VICTORY HALL broke out a step at the start, chased three wide under a ride from the three-eighths marker, continued three wide into upper stretch, proved no match for the top one while running on well clear of the rest to be along second best. BELLORO hustled from the start, chased four wide under urging from the five-sixteenths, tipped five wide into upper stretch, kept on to the wire to secure the show honors. ENGLISH CASTLE went to the front, traveled around the first turn in the two path, was well rated while setting the pace, controlled the action while inside on the far turn, responded well when asked inside the quarter-pole, extended the advantage under a strong hand-ride into the final furlong, was given one pop of a right-handed crop outside the sixteenth-pole and proved much the best while placed back under a strong hand-ride to the finish. OAT COUTOUR saved ground on the first turn, settled near the middle of the field, was asked with three furlongs to run, raced in the three path while ridden along on the far turn, turned into upper stretch under a drive and finished willingly to get the place. NAGUILE bumped with a rival at the start, was rated just off the pace on the inside, came under urging on the far turn, chased under a drive in the stretch and proved no match for the winner then lost the place while able to get the show. WIND DANCER brushed the outside of the gate at the start, established a forward position early, raced in the three path on the first turn, stalked the pace on the outside, was given his cue in the two path on the far turn, chased under a drive into the final furlong and weakened. KISMEHOLDMETHRLME went around the first turn in the three path, settled on the outside, was urged along in the two path on the far turn and lacked the needed response. BLUE PILL rounded the first turn in the two path, settled in the back half of the field, was roused in the two then three path on the far turn and failed to threaten. COME FULL CIRCLE broke a step slow, was taken in hand behind a foe early then moved around that opponent, saved ground for most of the first turn then shifted to the three path, settled well off the pace, rounded the far turn in the two path and was no factor. JOEVIA'S FIRST bumped with a foe at the start, raced inside for most of the first turn then shifted to the three path, settled towards the rear, was roused in the three then four path on the far turn, spun into the stretch in the five path, drifted in near the furlong marker and also was no factor. BIG EGO was hustled from the gate, settled from the two path to the inside, was urged along on the far turn and failed to respond. BOSUN chased three then two wide coming under coaxing near the quarter pole, went six wide into upper stretch, dug in under a drive outside the top pair a furlong out, then surged home late taking command a sixteenth out before edging clear to the wire. COURTLY BANKER broke out at the start bumping and placing NOT FOR HIRE in tight against ON THE LEDGE, chased just off the inside and then along the inside coming under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, angled five wide into upper stretch, rallied to take command a furlong out, dug in under threat and was caught a sixteenth from home, ran on to preserve the place honors. ON THE LEDGE brushed the near side stall at the start, then got brushed by NOT FOR HIRE due to pressure from COURTLY BANKER, chased three then two wide under a ride from the five-sixteenths, angled six wide into upper stretch, took narrow and brief command with three-sixteenths to go, got collared soon after and weakened in the late stages while along clear for the show honors. NOT FOR HIRE got bumped at the start by COURTLY BANKER and was placed in tight between foes briefly, chased just off the inside under a ride from the five-sixteenths, went nine wide into upper stretch and improved position to the finish. STORMY BIRTHDAY got bumped at the start by IDENTITY CRISIS, who recovered outwards from a stumble, chased four then three wide under urging from the five-sixteenths, went seven wide into upper stretch, weakened. FUTURE IS NOW chased four then three wide down the backstretch in closest aim of the leader, tucked to the two path through the turn, came under coaxing near the quarter pole and swung three to four wide into upper stretch set down for the drive, rallied to issue a challenge taking command a sixteenth from home, then dug in gamely to the finish. ZEITLOS coaxed from the gate, chased just off the inside and then along the inside coming under encouragement with five-sixteenths to go, angled five wide into upper stretch, offered up late foot and was just up for the place honors in a blanket finish at the end. TIME TO DAZZLE brushed the near side stall at the start when breaking inwards, chased four then three wide down the backstretch before tucking to the two path into the turn, came under coaxing near the quarter pole, began to tip out as PIPSY did so in front and clipped the back of that rival bobbling at that station, went seven to eight wide into upper stretch still with PIPSY in front, tipped out two additional paths and kicked on belatedly to just get up for the show honors on the wire. TWIRLING QUEEN hustled from the gate, showed the way in hand just off the inside and then along the inside through blistering splits, got set down spinning from the two path into upper stretch, dug in under a drive getting caught a sixteenth out, ran on through to the end. KAIRYU (IRE) bobbled at the break, chased just off the inside and then along the inside under a ride from the five-sixteenths, angled three wide into upper stretch, offered up a mild kick but was out-finished. TOUPIE got away to an awkward beginning, came under hustling and chased along the inside getting taken in hand just inside the seven-sixteenths as the rail tightened up briefly, remained patiently handled until roused taking the two path at the top of the stretch and weakened in the late stages. PIPSY (IRE) chased four then three wide coming under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, began to tip out near the quarter pole and was clipped behind at that station by TIME TO DAZZLE who tipped out at the same time in behind her, continued

