GOING FOR GLORY was sent hard from the gate, chased early then was well placed just off the pace, was roused near the five-sixteenths pole, moved to the two path late on that bend, pursued the leader under a right-handed crop into the final furlong, switched to a left-handed crop while gaining outside the sixteenth-pole and got up under steady handling to prevail. FIVE DOZEN ROSES broke awkwardly and was off a step slow, settled on the outside, tracked the leader in the four then three path on the turn, was asked coming to the quarter-pole, took the lead in the five path into upper stretch, drifted out inside the three-sixteenths pole, passed the furlong marker under a right-handed crop, drifted in outside the sixteenth-pole, led into the final sixteenth but was caught while able to get the place. SYL'S PLEASURE pressed the pace on the outside, vied in the three then two path on the turn, was given her cue outside the quarter-pole, spun into the stretch in the three path, drifted out under a left-handed crop inside the three-sixteenths pole, fought with the winner into the final furlong, was carried in some by that foe outside the sixteenth-pole and was outfinished while well clear for the show. POSSE ROCKS broke out and hit the gate, went to the front, set the pace under pressure to her outside while off the rail, dropped from the two path to the inside on the turn, lost the advantage into upper stretch, dropped back into the final furlong and tired. LADY DELILAH stumbled badly at the start and was off very slow, spotted the front several lengths, was urged along at the rear, traveled around the turn in the four path, turned into the stretch in the five path and was no factor. JACKPOT JULIE was sent hard from the gate then urged along off the pace, went around the turn in the two path and capitulated.

SHOOT IT TRUE three wide in pursuit, remained patiently handled and was angled out five wide into upper stretch, got roused with three-sixteenths to go, edged clear with a burst, the rider looking back to assess his margin and was geared down inside the sixteenth marker to the finish safely clear and in front to prevail comfortably on the wire. WEEKEND RAGS coaxed from the gate, chased along the inside down the backstretch and then three wide through the turn coming under coaxing near the quarter pole, angled six wide into upper stretch, ran on to secure the place honors. STRICTLY TABOO crossed directly to the inside after the start and chased along the rail down the backstretch, tipped out steadily to be four wide midway on the turn, came under encouragement at the five-sixteenths, went seven wide into upper stretch and kept on to the end. BUSTIN BULLET hustled from the start, dueled from the two path early on with LATEST EDITION, then chased through the turn getting shaken off midway, came under urging at the five-sixteenths, spun two to three wide for home and weakened in the late stages. KERRY coaxed from the gate, raced four wide in aim of the front before advancing to duel tucked three wide through the turn with LATEST EDITION to her inside, swung four wide into upper stretch and took over narrow and brief command straightened away, got collared nearing the eighth pole, then weakened through to the finish. BLOSSOMING ERUDITE hustled from the start, chased along the inside under a ride from the five-sixteenths, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, weakened in the drive. LATEST EDITION coaxed from the gate, dueled from the three path with BUSTIN BULLET to her inside down the backstretch, shook off that rival and was confronted outside by KERRY and dueled from the two path through the turn with that rival coming under coaxing three furlongs out, swung three then two wide into upper stretch and yielded the front straightened away, then weakened through to the end.

HOULTON bumped solidly with a foe multiple times at the start, was taken back between horses nearing the first turn, moved from the two path to the rail on that bend, was well placed just off the pace, drafted inside to the two path on the far turn, was roused near the five-sixteenths pole, shifted out after turning into the stretch, chased outside while being carried out under a right-handed crop near the furlong marker, gained to get a short advantage outside the sixteenth-pole, fought with the runner-up while side by side with that foe to the finish and narrowly prevailed. HOUSE UNITED was bumped hard at the start and forced in, brushed with that same foe early, moved from the four path to the two path on the first turn, was rated just off the pace, came under urging while shifting from the two path to the four path on the far turn, gained to make a bid outside the quarter-pole, turned into the stretch under a right-handed crop, was switched to a left-handed crop outside the furlong marker then drifted out while getting closer to the leader, made a bid outside the sixteenth-pole, fought with the winner to the finish and just missed. DAIQUIRI SOMMELIER bumped solidly multiple times with a foe at the start, raced in the three path on the first turn, prompted the pace on the outside, took the lead in the three path outside the three-eighths pole, dropped to the two path later on that bend, was asked near the quarter-pole, led under a drive into until outside the sixteenth-pole then was overtaken while well clear for the show. ALWAYS BE SMART was off slow and spotted the front a few lengths, raced in the three path on the first turn, was coaxed at the rear, moved closer with five furlongs to run, was ridden along in the three then four path on the far turn, turned into the stretch in the five path and lacked the needed response. BLOWN COVER went to the front, showed the way on the inside of a foe while on the inside, was headed outside the three-eighths pole, dropped back late on the far turn and tired. TIZMARKUS broke in and bumped hard with a foe, brushed with that same opponent early, raced in the five then four path on the first turn, tracked the pace on the outside, was urged along passing the nine-sixteenths pole, came up empty while moving from the four path to the six path on the far turn then retreated fast, moved further out into the stretch and was eased but walked off.

