STARTS NOW rated inside, exited the backstretch in the two path, drew alongside the leader midway around the bend, put a head in front in upper stretch, dueled with KENTUCKY GAL (IRE) midstretch and yielded in the final sixteenth. VINCERO GRANDE allowed to settle in the early going, traveled two wide into the clubhouse turn then quickly moved inside, cut into the leaders margin in the middle stages, saved ground through the far turn, offered a mild response and got up for third in the closing moments. CHEEKIEST trailed early and moved inside, shifted to the two path around the final bend, showed a mild response down the lane and got edged for the show honors. ESMERAY (IRE) laid off the pace in the two path, moved into range on the backstretch, chased three wide around the far turn, got floated into outer rival entering the stretch and was outkicked for third and fourth. TIARAQUEEN (GB) sprinted clear and opened up a comfortable lead first time through the stretch, padded the lead around the clubhouse turn, remained well clear to the half-mile pole then carried a diminishing lead into the far turn, took pressure midway around the final bend, lost command in upper stretch and folded in the late stages. MIZZYAAN traveled three deep then two wide around the clubhouse turn, chased in range leaving the backstretch, went four wide around the bend, got bumped from inside at the top of the stretch and flattened.

ADEBAYO broke slow and lost his path leaving the gate, rushed up between then chased three deep into the turn, bid two wide with a quarter mile remaining, kicked clear in upper stretch, challenged by UNBREAKABLE TRUST at the sixteenth pole, lugged out and bumped that rival late and was able to hold on. UNBREAKABLE TRUST chased along the inside into the turn, angled out and came four wide into the stretch, reeled in the leader at the sixteenth pole, finished gamely while getting forced out and bumped late only to miss out in a narrow photo. MASTER JACQUES bumped leaving the gate, chased from off the pace, took the turn two then three wide, moved out and gained third. TORLEIF forwardly placed outside a rival then between leaving the backstretch, bumped with inner rival twice early on the turn, went two wide around the bend, found the rail then tipped back out in upper stretch and got edged for the show honors. SOUL MUSIC broke in and bumped, chased well off the rail early, took the turn four then five wide and lacked a rally. THEY'RENOTLIKEUS reluctant loading into the gate, coaxed from the start then taken to the back of the field early, went two wide into the turn, trailed four wide into the stretch and was never a factor. HOT TIGER NIGHTS got bumped by SOUL MUSIC leaving the gate, took control early then crossed over once in the clear, confronted from outside rival at the quarter pole, yielded at the top of the stretch and weakened down the lane. BUSTER'S WAY bumped leaving the gate, raced up close from inside, bumped twice early on the turn and faded. THE RIDER ABOARD UNBREAKABLE TRUST LODGED AN OBJECTION AGAINST THE RIDER ABOARD ADEBAYO FOR INTERFERENCE LATE IN THE STRETCH. THERE WAS ALSO A STEWARDS' INQUIRY INTO THE SAME INCIDENT. NAVAJO WARRIOR vied four deep early then stalked the leaders into the backstretch, stayed off the rail to the far turn, spun four wide into the lane, bid in upper stretch, took over midstretch and drew away late. TRUSTY RUSTY raced five wide into the first turn at the back then raced outside a pair of rivals around the bend, crept closer up the backstretch, gained around the far turn, came five wide into the lane, bid in upper stretch but flattened in deep stretch. MEGA MOON vied inside rivals in the opening stages, cleared with a quarter mile remaining, collared by a pair of rivals at the eighth pole and yielded. DORIE MILLER coaxed along off the pace, traveled along the inside into the turn, angled out and came four wide into the stretch and got up for third. CLUBHOUSE BRIDE pressed the pace from outside to the top of the lane, lost touch with the leader shortly after and weakened down the lane. NO CAP stalked between rivals, bid three deep at the quarter pole, could not sustain the challenge in upper stretch and flattened out. SAND TO SEA raced off the rail at the back, moved inside for the turn, steered off the fence in the lane and failed to menace. LADY MARYANN raced up close three deep, moved to the four path on the turn, drifted into the lane and weakened. SHANGHAI SUNRISE raced outside rivals at the back of the pack, traveled three then two wide on the turn, angled out in the upper stretch and failed to be a factor. FULL MOON GRAZEN broke a step slow, raced in the second flight off the rail, exited the backstretch in the two path, quickly moved out to the four path around the bend and had little left for the drive.

CONTRARY CHIEFTAIN stalked in the two path then pressed between rivals around the clubhouse turn, headed the leader at the midway point, spurted away approaching the five-sixteenths pole and opened up around the bend, padded the lead in upper stretch and tacked on a few more lengths while ridden out to the wire. BROTHER O' BRIEN stalked along the inside, coaxed along up the backstretch from the fence, shifted to the two path around the far turn, chased between rivals at the eighth pole and bested the rest. MISCHIEF'S THIRSTY settled in the two path, lacked room at the half-mile pole, rounded the second bend two then three wide and got outkicked for second down the lane. SUPERMAZEL stumbled leaving the gate, tracked four then three wide around the first turn, passed tired rivals on the far turn, spun three wide into the lane and improved position. TOUCH OF ZEN chased three wide, coaxed along out of range up the backstretch, went four deep into the far turn, stayed wide to the stretch and failed to menace. CHIEF JACKSON tracked in the two path, chased two wide into the far turn, moved into second around that bend, then flattened out in the furlong grounds. LITTLEBROTHERJOEY took control early and set the pace under pressure from outer rivals, dueled at the midway point, lost command at the seven-sixteenths pole, weakened around the far turn and gave way. ROISTER stalked in the three path, dropped back around the far turn, came four wide into the lane and had little left for the stretch.





MOVIETIME raced four deep around the first turn, chased outside rivals up the backstretch, dropped back three then two wide on the far turn and was done early.

ANNAN settled along the rail off the pace, gained inside to two wide on the far turn, angled out into the lane, surged clear and won handily going away. WINNING PATRIOT bumped between rivals early, stalked in the two path, went three deep into the far turn, challenged outside a pair of rivals around the



bend, took over approaching the drive, shifted out in upper stretch, yielded at the eighth pole and stayed on to hold second. SOGNO DI VINO bumped between rivals early, settled in the two path, coaxed forward between rivals on the backstretch, went two then three wide around the far turn, bid in upper stretch but got floated out by WINNING PATRIOT, could not kick on with ANNA into the final furlong, flattened in the late stages but was able to secure third. JUST A GRAZE bumped early, stalked along the inside, came under a ride on the far turn, ran into traffic leaving the bend, got stuck behind rivals again in upper stretch, split rivals and churned on for a minor award. FIGHT BACK raced in the two path at the back, crept closer in the middle stages, got crowded along the rail past the five-sixteenths pole, got caught in traffic from upper to midstretch and kept on trying after. GIANT LUTHER raced in the two path then found the rail towards the back, went two wide into the far turn, moved out in the lane and passed tired rivals. MILLBO BAGGINS pulled early while exchanging bumps with inner rival, angled in for the first turn, moved to the two path then came back to the inside, drew closer leaving the backstretch, tipped three wide on the far turn, got floated out a bit into the lane and flattened out. HARBOR CODE grabbed the early lead and steered across to the inside, took pressure at the three-eighths pole, lost command entering the lane, yielded in upper stretch and gave way. ZAGREUS showed early speed from inside then stalked in hand, bid between rivals at the three-eighths pole, lost touch with the leader approaching the stretch and faded down the lane. SHAPOVAL got pinballed prior to the first turn, tracked three deep out of range, stayed off the inside up the backstretch and far turn and never got involved.
