ACCELERATED NEWS broke out at the start bumping MANHATTAN BEAUTY, chased five then four wide in aim of the front down the backstretch, advanced four wide through the turn stacking outside the top trio vying for command with five-sixteenths to go, swung four wide into upper stretch and seized command straightened away, went clear under a drive to score. OUR PREFERRED PAL got carried out at the break by MISS IM PULSIVE, prompted that rival from the outside in the two path before advancing between rivals through the turn to vie for command, continued just off the inside into upper stretch, proved no match for the top one while keeping on to secure the place honors. LADY ANGELINA broke in a step at the start, led briefly before pressing the pace of MISS IM PULSIVE from the three path, advanced to vied between foes through the turn, continued three wide for home and tired. MISS IM PULSIVE struck the off side stall at the start when breaking outwards and then carried out OUR PREFERRED PAL briefly afterwards, cut the pace under pressure from a pair and then a trio and then vied inside three rivals through the turn clinging to command, took the inside route into upper stretch and yielded the front, then tired through to the finish. SUNSHINE LILY fell to her face at the start when stumbling badly, the rider showing sound balance and agility to stay onboard, and conceded four to five lengths to the front before settling into stride, chased along the inside coming under urging three furlongs out, angled five wide into upper stretch and was unable to make an impact. MANHATTAN BEAUTY got bumped at the start by ACCELERATED NEWS, who broke inwards, chased six then five paths off the inside down the backstretch before tucking three then two wide through the turn, angled four to five wide into upper stretch and was eased home to the finish.

KILLY START settled off the pace, was roused just before the seven-sixteenths pole, angled from the two path to the five path while gaining on the turn, rallied to the lead at the three-sixteenths pole, fought outside of three foes into the final furlong, drifted in under a right-handed crop while dueling with the runner-up approaching the sixteenth-pole, rubbed saddles while fighting with that opponent to the finish and narrowly prevailed under strong urging. ECHO IN ETERNITY stumbled at the start but broke right with the field, was well placed just of the pace, chased while moving from the two path to the four path on the turn, gained passing the five-sixteenths pole, made a bid into upper stretch, was put to a left-handed crop while fighting with multiple foes outside the furlong marker, dueled with the winner while brushing late and was denied while clear for the place. ALTERED SHOT broke out and hit the gate, was hustled to the front then set the pace under pressure to her outside, lost the advantage passing the seven-sixteenths pole, vied along the rail under a bit of extra left-rein pressure on the turn, spun into the stretch in the two path while put to a right-handed crop, battled under a drive into the final furlong, dropped back outside the sixteenth-pole and weakened while able to get the show. SPRING MAGIC pressed the pace on the outside, took a short lead passing the seven-sixteenths pole, vied in the three path on the turn, lost the advantage under a drive at the three-sixteenths pole, dropped back into the final furlong and tired. MISS LAO was coaxed along on the outside, came under stronger encouragement in the four path on the turn, turned into upper stretch in the six path and lacked the needed response. LADY ARWEN had her head turned a bit at the start and was last to commence, moved out at the eleven-sixteenths pole then settled at the rear on the outside, dropped from the three path to the two path early on the turn, remained in the two path into the stretch and failed to respond.

ATHALIAH coaxed from the gate, showed the way in hand along the inside patiently handled through sensible splits under the watchful eye of BOURBON MILK PUNCH but facing little pressure until nearing the quarter pole, got set down taking the inside route into upper stretch, edged away under a drive to inside the eighth pole, dug in and held well and clear to the finish kept busy to the end. BOURBON MILK PUNCH attended the leader from the outside in the two path applying little pressure save through her presence, came under coaxing near the quarter pole and spun three then two wide into upper stretch, dug in under a drive running on to chase the winner home clear for the place honors. SHARON HORIZONS (IRE) struck the off side stall at the start, tracked the pace along the inside, got set down taking the inside route into upper stretch, offered up a mild kick. ASHES AND DIAMONDS settled just off the inside in pursuit from the tail of the field, came under coaxing near the quarter pole before being roused taking the inside route at that station, offered up a mild bid. AMELIA tracked the pace along the inside, got let out angled four wide at the head of the stretch, weakened. BEDFORD THE BRAVE just off the inside through the first turn, raced three wide in pursuit under urging from the five-sixteenths, tipped four wide into upper stretch, offered no response. BABYSITTER three then two wide through the first turn, chased just off the inside patiently handled until asked continuing in the two path into upper stretch, faltered in the drive.

WHO'S THE KING became fractious in the gate when his neighbor to the outside broke through the front, went to the front, was well rated while setting the pace in the two path, responded well when asked inside the five-sixteenths pole, extended the advantage into upper stretch, drew off under a strong hand-ride into the final furlong, remained well clear while flagged with a right-handed crop into the final sixteenth and maintained a safe advantage under a hand-ride to the finish. GOTTA GUY was taken up between foes in tight quarters early, raced in the three path for most of the first turn, moved to the four then five path late on that bend, dropped in some entering the backstretch, was unhurried at the rear of the field, raced inside to the two path while still well behind the leaders on the far turn, was roused outside the five-sixteenths pole, spun into the stretch in the three path under the crop and finished with good energy to garner the place. TRUE CONNECTION became restless in the gate when a rival broke through the front, started the turn in the four path then dropped in, reached the rail before completing half of the first turn, was well placed just off the pace, moved off the rail early on the far turn then was asked, shifted to the three path nearing the three-eighths pole, pursued the winner under a drive into upper stretch then dropped further behind that foe, kept on willingly in the final furlong and safely secured the show. ULTIMATE STRIKE was urged along early, saved ground on the first turn, settled towards the back, moved closer with five furlongs to run, raced in hand while just behind an opponent passing the nine-sixteenths pole, saved ground while urged along on the far turn and lacked the needed response. I'M SOLO N IN LOVE broke hard through the front of the gate, was brought back around and reloaded after being deemed fit to run by the state veterinarian, came away in good order, raced in the three path on the first turn, tracked the pace on the outside, came up empty in the three then four path on the far turn and retreated. BROWN DON'T STOP became fractious in the gate when a foe to his inside broke through the front, dropped from the five path to the three path on the first turn, settled off the pace, was roused in the two then three path on the far turn and failed to respond. BOB JOHN RAY moved from the rail to the four path on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along late on the backstretch, retreated in the four then five path on the far turn and faltered then was eased but walked off.

