDO STAR brushed leaving the gate, climbed early and dropped back, raced along the rail into the stretch and passed tired rivals. BARSABAS coaxed along early from off the pace, saved ground through the turn and failed to respond. STAN FROM MALIBU brushed with TAMARANDO STAR leaving the gate, dueled from inside to the five-sixteenths pole, could not kick on the leader after, chased along the rail into the stretch and tired. THERE WAS A STEWARDS' INQUIRY INVOLVING THE TOP TWO FINISHERS LATE IN THE RACE. FOLLOWING A REVIEW, THE STEWARDS UNANIMOUSLY RULED THAT ALTHOUGH CAROL'S COMIC DID DRIFT OUT AND FLOAT HALO UNCLE OUT A BIT LATE, THE INCIDENT DID NOT WARRANT A DISQUALIFICATION.

ARROWTHEGREAT chased in the three path around both turns, drifted in a bit in the lane despite left handed urging and was along for second. EAGLES FLIGHT took control early and moved inside, was joined by MDNIGHT MAMMOTH on the backstretch, fought along the inside through the far turn, yielded to the winner entering the stretch and flattened to third. FOR ALL MANKIND stalked from inside, shifted to the two path chasing on the far turn and faded down the lane.

FAST BUCK stalked three deep, challenged the top pair from outside midway around the bend, emerged clear entering the lane, drifted inward under right handed urging, met the challenge from WE'RE IN TROUBLE late and held gamely. WE'RE IN TROUBLE broke in and bumped, raced outside a rival at the back, crept closer up the backstretch, bumped with inner rival into the turn, bumped midway around the bend while chasing four deep, bumped once more entering the lane, dug in deep stretch and drew alongside FAST BUCK but failed to get by. DANDY MAN SHINES (IRE) unhurried in the beginning, drew closer between rivals but had to take hold when running on heels at the seven-sixteenths pole, bumped with outer rival three deep at the three-eighths pole, bumped again midway around the bend and once more coming into the stretch, stayed within range down the lane but only managed to hold third. ELWOOD BLUES stalked off the rail or between rivals, bumped in the two path near the quarter pole, ran into traffic entering the lane, kept on trying while finding the rail in the lane and earned a minor award. GO JOE WON had to take hold when losing his path at the nine-sixteenths pole, followed in hand along the inside into the turn, angled out approaching the stretch, kept trying down the lane but needed to find more. MUCHO DEL ORO raced up close on the inside, got boxed in around the turn, lacked room in upper stretch, tipped out into the clear and failed to threaten. CHARGE FOR GOLD got bumped from outside at the start, went up to duel from inside, vied with outer pair past the five-sixteenths pole, yielded leaving the turn and gave way. SHARP AZA TACK dueled from outside, battled between rivals past the five-sixteenths pole, could not kick on with the new leader entering the stretch and retreated.

BE A GOLDFISH raced in range four then three wide around the first turn, fell out of range on the backstretch, drew closer two then three wide on the far turn, got to within striking distance midstretch, closed in gamely and overhauled the runner-up in the final moments. AGGRO showed good early speed on the inside under pressure, cleared outer rival at the three-eighths pole, kicked away with a quarter mile remaining, padded the lead in upper stretch, held a diminishing lead entering the last sixteenth and got run down in the last strides. SIEMPRE NAMAN coaxed along in the two path while dropping back, trailed off the inside up the backstretch, angled to the fence while passing rivals on the far turn, showed late effort and gained the show honors. MRAZEK'S OLD DREAM tracked two wide around the clubhouse turn, traveled in mid-pack up the backstretch, entered the far turn along the rail, angled out and spun four wide into the lane, moved out further and kept trying but needed to find more to be considered a threat. UNION HEIRESS unhurried in the beginning while staying well off the inside, went four deep into the far turn, came six wide into the stretch and failed to menace. PUBLIC ASSEMBLY settled inside, drew closer under patient handling on the far turn, give her cue in upper stretch, bid between rivals at the eighth pole, surged clear midstretch and was kept busy to the wire. SUN OF HILL (BRZ) hopped at the start, lagged behind on the inside, angled out into the stretch but ran into traffic, altered back inside and finished well to gain second. SNEAKER checked off heels early, brushed and became rank between rivals into the first turn, found the rail around the clubhouse turn, saved ground through the second bend, tipped out at the top of the stretch, rallied but got outkicked for the place honors. VENGANZA reserved two to three wide early, steadied between rivals at the three-eighths pole, tipped out around the bend and steered widest into the drive, offered a mild rally down the lane and rounded out the superfecta. VALENCE unhurried from outside, rounded the first turn three then four wide, stayed off the rail to the second bend, spun four wide into the lane and showed a mild response through the stretch run. ETERNAL REIGN (IRE) chased four then three wide early, went three deep into the second bend, moved into the two path, tipped back out in the lane but flattened out. TIRUPATI got crowded between and behind a rival into the first turn, tracked three then two wide on the clubhouse turn, angled out and came five wide into the lane

