MENDELSSOHNS ANGEL stalked between rivals, checked past the three-eighths pole, continued on in the two path to the lane, rallied three deep into deep stretch and edged inner rivals in the closing moments. PAVEL'S ETOILE was closest in pursuit to the turn, challenged from outside around the bend, lost touch with the leader in upper stretch, came back on in the final furlong, fought between rivals and missed while taking some contact at the wire. TIGER OF THE SEA took control from inside, pressured by PAVEL'S ETOILE on the turn, cleared that rival at the top of the lane, shifted in shortly after, moved out a bit then shifted back to the inside at the sixteenth pole while fighting with outer pair, then shifted out and bumped the runner-up on the wire. DELLA TERRA raced in range three deep, remained off the rail to the stretch, moved out further and offered a mild response to round out the superfecta. MIA PIA took a bump from inside at the start, tracked next to the fence out of range, moved out in upper stretch and also showed a mild response down the lane. DIALING DESTINY bumped leaving the gate, chased the speed inside rivals, shifted in and almost hit the rail then checked past the three-eighths pole, finished willingly down the lane but lacked the needed late punch. SALLY'S WISH forwardly placed in the opening stages four deep, chased three wide on the turn and finished evenly late. CASH'S CANDY was off slow to begin, angled to the inside laying off the pace, saved ground through the turn and failed to threaten. NATURALLY BLONDE settled between foes, had to checked behind a rival at the three-eighths pole, tipped out into the lane and lacked a rally. SPARTA F. C. broke a step slow on the far outside, unhurried three deep up the backstretch, came four wide into the stretch and failed to menace. SURFIN CANDY was off slow to begin, reserved at the back, angled out on the turn and was never a factor.

REEF RUNNER broke well then settled on the inside at the back, trailed next to the rail then two wide at the quarter pole, came three wide into the stretch, closed in and took aim at YELLOW CARD with a furlong remaining, drew alongside that rival in deep stretch and dug in to edge the runner-up. YELLOW CARD stalked the speed in-hand and moved inside, bid between rivals past the quarter pole, seized command outside the eighth pole, put MUCHO DEL ORO away then came under threat from REEF RUNNER, resisted through the final sixteenth but yielded grudgingly in the end. SORRENTO SKY (IRE) tracked two wide between runners into the turn, exited the dirt crossing in the four path, tipped out further at the top of the lane and gained third. MUCHO DEL ORO sprinted clear early, led along the inside around the bend, took pressure from outer rivals past the quarter pole, relinquished the lead in upper stretch and weakened in the late stages. NESSO'S LASTHARRAH settled along the inside, drew closer around the turn, chased two wide into the lane and flattened out. BEYOND BRILLIANT stalked the pacesetter outside a rival, bid three deep past the quarter pole, fought four wide turning for home, then weakened in the furlong grounds. FIRST PEACE reserved in the early going, traveled three deep between runners into the turn, gained while easing out to the five path around the bend, then flattened out in the stretch run. KALE'S ANGEL tracked four deep into the turn, trailed six wide into the lane and had little left for the drive.

CASALU was forwardly placed three deep, challenged LEE'S BABY GIRL from outside past the quarter pole, got forced out by that rival crossing the dirt, kept the pressure on the leader into deep stretch but could not summon the needed final kick. EIFFEL unhurried in the beginning, steered to the two path, moved out and came four wide into the stretch and showed late effort in the final furlong. PRACTICAL DREAM pressed the pace from inside, lost touch with the leader entering the turn, was a bit rank inside a pair of rivals early on the bend then again near the quarter pole, finished willingly down the lane but needed to find more. MISO PHANSY chased from off the pace, went three deep into the turn, came five wide into the lane, angled in upper stretch and kept on to the wire. SCHILFLIED broke out, raced up close between rivals, stalked in-hand from the two path around the bend, came under a ride leaving the turn, bid in upper stretch but flattened out in the last sixteenth. WINK AND A GRIN trailed two wide into the turn, angled six wide across the dirt and failed to threaten. A THOUSAND MILES tracked just out of range three wide into the turn, moved into four path around the bend, got carried eight wide across the dirt and faded in the lane. DONTTELLOURWIVES angled to the inside traveling towards the rear in the opening stages, jumped onto the dirt then crossed back awkwardly onto the turn and was never a factor.