SPEED SHOPPER a bit reluctant to load prior to the start, got coaxed briefly from the gate and settled tracking the front just off the inside from mid pack behind cover, tipped out three wide and into the clear five furlongs from home and began a steady advance into and through the far turn coming under coaxing near the quarter pole, swung three to four wide into upper stretch and took over command near the three-sixteenths, then edged clear under a drive to score. 

DAZZLING MOVE broke out at the start bumping MALIBU BEAUTY, showed the way in hand three then two wide patiently handled until let out spinning two to three wide into upper stretch, dug in under a drive under lone threat to the outside, got caught near the sixteenth marker and ran on well clear of the rest to be along second best. SIMULATE was well placed just off the pace on the inside, moved to the two path while asked outside the quarter-pole, shifted three wide into the stretch then moved further out, rallied outside to make a bid outside the furlong marker, gained the lead outside the sixteenth-pole then drew clear under strong urging. THIRTEEN COLONIES established a forward position early, raced in the three path on the first turn, stalked the pace on the outside, made a bid in the two path on the far turn, took the lead into upper stretch, led under a drive into the final furlong, was overtaken by the winner outside the sixteenth-pole and proved no match but held the place. PLENSA was hustled from the gate then brushed with a foe early, was taken up between horses nearing the first turn, raced in the two path on that bend, was reserved off the pace, traveled around most of the far turn in the two path then shifted to the three path, turned

into the stretch in the five path and improved to get the show. WARLANDER raced in the three path on the first turn, was rated on the outside but with cover, went around the far turn in the three path, was given his cue near the five-sixteenths pole, spun into the stretch in the four path then moved further out and lacked the needed kick. FOND FAREWELL brushed with a rival early, dropped back while in tight between horses in the two path on the first turn, was reserved off the pace, saved ground while roused on the far turn, turned into the stretch in the two path while under the crop and lacked the needed response. ASBURY PARK (GB) had his head turned when adjusted by the assistant starter at the start, hit the inside of the gate and came away awkwardly at the rear, saved ground while unhurried at the tail-end of the field, shifted to the three path near the five-sixteenths pole, was roused outside the quarter-pole then shifted into the five path entering the stretch, moved further out in the drive and failed to threaten. BAKERS STREET was fractious in the gate, settled on the inside, was roused on the far turn and failed to rally. HANDS OF TIME bobbled shortly after the start, went to the front, rounded the first turn in the two path, showed the way down the backstretch, vied inside on the far turn, was asked near the quarter-pole, lost the advantage into upper stretch and gave way. KING OF ASHES settled towards the rear in the two to three path, was roused on the far turn, swung out to the six path into upper stretch and was no factor. STRATE CASH stumbled at the start, tossed his head between foes and was taken up early, went around the first turn in the four path, settled outside without cover, was roused in the four path on the far turn, spun into the stretch in the six path and failed to respond.

SAIPAN three wide through the first turn, chased four then three wide under a ride from the five-sixteenths, went four wide at the top of the stretch, ran on to garner the place honors. PRINCESS SUMMER raced just off the inside through the opening bend, then chased three wide coming under urging at the five-sixteenths, angled five wide into upper stretch, offered up a mild bid. ARGENTIERA chased along the inside, came under encouragement with five-sixteenths to go, took the inside route into upper stretch, weakened in the late stages. FIRE AGATE got bumped at the start by HEART COLLECTOR, chased just off the inside and then along the inside coming under urging near the quarter pole, spun three wide into upper stretch, offered no response. OTHERPEOPLES MONEY chased three then two wide ridden along with five-sixteenths to go, cornered just off the inside into upper stretch, weakened. LUCY PLAYA broke out a step at the start, chased just off the inside under urging from the five-sixteenths, angled three to four wide into upper stretch, weakened in the drive. HEART COLLECTOR broke out at the start bumping FIRE AGATE, raced three wide through the first turn and then three to four paths off the inside down the backstretch, continued three wide through the far turn, went four wide for home and tired. This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the
