VICTORIOUS DREAM (IRE) tracked two then three deep on the clubhouse turn, moved up close outside the top pair on the backstretch, challenged three deep on the far turn, dueled outside FIRE BAN into the stretch, put a head in front at the top of the lane and drew clear in the last sixteenth. FIRE BAN rated along the rail in the opening stages, followed behind the leaders while moving off the rail to the two path around the far turn, tipped out at the top of the stretch, finished willingly and gained the place. WOLF HILL stalked the pace from the two path early, applied pressure between rivals in the middle stages, gained the lead at the five-sixteenths pole, dueled inside VICTORIOUS DREAM (IRE) late on the bend, lost command in upper stretch and was outfinished in the late stages. HOLLY GOQUICKLY (FR) unhurried at the back and moved inside, drew close while easing over to the two path on the far turn but weakened down the lane. KINZLEE'SCHARISMA went to the front from inside, took pressure on the backstretch, lost command at the five-sixteenths pole, yielded to outer rivals with a quarter mile remaining and tired in the stretch.

POCKET VENUS pressed the pace from outside, took over with a quarter mile remaining, put SEXY BLUE away at the top of the stretch and was kept to task through the final furlong. SEXY BLUE showed the way under pressure from POCKET VENUS, came under a ride on the turn, lost command at the quarter pole, yielded to the winner at the three-sixteenths pole and stayed on for a clear second. ANGEL BABY chased from out wide in the opening stages, put in a mild bid four deep on the turn, chased after the leaders three wide into the lane, flattened in the stretch but was able to edge LADY GAMBITA for third. LADY GAMBITA followed in range up the backstretch, asked three deep then two wide into the lane, flattened out in the stretch and missed third. HONEY BUCKET broke a step slow, moved up quickly to stalk the behind the leader, fell back to last still within striking distance on the turn and weakened in the drive.

KING OF DRAGONS laid off the pace outside a rival, moved into range on the backstretch, made two then three wide move around the far turn, challenged from outside coming into the lane, took over under hand urging in upper stretch and was kept busy to the wire. SAND BAGGER stalked two then three wide early, was closest in pursuit of the leader in the middle stages, challenged from outside past the three-eighths pole, put a head in front midway around the bend, cleared inner rival but was quickly confronted by KING OF DRAGONS approaching the stretch, lost the lead outside the eighth pole and stayed on well for a clear second. GOODFELLA (IRE) settled along the rail, chased two wide around the far turn, moved into the third in upper stretch but could not threaten the top pair in the final furlong. BAD TO THE BONES trailed on the inside, tipped three wide around the far turn and passed tired rivals. ZAGREUS showed the way outside a rival then moved inside nearing the first turn, took pressure past the three-eighths pole, lost command midway around the bend, failed to keep up with the top pair at the quarter pole and faded in the lane. JUST A GRAZE pulled while racing up close next to the fence then got put in tight by the leader first time in the stretch, shifted to the two path and went up to press the leader for a bit around the clubhouse turn, dropped back to chase on the backstretch, saved ground while starting to weaken on the far turn and tired in the stretch.

RYAN'S GIRL pressed the pace from outside, vied three deep on the backstretch, took over at the five-sixteenths pole, cleared approaching the quarter pole and drew off in the final furlong. DORIE MILLER was off a bit slow to begin, reserved on the inside, tipped outside a pair of rivals on the far turn, finished willingly through the lane to gain second but was no match for the winner. CLUBHOUSE CUTIE bumped TIMEKEEPER'S CHARM at the start, raced up close on the inside, got put in tight by SPOTTED HAZE and steadied on the first turn, started to pull into the backstretch, went up to challenge the top pair from inside on the backstretch, put a head in front early on the far turn, lost command at the five-sixteenths marker, chased into the lane and weakened. TIMEKEEPER'S CHARM bobbed and bumped leaving the gate, followed in range three to four wide on the first turn, remained wide up the backstretch, raced in the four path into the far turn, angled in around the bend and had little left for the stretch run. SPOTTED HAZE showed the way in the two path into the first turn then moved inside around the bend, came off the rail and was challenged from both sides on the backstretch, lost command early on the far turn, weakened around the bend and was eased in the drive.

MATT AT FIVE duled from outside, took over late on the turn, cleared at the top of the lane and drifted to the inside, then straightened course and drew away from DEBBIES GETTINGHOT in the final furlong. DEBBIES GETTINGHOT stalked the top pair from off the rail, drew closer and loomed in the two path turning for home, tipped out at the top of the lane, chased determinedly through the final furlong but had to settle for second best. CONFIDENCE MAN came in at the start, laid off the pace on the inside then outside a rival, continued two wide through the turn and gained third. DE FACTO was off slow and veered in leaving the gate, raced greenly at the back early, went two wide into the turn, three wide into the stretch, kept on to earn a minor award but failed to threaten. DAZZLE COMM broke inward, settled on the inside, hugged the rail to the stretch and failed to menace. HIT THE TRACK JACK broke inward, went up to take a short lead dueling with the winner, maintained a slim advantage around the bend, relinquished the lead turning for home and gave way. HEROIC DOSE broke a step slow on the outside, trailed outside a rival in the early going, lugged out at the three-eighths pole and could not rally.

THE BIG CHEESEOLA sped clear from inside, opened up a comfortable lead leaving the backstretch, showed the way near the fence around the turn, drifted out through the lane and held well over the runner-up. BOSS SULLY sprinted to the front and showed the way outside VLAHOS, cleared that rival past the half-mile pole, led along the rail through the turn,

remained unchallenged around the bend, given his cue at the top of the lane, responded by inching away from a pair of rivals into deep stretch, then held safely over the runner-up. UNCONQUERABLE KEEN (IRE) settled between rivals then moved inside, saved ground through the turn, angled out in upper stretch, chased three deep into the last sixteenth and gained second. ARTISLAS traveled near the back outside a rival, steadied between rivals when crowded at the five-sixteenths pole, angled to the rail, was on the move from the fence before angling out into deep stretch and got up for third. SORRENTO SKY (IRE) tracked from inside, moved into range leaving the backstretch, saved ground to the lane, took aim at BOSS SULLY in upper stretch but flattened in the late stages. VIRAT bobbed leaving the gate, followed in range off the rail then outside a rival, navigated the turn three wide, was closest in pursuit turning for home, loomed from outside with a furlong remaining but faltered in deep stretch. ZIO JO unhurried in the opening stages, traveled along the rail into the turn then moved to the two path, steered out at the top of the stretch, kept trying through the final furlong but needed to find more. CHARGE FOR GOLD reserved early on then pulled the rider along past the five-eighths pole, trailed on the inside then moved to the two path on the turn, angled widest in upper stretch and improved position. FRIENDLY CONFINES got crowded shortly shortly after the start, ran up on heels early, picked up stride in the three path on the turn, moved out but had to steady behind BARTHOLDY in upper stretch and could not threaten in the final furlong. BARTHOLDY coaxed along in mid-pack early on, rounded the bend three then two wide, moved out in upper stretch and weakened. VLAHOS pressed BOSS BULLY from inside to the half-mile pole then chased after that rival to the turn, lost positions between rivals leaving the bend and faded in the lane.
