MIZUMI raced up close three deep then fought on even terms past the half-mile pole, dueled outside SAUCIER around the turn, put a head in front turning for home, maintained a short lead over SAUCIER into deep stretch and edged clear late. SAUCIER pressed from inside then gained the lead leaving the backstretch, dueled inside MIZUMI around the bend, lost command entering the lane, stayed on well to the sixteenth pole, yielded to the winner late but was clearly second best. APPLES Y PEACHES raced up close four deep, could not keep up with the top pair on the turn and gave chase three deep, churned on down the lane and finished a clear third. BAD MANNERS tracked from inside, drew closer and paused behind a rival on the backstretch, came under a ride midway on the turn, hugged the rail to the stretch and weakened. SLICE broke a bit slow on the inside, trailed well off the rail in the early going, rounded the bend four then three wide and passed tired rivals. ALL IN THE GAME threw her head at the start and came away slow, moved into range quickly, chased three deep then two wide on the turn and tired. MOLLY E set the tone early then fought with rivals on both sides past the half-mile pole, lost the lead into the turn, dropped back on the turn and had little left for the stretch run.

IRISH ROYALTY hustled from the gate, fought for the lead from inside, carried a short lead over LISTENUPSHANCE around the turn, put that rival away at the top of the stretch, remained clear into the final sixteenth, threatened by ANMER HALL late and was able to hold. ANMER HALL stalked outside a rival then between foes, waited in the two path on the turn, roused and tipped out at the top of the lane, was closest in pursuit of the IRISH ROYALTY into deep stretch, drew alongside that rival with thirty yards remaining but ran out of ground. LISTENUPSHANCE reared up in the gate, dueled from outside, kept the heat on IRISH ROYALTY around the bend, could not kick on with that rival at the top of the lane, weakened in the late stages but was able to save third. YACOWLEF (IRE) unhurried in the early going, coaxed into range leaving the backstretch, traveled three deep around the bend but could not summon the needed rally in the lane. DHITJARI (GB) raced up close outside the top pair, remained three wide to the stretch and lacked a response when called upon. GO JOE WON stalked the leaders from the rail position, saved ground to the stretch and faded down the lane.

J T'S WATCH dueled from inside, inched ahead leaving the backstretch, cleared briefly early on the turn, reengaged by DURAN shortly after, lost command on the far turn, battled back to reclaim the lead midstretch and inched ahead from DURAN late. DURAN dueled from outside, lost touch briefly with J T'S WATCH early on the turn then moved up to head that rival again on the backstretch, put a head in front on the far turn, battled down the lane and got outkicked by the winner in the late stages. MIGHTY KAI stalked three wide into the first turn, got floated to the four path briefly early on the first turn then angled to the inside, stayed on the fence through the second bend and could not produce a bid in the lane. BROADWAY UNIONS chased two wide into the first turn then quickly shifted to the three path, stalked the top pair three deep into the far turn, came under a ride around the bend and flattened out in the lane. MONGOLIAN MAX tracked in the four path entering the first turn then got floated to the five path momentarily, angled down to the two path quickly, followed between runners on the backstretch, ridden in the two path on the far turn and also flattened in the lane.

NOVINOPHOBIA vied four deep up the backstretch, chased after NEXT TRICK four, three, then two wide on the turn, re-bid between rivals at the top of the lane, took over outside the eighth pole and drew clear in the final sixteenth. SHE SPENDSALOT was off slow to start, chased from off the pace, saved ground to the stretch and came up empty in the stretch. SUSAN YVONNE raced near the back of the pack in the early going, traveled three wide on the turn and passed tired rivals. HEAVENLY DAREDEVIL traveled in mid-pack well off the rail, went four wide into the turn, angled down the two path and tired in the lane. BACKSTAGE DRAMA broke well then dropped back to last, saved ground through the turn and was never a factor.

SOUL SISTER followed in range from inside, had to take up inside a rival past the three-eighths pole, moved into second at the quarter pole, took aim two wide into the stretch, put a head in front at the eighth pole but was no match for LOOKIN AT DIAMOND in the late stages and finished a clear second. MELISMATIC (IRE) followed in range from inside, drew closer at the halfway point, shifted to the two path on the far turn, bid along the rail entering the lane, took over at the eighth pole and drove clear in deep stretch. POSTMODERN raced up close three then two wide, bid between rivals leaving the backstretch, took over midway around the far turn, lost command into the stretch, fought back to midstretch, could not kick on with the winner in the last sixteenth but was able to hold on for second. CONSTITUTION ANDI pulled into the first, checked and altered out, checked again around the bend, asked three then four wide on the far turn, came inward in the lane, rallied and missed second. POST GAME sat off the pace in the two path, moved into range in the middle stages, angled four wide around the far turn, steered out wider in the stretch, finished with late interest and earned a minor award. FLAMBOYANT sat off the pace three deep on the first turn, was on the move out wide on the backstretch and challenged four deep into the far turn, fought to midstretch and could not

summon the needed late kick. PLAGARIST tracked four then three wide early, chased from out of range then moved forward on the backstretch, bid three deep between foes into the far turn, led into the lane, lost command at the eighth pole and flattened late. GO RALPH settled three then four wide around the first turn, traveled outside a rival at the rear at the half-mile pole, came three wide into the stretch, drifted to the inside and showed a mild response to whittle the gap late. CHE (IRE) steadied when getting cut off shortly after the start, settled on the inside, chased two wide at the quarter pole and failed to menace in the lane. STAN THEMAN MUSIAL came away sluggishly at the start, trailed two wide then along the rail early, angled out at the five-sixteenths pole, came four wide into the lane and was never a factor. ITS THE BANDIT was fractious in the gate, sent for the lead from inside, led clear two wide then along the rail on the first turn, controlled the pace to the half-mile pole, came under fire from a trio of rivals at the seven-sixteenths pole, yielded around the far turn and tired in the lane.
