VALIANT SON tracked out of range from off the rail then drew closer outside a rival, latched onto GAZON (GB) on the turn, took over in upper stretch and edged clear late. GAZON (GB) away quickest to take the lead outside a pair of rivals, cleared and crossed over to the rail, took pressure from VALIANT SON on the turn, lost command in upper stretch, stayed on well from the fence into deep stretch, then yielded to the winner late. TRIBAL followed from out of range then moved closer into the turn, rounded the bend in the two path, moved out further in the drive, could not summon the needed rally but was able to hold off SPEARFISH for the show honors. SPEARFISH trailed the field in the early going, passed a rival into the turn, advanced two then three wide around the bend and could not get by TRIBAL for third. BELLY UP pressed the pace from between rivals then ceded command to the leader approaching the turn, chased from inside around the bend and weakened in the drive. EL BROMISTA settled inside, ran up behind FUEGO DEL SOL and stumbled badly when clipping heels into the turn, trailed on the inside then tipped out for the stretch and could not make an impact. FUEGO DEL SOL showed early foot inside the top pair then backed off when crowded past the half-mile pole, saved ground through the turn and had little left for the stretch run. THERE WAS A STEWARDS INQUIRY REGARDING THE RUN INTO THE TURN. THE STEWARDS UNANIMOUSLY RULED THAT EL BROMISTA CAUSED HIS OWN PROBLEMS BY RUNNING INTO A TIGHT SPOT AND THERE WOULD BE NO CHANGE.

B GRAYSON dropped back under coaxing early, picked up stride in the three path on the turn, came four wide into the lane, reeled in the leaders in upper stretch, cleared midstretch and kicked away under hand urging. MUTT DILLIN showed the way early with DESERT KAT to the outside, inched clear at the half-mile pole, pressured again by DESERT KAT around the bend, put that rival away in upper stretch but was immediately confronted by B GRAYSON, offered little resistance to that rival midstretch and stayed on to hold second. TIGER STRENGTH chased under coaxing while out of range of the top pair, saved ground through the turn and churned on to earn the show honors. DESERT KAT pressed the pace from outside, lost touch with the leader past the half-mile pole but remained close to the outside, reengaged on the turn, could not kick on with the top pair into the final furlong and weakened. PRECISION (GB) stumbled leaving the gate, trailed far back early, went three wide into the turn, raced two wide into the lane and never got involved after a troubled beginning.

CONFIDENTIALITY followed in range on the inside, challenged from the fence in upper stretch, got crowded and bumped by SEEKING ATTENTION midstretch and soldiered on to prove best late. SEEKING ATTENTION got bumped from outside leaving the gate, tracked along the rail, exited the bend in the two path, angled out into the clear, rallied four deep in the last sixteenth, was able to gain second but could not get by the winner. GOODIES got floated in some at the start, went up to take control with HIGH SOCIETY to the outside, showed the way along the rail on the turn then two wide turning or home, challenged by SEEKING ATTENTION in upper stretch, drifted in and bumped that rival midstretch, relinquished the lead at the sixteenth pole and got edged for second late. HIGH SOCIETY U pressed from outside early, chased two wide around the bend, took aim in the three path approaching the stretch, drifted in and steadied at the sixteenth pole, then kept on between horses late to round out the superfecta. JASMINE tracked outside a rival, chased two wide through the turn, moved out in the lane and came with a belated rally. AWESOME OLGA veered in and bumped SEEKING ATTENTION, crossed awkwardly over the dirt, trailed two wide to the stretch and never got involved. COPPER LUNA broke inward, crossed a bit awkwardly over the dirt, took a bad step and was eased out of the race, pulled up at the three-eighths pole and walked off.

BIG SOIREE grabbed the lead from outside and crossed over to the two path, found the rail early on the first turn, took pressure from a pair of rivals in the middle stages, moved clear early on the second bend, opened up into the stretch and was kept busy to the wire. COACH CRONIN brushed inner rival at the start, vied inside a quartet of rivals into the first turn then moved clear, was challenged from outside exiting the backstretch, moved clear past the five-sixteenths pole, challenged again by BERLIN WALL entering the lane, resisted through the lane and dug in late to hold stubbornly. BERLIN WALL vied between foes into the first turn then took a stalking position, drew alongside the leader at the seven-sixteenths pole, lost touch midway around the bend, re-bid into the lane, battled down the stretch but could not get by the winner. MAGNIFY showed speed five deep into the first turn then dropped back a bit and angled to the two path, took aim three deep at the quarter pole and flattened out in the final furlong. VOLDEMORT brushed leaving the gate, coaxed along the rail giving chase into the first turn, dropped back in the middle stages, passed a rival at the quarter pole, picked off another at the top of the stretch but failed to threatened. RUNAWAY CHARLIE vied four deep into the first turn, remained close while staying out wide, chased four wide through the far turn and faded out of contention. COWBOY MIKE vied three deep between runners into the clubhouse turn then raced up close close between rivals, tired around the far turn and was eased through the lane.

MARJORAM broke slow and trailed in the early going, went four deep into the turn, quickly moved to the three path, exited the dirt four wide, closed into range in upper stretch, dug in between rivals in the last sixteenth and got up at the wire. LIGHT WON UP tracked the speed from between runners, crept

closer in the two path on the turn, went three wide into the lane, challenged three deep in upper stretch, put a head in front at the sixteenth pole, led over outer pair into the final strides and got nailed on the line. YOURS SINCERELY (IRE) traveled four deep near the back in the opening stages, chased three deep around the bend, angled widest crossing the dirt, rallied down the center of the track, fought three deep in the final fifty yards and lacked the needed final kick. REVERA was closest in pursuit of the lone speed early, latched onto the rival approaching the quarter pole, gained command in upper stretch, lost the lead at the sixteenth pole and faltered late. SURFIN' U. S. A. settled between rivals off the pace, navigated the turn two then three wide, chased within striking distance with a furlong remaining but flattened out in the late stages. WILL HAPPEN followed in range outside a pair of rivals into the turn, bid three deep with a quarter mile remaining, vied four to five wide leaving the turn, fought to midstretch and weakened in the last sixteenth. STILL UNWRITTEN sped clear to show the way early, angled over to the rail for the turn, confronted by pair of rivals near the quarter pole, relinquished the lead in upper stretch and weakened in the final furlong. BELLA LYRA (GER) was a bit rank early on racing inside rivals off the pace, saved ground along the rail through the turn, chased within range at the eighth pole but weakened in deep stretch. MO' EM DOWN stalked from inside down the hill, exited the turn in the two path, given her cue at the top of the lane but got blocked behind a weakening STILL UNWRITTEN in the final furlong. DREAMING OF ALYS bobbled leaving the gate, raced three deep between rivals at the back in the opening stages, dropped back to last and angled inward before steering out approaching the dirt, came four wide into the lane and could not rally.
