ANNEXPERIENCE broke alertly and went straight to the front, moved in while going clear early, was well rated while setting the pace from the inside to the two path, responded well when asked inside the five-sixteenths pole, extended the advantage in upper stretch, was given a few pops of a right-handed crop outside the eighth-pole, drew off into the final furlong and proved much the best under a strong hand-ride to the finish. MOE EIGHTY EIGHT bumped soundly with a rival at the start, checked between horses early, raced inside for most of the first turn then moved to the two path, settled near the back, brushed with a rival late on the backstretch, was urged along in the three path on the far turn, turned into upper stretch under a drive in the five path and improved to just get the place. DEEMER bumped multiple times with a foe at the start, was placed under a strong hold early, tugged keenly on the bit in the three path through the first turn, was rated off the pace, came under urging in the two path on the far turn, chased the winner in the four path into upper stretch and proved no match then just missed the place while narrowly able to get the show. PAZZ THE SOY SAUCE was hustled to the front then showed the way, came out to the two path into the turn then dropped back to the rail, was asked near the quarter-pole, lost the advantage in upper stretch, fought on determinedly to regain the lead outside the sixteenth-pole, led until the final strides but was denied and just missed the trifecta. OUT OF THE FOG was forwardly placed on the outside, came under urging in the three to four path on the turn, gained to get a short lead in upper stretch, lost the advantage back to the pacesetter outside the sixteenth-pole and was out-kicked.