UNBRIDLED BOMBER bobbled just after the start, raced in the three path on the first turn, settled on the outside, was roused near the seven-sixteenths pole, went around the far turn in the four path under urging, spun into the stretch in the five path while taken in hand and was eased but walked off.

TIME TO DREAM settled tracking the front just off the inside from mid pack behind cover, was off heels of PAN PAN three furlongs out and was taken hold of, spied an opportunity to tip out past his stable and barn mate just inside the five-sixteenths and had to pause over that one's heels making sure not to clip before being placed to a ride nearing the quarter pole now in the clear, moved in tandem with MARKET CHILL to the quarter pole and went four wide at that station before shaking off that foe rallying to engage a once clear leader inside the final furlong, took over with a sixteenth to go and forged clear to the finish to score. SMOKEN WICKED broke in at the start bumping GARAMOND in concert with MACHO MUSIC, raced three then two wide in closest aim of the leader on hold to the outside, took over command just inside the five-sixteenths, spun just off the inside into upper stretch roused for the drive and drew clear under a drive getting geared down inside the final sixteenth. GUNMETAL broke out at the start trading a brush with MATI GOL, chased four then three wide from just off the pace, came under urging with five-sixteenths to go and swung three wide into upper stretch, proved no match for the top one while keeping on to procure the place honors. GATE TO WIRE broke in at the start and was corrected, chased three to four wide under a ride from the five-sixteenths, angled five wide into upper stretch and offered up a mild bid. MACHO MUSIC coaxed from the gate, came outwards and bumped GARAMOND in tandem with SMOKEN WICKED, showed the way through swift splits lightly coaxed along the inside under some pressure from the eventual winner and then a pair when joined by GUNMETAL through the turn, yielded the front just inside the five-sixteenths, took the inside route into upper stretch and weakened. T KRAFT broke half a beat slow and came under brief coaxing from the gate, chased just off the inside coming under encouragement near the five-sixteenths, tipped four wide into upper stretch, weakened in the drive. MATI GOL broke in at the start brushing the near side stall and then trading a brush with GUNMETAL, chased five paths off the inside early on before tucking to the three path, went to the inside at the nine-sixteenths before heading just off the inside through the far turn coming under urging with seven-sixteenths to run, swung four wide into upper stretch and tired. GARAMOND got bumped between foes at the start, chased along the inside coming under a ride three furlongs from home, cornered two to three wide into upper stretch and was eased home to the wire.

DIVIDEND RECAP settled nicely on the inside, was roused inside the five-sixteenths pole, rallied in the four path into the stretch, gained the lead inside the three-sixteenths pole, moved clear under a right-handed crop into the final furlong, was given one final pop of the crop coming to the sixteenth-pole then placed under a hand-ride to the finish while much the best. ADDAGIRL ADDIE was hustled from the gate, saved ground on the first turn, was well placed just off the pace, moved from the rail to the two path while given her cue on the far turn, swung out to the five path into the stretch then made an outside bid, lost touch with the winner near the furlong marker and proved no match while clear for the place. CATHOLIC EDITION broke awkwardly then bumped with a rival while off a step slow, rounded the first turn in the two path, was reserved towards the rear, paused off heels leaving the backstretch, rounded most of the far turn in the two to three path, came in when a foe just in front dropped in inside the five-sixteenths pole, bumped ALICE FANTASTIC while taking that foes path and had that rival clip her heels, checked in tight quarters at the quarter-pole, was put to a drive in upper stretch and got up for the show. PROFESSOR GRACE bumped with a rival at the start, showed speed and sped to the front, rounded the first turn in the two path, showed the way down the backstretch, vied inside to the two path while asked on the far turn, came under a drive in upper stretch, lost the advantage to the winner inside the



three-sixteenths pole and tired. PRACTICAL ROMANCE showed speed on the outside, was caught in the four path on the first turn, raced towards the front on the outside, was asked while moving from the two path to the four path on the far turn, dropped back to the three path then two path in front of opponents later on that bend, angled out in upper stretch and lacked the needed response. FORGET TOMORROW went around the first turn in the three path, settled on the outside but with cover, was roused while moving from the three path to the five path on the far turn and failed to rally. ALICE FANTASTIC saved ground for most of the first turn then moved to the two path, settled at the back while off the inside, raced in hand leaving the backstretch, dropped from the three path to the rail on the far turn, was bumped by CATHOLIC EDITION inside the five-sixteenths pole and shut-off, clipped the heels of that opponent at that juncture then checked, came off the rail outside the quarter-pole and failed to threaten. IMMIGRATION LAW broke out then was hustled, showed speed between horses, went around the first turn in the three path, stalked the leader on the backstretch, raced in the two to three path early on the far turn then moved to the four path under urging later on that bend, chased into the stretch and faltered.