out eight wide into upper stretch, then weakened in the drive. OBSTREPEROUS chased five then four wide down the backstretch before tucking three wide through the turn, got ridden along at the five-sixteenths, went seven wide at the head of the lane and tired. There was a Jockey's Objection by the rider of TIME TO DAZZLE alleging interference at the quarter pole against FUTURE IS NOW. After review, the claim of foul was dismissed and the result was allowed to stand before the race was declared official.

MULLIKIN buckled at the start when losing his back footing as the soil broke away and recovered outwards bumping the aforementioned foe, pressed the pace from the outside three then two wide patiently handled, took over command swinging four then three wide into upper stretch and was set down straightened away, dug in under threat and was collared a furlong out, ran on through to the finish clear for the place honors. NAKATOMI chased five then four wide under a ride from the five-sixteenths, angled five to six wide into upper stretch and improved position digging in and battling on to just get up for the show honors over a rival on the wire. DAMON'S MOUND broke out at the start and was corrected before making any contact with MULLIKIN, cut the pace along the inside under pressure from that rival, came under urging at the five-sixteenths, yielded the two to three wide at the quarter pole, weakened in the stretch when knocking heads with NAKATOMI but ultimately lost that battle on the line. BABY YODA got bumped at the start by NASH and pinched that rival out against pressure from MULLIKIN who initiated all the contact, chased four then three wide, came under light coaxing at the three-eighths marker, paused briefly at the five-sixteenths as BOOK'EM DANNO took the seam in front, went seven wide into upper stretch and tired. NASH buckled when losing his rear footing and then got bumped by BOOK'EM DANNO due to pressure from MULLIKIN and was pinched back against BABY YODA conceding three to four lengths to the front, chased along the inside, came under encouragement three furlongs out, angled four to five wide into upper stretch and tired.

ROOKIE CARD pressed the pace on the outside, took the lead passing the nine-sixteenths pole, shook clear in the three path early on the turn, responded well when roused in the four path into the stretch, drew away while kept to the task until near the sixteenth-pole then was eased up while much the best. SINGLEMINDED settled on the outside, was urged along late on the backstretch, chased in the four path on the turn, was driven into the stretch in the five path and earned the place while no match for the winner. ANTONIO OF VENICE settled in the front half of the field, chased in the two path through the turn and weakened while able to get the show. VEKOMA RIDES broke out and was off a half-step slow, angled out early then was urged along well off the pace, went around the turn in the two to three path and lacked the needed response. KALAHARI DREAMS settled towards the rear, dropped back from the four path to the three path early on the turn and failed to threaten. INVICTUS broke out at the start, moved out while urged along off the pace, went around the turn in the five path, dropped to the four path into the stretch and came up empty. STARS AND STRIDES brushed the outside of the gate at the start, was urged along near the middle of the field, went around the turn in the three path and came up empty. LANDING CRAFT was well placed just off the pace,

dropped back early on the turn, raced inside to the two path on that bend, was driven into upper stretch in the three path and tired. TUNISIAN SPRING was urged along off the pace, rounded the turn in the four path, spun into the stretch in the five path and was no factor. COMMUTED broke a half-step slow, raced near the back, shifted from the rail to the two path on the turn, was taken well out in the track in the stretch and faltered then was eased in the final furlong but walked off. FIFTH AVENUE set the pace under pressure to his outside, lost the lead to the winner passing the nine-sixteenths pole, dropped back along the rail on the turn and stopped then was also eased but walked off.
