REGALTON (GB) coaxed from the gate, dueled early on inside of MARITAL TRUST before easing off that rival nearing the half mile pole as LAUGHING LADY advanced, chased just off the inside through the turn coming under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, went nine to ten wide into upper stretch, rallied to take command a furlong out, edged clear to the finish kept to task. FAST MARKET got loaded into stall three prior to the start, broke out at the start bumping SONJA HENIE, chased just off the inside coming under coaxing near the quarter pole, swung four wide into upper stretch, offered up a mild bid and was along clear of the rest and second best. SONJA HENIE was loaded in stall four after FAST MARKET was loaded in stall three, chased three then two wide coming under light coaxing near the quarter pole, went seven wide into upper stretch, dug in under a drive and was just up for the show honors over a pair of rivals on the wire. PANACHE chased just off the inside and then along the inside coming under a ride at the five-sixteenths, angled four to five wide into upper stretch, offered up a bid a furlong out, then stayed on one paced to the end. TATER TOT coaxed from the gate, chased just off the inside in closest aim of the duel coming under urging three furlongs out, angled out eight wide at the head of the stretch, dug in seizing very brief command nearing the eighth pole, got displaced a jump later by the eventual winner and weakened in the late stages. MY DIVINE SPIRIT (GB) chased along the inside under a ride nearing the quarter pole, spun just off the inside into upper stretch at that station, offered no response. LAUGHING LADY advanced inside the nine-sixteenths and dueled with MARITAL TRUST to her inside while two to three wide down the backstretch from near the half mile pole and through the turn, came under encouragement with five-sixteenths to run, went seven then six wide into upper stretch and weakened. MARITAL TRUST brushed the near side stall at the start, dueled inside of REGALTON briefly before that foe eased off nearing the half mile pole and was engaged in head to head combat with LAUGHING LADY at that juncture, knocked heads through the turn coming under urging near the quarter pole, spun two to three wide into upper stretch, dug in under threat and relented nearing the eighth pole as TATER TOT struck the front briefly, then weakened through to the finish.

HALINA'S FORTE settled off the pace, saved ground on the turn, gained coming to the quarter-pole, spun into the stretch in the two path while roused, chased under a right-handed crop in the two path into the furlong, made a bid outside the sixteenth-pole and got up while drifting out late to prevail. R DISASTER broke out then was hustled to the lead, moved clear inside the five-eighths pole, vied in the two path for most of the turn while challenged to her outside, moved to the three path late on that bend, came under a right-handed crop in upper stretch, led until the sixteenth-pole but was caught while drifting out late then held the place. SCYLLA settled towards the rear, was roused in the two path on the turn, turned into the stretch in the three path under a drive then moved out a path, dropped in a bit while chasing into the final furlong, shifted back out near the sixteenth-pole and finished willingly for the show. JODY'S PRIDE was hustled from the gate then forwardly placed on the outside, dropped from the five path to the four path early on the turn then chased the leader, spun into the stretch in the five path, pursued the leader on the outside into the final furlong and lacked the needed kick. STRIKER HAS DIAL was hustled from the gate then well placed just off the pace, made a bid outside the leader while in the three to four path on the turn, turned into upper stretch under a drive, dropped back into the final furlong and tired. BENEDETTA broke awkwardly and was last away, raced off the pace under urging, traveled around the turn in the four path, spun into the stretch in the six path and failed to threaten. CARMELINA chased the pace down the backstretch, dropped back some into the turn, went around that bend in the three path, was driven into the stretch in the four path and came up empty. LITTLE PRANKSTER was

ridden along towards the rear, steadied off heels in the three path near the three-eighths pole and failed to respond.

JUST ADD WATER got away to an awkward start and conceded three lengths to the front before settling into stride, chased just off the inside and then along the inside coming under coaxing near the quarter pole, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, rallied to issue a challenge inside the final furlong splitting foes to take command a sixteenth out, then inched away to the finish to prevail. INFLAMMABELLE chased just off the inside and then along the inside just off the duel up front, came under urging with five-sixteenths to go, angled out six wide into upper stretch, ran on to secure the place honors in the final jumps. TURRIGA coaxed from the gate, pressed the pace of YOUGOTTAHAVEHOPE from the outside in the three path, tucked to the two path and dueled with that rival through the turn, spun three wide into upper stretch, seized narrow command a furlong out, dug in and was caught a sixteenth from home and kept on to preserve the show honors on the line. QUICK POWER NAP chased along the inside and then just off the inside under a ride from the five-sixteenths, angled nine wide into upper stretch, kicked on belatedly to the finish. PHOEBEINWONDERLAND brushed the off side stall at the start conceding two lengths to the front, chased three wide patiently handled until set down angled six to seven wide into upper stretch, offered up late foot.

YOUGOTTAHAVEHOPE coaxed from the gate, showed the way in hand just off the inside under pressure from TURRIGA to the outside, tucked inside into the turn and had that foe advance and dueled through the turn coming under coaxing near the quarter pole, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, yielded the front near the eighth pole, then weakened in the very late stages. MISS BOURBON chased two then three wide under a ride from the five-sixteenths, angled out eight wide into upper stretch, weakened in the late going. ALETTE D'ORO chased along the inside under encouragement from the five-sixteenths, spun just off the inside into upper stretch and offered no response. SPA CITY ZIPP chased five then four paths off the inside down the backstretch before tucking to the two path into the turn, got ridden along with five-sixteenths to run, tipped three wide at the top of the stretch and tired in the final furlong.
