CANDY BAR tracked in the two path or between rivals, chased three deep at the five-sixteenths pole, bid from outside late on the far turn, moved clear at the top of the stretch and held well over the runner-up. CAMERON SLOUGH trailed in the two path early, gained four deep around the far turn, took aim at the winner in upper stretch, chased determinedly through the lane but had to settle for second best. DEA MATRONA (FR) bobbled slightly leaving the gate, raced up close in the two path outside the leader, came under a ride on the far turn, got bumped by FREE AND HUMBLE at the quarter pole and chased evenly in the lane for third. SHE'S SPLENDID settled along the rail, went between runners at the quarter pole and failed to rally in the drive. LADY RIDER followed in range three deep to the stretch and weakened. MOONLIT COURAGE grabbed the early lead and moved inside, challenged by the winner approaching the stretch, offered little resistance and gave way in the final furlong. FREE AND HUMBLE well positioned on the inside behind the pacesetter, bumped DEA MATRONA (FR) and checked at the quarter pole and could not recover from the trouble.

DREAM QUEST sprinted to the front, led outside THIRSTY CAITLIN then cleared leaving the backstretch, crossed over to the rail, met bids from THIRSTY CAITLIN and POTICA turning for home, maintained short advantage into deep stretch and stubbornly held. THIRSTY CAITLIN bumped leaving the gate, raced up close on the inside, tipped two wide at the quarter pole, bid between rivals coming into the stretch, battled into the final sixteenth, dug in late and just missed. POTICA chased between rivals or in the two path, bid three deep exiting the turn but could not summon the needed late kick. PAY ONE MORE DREAM chased three deep into the turn, asked right handed around the bend, drifted to the inside in upper stretch, switched to the left hand and could not rally. LIHUE PRINCESS hustled along the inside but had to steady early, angled to the three path on the turn, moved out further at the top of the lane and failed to rally. SHE'S MY STAR was away alertly then bumped with outer rival and dropped back to last, trailed two wide then along the rail and passed a tired rival in the lane. SOO BRONX chased from inside into and around the bend and tired in the lane.

MONEY MAKES MONEY chased two then three wide, loomed three deep turning for home, challenged from outside in upper stretch, kicked clear outside the sixteenth pole and remained strong to the line. STEAK FRIES chased from inside at the back then had one beat leaving the backstretch, saved ground around the bend, cut the corner into the lane, lacked room and altered out at the eighth pole, then finished willingly to earn second. DECAPO chased for a bit then pressed from outside leaving the backstretch, took over in upper stretch, yielded to MONEY MAKES MONEY past the eighth pole and flattened to third. GREY'S BOY chased from inside, shifted to the two path at the quarter pole, moved out in the lane and flattened. PUNTO FORTY quickest of all in the early going, took pressure at the half-mile pole, maintained command through the turn, was overtaken in upper stretch and weakened in the final furlong. LUCK LUCKY (IRE) chased from off the pace, went two wide around the bend and failed to respond when called upon.

IMA JOKER unhurried in the beginning and steered to the rail, trailed around the far turn, moved off the fence for the drive and improved position. JANEY CREED settled outside a pair of rivals in the opening stages, remained off the rail to the far turn, spun three wide into the stretch and failed to menace. KENTUCKY GAL (IRE) was closest in pursuit on the inside, came under a ride on the far turn, tipped out into the lane and weakened. MY PERFECT WAVE stumbled badly leaving the gate, trailed on the inside, went outside a rival on the backstretch, rounded the far turn three then four wide, angled out in the lane and was never a factor.

KINTRIGUE dueled from inside into the first turn, led inside a pair of rivals around the bend, lost command into the backstretch, pressed the leader then headed that rival near the seven-sixteenths pole, cleared around the far turn, challenged by SPECIALTY into the lane, lost command outside the eighth pole, fought back in deep stretch and edged the runner-up. SPECIALTY tracked from inside, came under a ride on the far turn, tipped two wide at the quarter pole, drew alongside KINTRIGUE approaching the stretch, took over into the furlong grounds, dueled in the late stages and was edged by the winner. JUSTIVAR settled three then two wide around the first turn, angled in on the backstretch, advanced along the fence around the far turn, lost the crop

entering the lane, steered out and finished willingly under hand urging behind the top pair. SUGAR REIGN was reluctant to load behind the gate, tracked from inside, hugged the rail to the stretch, rallied in the lane but was not enough to threaten the top trio. SPRINGLINE laid off the pace on the inside, coaxed along leaving the backstretch, found traffic on the far turn, went two wide into the lane, angled out and offered a mild rally. EGYPTIAN MISTRESS stalked between rivals in the two path, asked around the far turn still two wide but could not respond. TIPITAP dueled from outside then between runners on the first turn, took a stalking position on the backstretch, got floated out by WINIKA and checked on the far turn and had little left for the stretch run. GLOBAL CONSORT forwardly placed three deep early, chased out of range on the backstretch, went three then two wide around the far turn and faded. WINIKA showed early foot four then three deep around the clubhouse turn, carried a short lead over KINTRIGUE up the backstretch, started to weaken while drifting out a bit on the far turn, then tired in the stretch run.
