HISTORIC HEART (IRE) angled in entering the first turn, was reserved in second position behind the clear leader while jumping well, moved closer coming to fence eight, made a bid after going over fence nine, vied outside in the two path on the final turn, took the lead outside the quarter-pole, drifted out in upper stretch, was challenged by the runner-up outside the eighth-pole, dueled gamely inside that foe while near the outside fence in the final furlong and narrowly prevailed under strong urging. PROVEN INNOCENT left the flag-fall towards the rear, jumped well while outside towards the back, moved closer before fence eight, brushed with a rival after fence nine, chased in the four path for most of the final turn then dropped to the two path, came out into upper stretch, made a bid outside the winner outside the eighth-pole, dueled resolutely with that foe while close to the outside fence in the final furlong and was denied in a game effort while well clear for the place. ZARAK THE BRAVE (FR) became rank after clearing fence one, jumped outward at fence two, was reserved in the two path while jumping well thereafter, chased on the final turn, came out in upper stretch, pursued the top two into the final furlong and weakened while just able to get the show. WHO'S COUNTING jumped well while saving ground, moved closer before fence eight, chased inside on the final turn, came out into upper stretch, pursued the top two into the final furlong and proved no match for those foes then just missed the show. JIMMY P jumped well under reserve, had the rider fall back in the saddle many times going around the fourth turn, chased on the final bend and tired. AWAKENED was off at the rear, lost ground at the tail-end over fences four and eight then came up empty. HOWYABUD (IRE) went around the first turn in the two path, raced outside from that juncture while jumping well, angled out before fence eight, bumped with an opponent after landing over fence nine, was ridden along on the final turn and also came up empty. KITTEN AROUND went to the front from the outside, angled in entering the first turn, opened up a clear lead, jumped outwards over fences two and three, continued with a sizable advantage while jumping well thereafter, was challenged after fence nine, vied inside on the final turn, lost the advantage to the winner outside the quarter-pole and gave way.

WEIGH THE RISKS coaxed from the gate, showed the way in hand three then two wide, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, got roused with three-sixteenths to go and went clear under a drive to prevail. PATRICIA ANN fractious in the gate prior to the start, got hustled from the gate, raced four then three wide in closest aim of the leader, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, swung three to four wide into upper stretch, proved no match for the top one while keeping on to procure the place honors. ZADORSKY bobbled at the break, chased three then two wide under a ride from the three-eighths marker, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, improved position to secure the show honors. SULTRY LASS brushed the off side stall at the start, chased just off the inside and then along the inside under a ride from the five-sixteenths, took the inside route into upper stretch and tired. TOUGH STREET a bit fractious in the gate prior to the start, got coaxed from the start, chased five paths off the inside down the backstretch and then three wide through the turn under urging from the three-eighths pole, angled in to take the inside route into upper stretch and tired. BRAGANZA a bit fractious in the gate before the start, chased along the inside until tipped three wide at the seven-sixteenths, got ridden along three furlongs out and angled out five wide into upper stretch, then tired in the drive.

GASOLINE was recalcitrant in the post parade, saved ground on the first turn, was well placed just off the pace, angled from the rail to the four path on the far turn, gained to make a bid under urging near the five-sixteenths pole, spun into the stretch in the six path then quickly drifted out while taking the lead, maintained a narrow advantage while well out in the track past the eighth-pole, drifted in some while headed in the final furlong, fought on well to the finish and prevailed under strong urging. KING PUCK bumped with a rival at the start, went to the front and set the early pace, lost the lead passing the half-mile pole, stalked the leader while inside on the turn, was asked outside the quarter-pole, took over inside the three-sixteenths pole, shook clear under a right-handed crop at the furlong marker, extended the advantage under the crop into the final sixteenth and proved much the best while put under a hand-ride late. ASKINGFORAFRIEND broke out and bumped with a foe, settled off the pace, dropped back some leaving the backstretch, was roused in the three path on the turn, moved to the four path outside the quarter-pole, turned into the stretch in the six path and finished willingly to just get the place. LIGHT FANTASTIC was unsettled in the gate then off slow, rushed up on the outside then gained the lead passing the half-mile pole, moved clear at the seven-sixteenths pole, dropped from the four path to the two path early on the turn, shifted back to the three path outside the quarter-pole, lost the advantage to the winner in upper stretch, lost touch with that foe into the final furlong and proved no match then just missed the place while able to get the show. ROUT was hustled from the gate then urged along off the pace, moved from the two path to the three path on the turn, was driven into the stretch in the four path and lacked the needed kick while able to get the

final spot in the superfecta. KLIMT MASTER bumped with an opponent at the start while brushing with another foe, was urged along near the back, rounded the turn in the two path, moved out in upper stretch and improved position. BLISS STREET broke out then brushed with a rival, settled towards the rear, was roused while saving ground on the turn, paused along the rail in upper stretch, was asked for his best outside the furlong marker and lacked the needed response. THE COMMISH bumped with a rival at the start, was well placed just off the pace, chased in the two path on the turn, dropped back into upper stretch and tired. LIBERTY RISING bumped with rivals on both sides at the start then clipped heels and dropped back before angling out, settled near the rear, was roused in the three path on the turn, spun into the stretch in the four path and failed to threaten. GUILTY was urged along on the outside, went around the turn in the four path, spun into the stretch in the six path and faltered.