CLOUSEAU settled next to the fence at the back, trailed through the far turn, tipped out a bit into the lane, rallied three deep between rivals into deep stretch and won going away. BRAZENLY settled in the two path, followed three deep in pursuit in the middle stages, remained three wide through the far turn, rallied four deep into the last sixteenth, got outclosed by the winner but gained second. RODRIGOKNOWS forwardly placed in the three path on the first turn, applied pressure to the leader into the backstretch, lost touch with the frontrunner at the nine-sixteenths pole, latched on once more leaving the backstretch, dueled around the far turn, put a head in front in upper stretch, battled into deep stretch and yielded late. CANANI brushed leaving the gate, cleared quickly and moved to the rail, took pressure exiting the clubhouse turn, cleared at the nine-sixteenths pole, confronted by RODRIGOKNOWS again into the far turn, resisted through the bend, relinquished the lead in upper stretch, fought to the sixteenth pole, yielded to outer rivals and got edged for third. ASMODEUS was a bit fractious kicking the stall doors, broke alertly taking control and steered across, showed the way under pressure from outer rival through the early going, shook free past the seven-sixteenths pole and stayed clear under urging down the lane. WHITE MOUNTAIN bumped leaving the gate, sat well off the pace off the rail, advanced inside rivals on the far turn, moved off the fence in the lane and rallied for second. MIGHTY KAI bumped with inner rival at the start then lost a clear path shortly after, chased five wide outside a rival into the first turn, angled to the inside around the bend, was on the move while tipping three wide on the second bend and finished evenly late. PETESOLDFASHIONED traveled along the rail then angled out around the bend, raced three deep into the far turn, five wide exiting the bend and showed a mild rally to round out the superfecta. BATTLE CRUISER chased in the two path, followed out of striking distance in the middle stages, went three then four wide around the far turn and lacked a bid. VALENTINES CANDY was unruly inside the starting gate, stalked from inside, asked around the far turn while moving to the two path and weakened in the furging grounds. TOP GUN CLASSIC came out and bumped in the beginning, drifted out on the first turn and fell back off the pace, came six wide into the stretch and failed to make an impact. TIGER STRENGTH bumped shortly after the start, went up to press the pace from outside, failed to keep up past the seven-sixteenths pole,





dropped back around the far turn, eased in the lane and walked off. BIG SPLASH was off slow from inside, unhurried while moving off the rail, trailed wide into the stretch and was never involved. CANYAHEARMEKNOCKIN got sandwiched shortly after the start, tracked three wide early, dropped back between on the second bend, eased in the lane and walked off.

# Footnotes | <u>View Glossary Of Terms</u>

WIND SPEED got forced out into outer rival crossing onto the dirt, chased from off the pace on the inside, moved into the two path around the bend, tipped out in the lane, closed in fast and inhaled the runner-up approaching the wire. GODAVRI was closest in pursuit up the backstretch, bid two wide past the quarter pole, cleared in upper stretch, showed the way into the final fifty yards and got run down near the wire. CLUBHOUSE CUTIE raced in range off the





rail, drew closer two then three wide on the turn, chased within striking distance down the lane but finished evenly late. SASAFRAN settled off the pace, took the turn two wide, churned on through the lane but needed to find more. NATURALLY BLONDE sped to the front and set the tone up the backstretch, challenged from outside late on the turn, yielded in upper stretch and weakened in the final furlong. ZAP THE COMMAND got bumped and forced out crossing the dirt, raced outside a rival near the back into the turn, tipped three wide at the five-sixteenths pole and lacked the needed response when called upon. TIS SUNRISE dropped off the pace and angled to the inside, hugged the rail to the stretch and failed to threaten. BIG CITY MISS showed early speed then jumped onto the dirt and lost momentum, chased from inside out of range up the backstretch, lost ground around the bend and faded. RELIGIOUSLY came out and jumped crossing onto the dirt bothering rivals, went two wide into the turn, angled to the inside a trite five-sixteenths pole and failed to the stretch and could not make an impact. MISS MRAZEK raced well off the pace off the inside, dropped back to last two wide on the turn, eased in the lane and walked off.
