SPITFIRE settled in a good position down the backstretch, chased in the two path on the turn, was driven into the stretch in the four path while moving closer to the pacesetter, rallied to the lead just inside the furlong marker, drifted in while moving clear under a left-handed crop approaching the sixteenth-pole then was placed under a hand-ride late while much the best. SALT PRINCESS was urged along off the pace, saved ground while dropping further behind the leader on the turn, spun into the stretch in the two path then moved further out around the three-sixteenths pole and finished with good energy to garner the place. SPARKLING MAMA was hustled from the gate, switched to the outside of the leader early then tracked the pace, made a bid leaving the backstretch, vied in the three path on the turn, was asked coming to the quarter-pole, took a short lead into upper stretch, led under a drive into the final furlong then was headed by the winner and weakened then lost the place but was clear for the show. FONZI ANGEL was hustled from the gate then urged along on the outside, moved in late on the backstretch, dropped from the three path to the two path on the turn, shifted to the four path outside the quarter-pole, spun into the stretch in the five path and lacked the needed response. COOLA BOOLA broke fast then was hustled hard and showed clear early, set the pace down the backstretch, vied inside while challenged on the turn, came under urging inside the five-sixteenths pole, lost the advantage while put to the crop into upper stretch, remained on her inside lead until outside the furlong marker, swapped to the proper lead while dropping back at that juncture and tired. BIRCH RUN was hustled from the gate then urged along off the pace, dropped from the four path to the three path on the turn, spun into the stretch in the four path and failed to respond. MIA SOPHIA dropped back after the start then settled at the rear, dropped further back late on the backstretch, went around the turn in the four then three path and was outrun.

NOBLE CONFESSOR broke in at the start trading a bump with SPUN, who recovered outwards from a bobble, showed the way rated just off the inside and then along the inside patiently handled until placed to coaxing nearing the quarter pole, got set down spinning three wide into upper stretch, edged clear under a drive to the eighth pole, dug in and held safe to prevail. ORGONITE tracked the pace along the inside from the pocket, came under coaxing with five-sixteenths to go, swung three then two wide into upper stretch, tipped out a path inside the eighth pole and surged late to get up for the place honors when latching on the aforementioned foe as he hit the wire. A BOURBON FOR TOBY settled just off the inside near the rear of the field, tipped out three wide just inside the seven-sixteenths and commenced a steady bid through the far turn into prominence angled five to six wide into upper stretch, dug in under a drive and offered up a mild kick to secure the show honors. ROYAL'S PRIDE (GB) hustled from the gate, got beat to the front by the eventual winner and had that rival come inwards and was taken under a firm hold and eased off to tip to the two path with one mile to go, tracked the leader in closest aim just off the inside attending the pace but applying no pressure, came under coaxing near the five-sixteenths between foes when joined by the aforementioned foe to the outside, swung four wide into upper stretch, dug in under a drive and weakened in the late stages. VINTAGE VINO settled tracking the front from the two path in the one and one, came under encouragement at the three-eighths, angled five wide into upper stretch, offered up a bid but was out-kicked. SPUN bobbed at the break and recovered outwards trading a bump with NOBLE CONFESSOR, tracked the pace along the inside from mid pack, was off heels of ORGONITE when a bit eager at the three-eighths marker, came under urging with five-sixteenths to go, angled four wide for home and stayed on one paced to the finish. BELMONT UNION coaxed from the start, chased along the inside under a ride from three furlongs out, cornered two to three wide at the head of the stretch, trailed.

BOBROVSKY angled in while speeding to the front then quickly went clear, opened up a sizable advantage without the need of encouragement, extended the advantage in the two path on the turn, responded well when asked turning into upper stretch, was put to a left-handed crop outside the furlong marker and widened under strong urging to prove much the best. WAITIN'ONASUNNYDAY broke out and bumped with a foe then stumbled, followed the solo leader from second, chased in the three path on the turn, turned into upper stretch under a drive and was second best. IMAGINE JOHN bumped with a rival at the start, was urged along in third position, dropped from the four path to the rail early on the turn, saved ground from that point into the stretch and lacked the needed response while best of the rest. MR. J bumped with rivals on both sides at the start then was taken up while squeezed back, raced towards the rear under urging, moved from the rail to the three path on the turn, spun into the stretch in the five path and failed to threaten. KINNICK was hustled from the gate then urged along well off the pace, traveled around the turn in the two path and failed to respond. HOOSICK FALLS was ridden along on the far outside, moved from the five path to the four path early on the turn, continued in the four path through that bend and showed little. ANTONINO was ridden along on the inside, dropped back late on the backstretch, saved ground on the turn and faltered then was eased but walked off.

RIGHT TO WIN (IRE) coaxed from the gate, tracked the front just off the inside from mid pack, tucked inside to the hedge three furlongs out and came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, angled four wide into upper stretch, rallied to take command a sixteenth from home, inched away to the finish kept to task. HAMILTON'S WAY along the inside past the stands the initial time and through the first turn, tipped three paths off the hedge down the backstretch, continued three wide through the far turn coming under a ride with five-sixteenths to run, went eight wide into upper stretch, offered up a mild kick to secure the place honors. DAKOTA COUNTRY three wide early on, tucked to the inside one mile from home and chased along the hedge coming under encouragement at the five-sixteenths, swung three wide into upper stretch and offered up a mild bid. KID KREESA established the front and showed the way in hand along the inside past the stands the first time before taking to the two path through the first turn, tucked back inside down the backstretch and steadily was just off the inside by midway, settled into a comfortable rhythm through moderate splits patiently handled until let out spinning from the two path into upper stretch, dug in under a drive under threat from flanking challengers, got collared a sixteenth from home, and kept on to the finish. DOOMED tracked just off the inside and then along the inside coming under encouragement at the five-sixteenths, spun just off the inside into upper stretch and took to the hedge straightened away, rallied up the inside offering a bid a furlong out to threaten for command, then weakened in the late stages. VIA DELLA SPIGA coaxed from the start, chased two to three wide under a ride from the three-eighths marker, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, tipped out a path three-sixteenths from home and weakened. UNION EXPRESS struck the off side stall at the start, tracked the pace along the inside from the tail of the field, came under encouragement three furlongs out, angled six wide into upper stretch and passed tired rivals. ROHAN coaxed from the start, raced three wide past the stand and through the first turn, chased three then two wide on hold until set down angled seven wide into upper stretch, then weakened in the drive. LANDAUER coaxed from the gate, chased along the inside early on and then two to three wide thereafter, came under coaxing at the seven-sixteenths, spun three wide for home and offered no rally. MR. COLOSSAL broke out at the start, raced two to three wide early on before chasing four paths off the inside down the backstretch, tucked to the two path through the far turn, went five to six wide into upper stretch and tired.
