OTTO THE CONQUEROR stumbled awkwardly at the start and was off a step slow then brushed with a foe, established a good position just behind the leading trio, was asked while in the two path for most of the turn, angled out late on that bend then reached the five path outside the guarter-pole, rallied in the six path into the stretch, closed strongly on the outside under a right-handed crop to get the lead outside the sixteenth-pole and prevailed under strong urging. LOCO ABARRIO went to the front, set the pace under pressure to his outside, vied along the rail on the turn, was asked inside the five-sixteenths pole, lost the advantage while moving to the two path coming to the quarter-pole, spun into the stretch in the three path, dueled inside of FAIR LAURENCE into the final furlong and got the best of that foe for the place but was overtaken by the winner. FRIAR LAURENCE pressed the pace on the outside of the leader, vied in the three then two path while between horses on the turn, was given his cue inside the five-sixteenths pole, took a short lead while in the back in the three path approaching the quarter-pole, spun into the stretch in the four path, dueled outside of the runner-up into the final furlong, was overtaken by the winner outside the sixteenth-pole and outfinished then just missed the place but was well clear for the show. COLD AS HELL made light contact with a foe at the start, pressed the pace on the outside, vied in the four then three path on the turn, was asked inside the five-sixteenths pole then carried back to the four path outside the quarter-pole, dropped back in the five path into upper stretch and tired. LOST IN ROME had his head turned a bit to the inside at the start, was slow into stride while brushing with a foe, settled at the rear, moved closer near the nine-sixteenths pole, was urged along late on the backstretch, saved ground early on the turn, came to the five-sixteenths pole under extra left-rein pressure while inside of a rival, checked sharply off heels shortly thereafter then came out to the three path, turned into the stretch in the five path then quickly moved further out and failed to threaten. HONORARY DEGREE bumped lightly with an opponent at the start, angled in while ridden along towards the rear, dropped from the three path to the two path on the turn and failed to respond.

SOLDIER N DIPLOMAT coaxed from the gate, raced four paths off the inside just off the top pair, tucked to the two path into the turn, came under coaxing tipped out three wide just inside the five-sixteenths, swung four then three wide into upper stretch, rallied to take command nearing the eighth pole now in the two path, came under late threat and dug in under a drive, the rider switching the crop to the right hand to flag his charge while loosening that rein and came outwards, bumped his main danger steps from the wire while flashing the crop in his face, the riders making contact with one another, and lasted on the line. ACCOST coaxed from the start, chased five paths off the inside down the backstretch and then three wide through the turn coming under urging with five-sixteenths to go, swung five wide into upper stretch, came in to the three path straightened away and nearing the eighth pole, dug in under a drive rallying to issue a challenge inside the final sixteenth, dug in latching on seventy yards from the finish, got the crop flashed at him from his main rival and was bumped out a path jumps from the finish, the riders making contact with one another, and missed at the end. VINO VICI bobbled at the break under hustling, cut the pace along the inside under pressure from EXHIBITION ONLY to the outside, cut the corner into upper stretch, shook off that rival and was confronted with three-sixteenths to go by the top one, yielded outside the eighth pole and ran on to preserve the show honors on the wire. FERAL bobbled after the start, crossed directly to chase along the inside down the backstretch before heading two then three wide through the turn, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, offered up a mild kick. FURTHER ADO a bit fractious in the gate prior to the start, got backed out and reloaded and then was a bit reluctant to load, broke out at the start forcing FOREVER MAN to steady, chased five to six paths off the inside down the backstretch and then four wide through the turn, went seven wide into upper stretch and offered up a mild bid. FOREVER MAN got steadied at the start when FURTHER ADO broke in front, chased just off the inside detached at the tail of the field down the backstretch before heading three then four wide through the turn when moving around a rival coming under coaxing at the seven-sixteenths, spun just off the inside into upper stretch and offered no response. BRAVE BUCK broke towards the rear then brushed with a rival early, moved up between horses inside the three-quarter pole then pressed the pace, took the lead in the two path outside the three-eighths pole, kicked clear when asked for his best in upper stretch, was put to a right-handed crop at the furlong marker and held under strong urging then was unsaddled on the far turn before being transported off the track via equine ambulance. VIGANO brushed with foes after the start then steadied in tight quarters and dropped back, fell well behind the rest of the field under urging, went around the turn in the two then three path, swung out to the seven path into the stretch, rallied outside under a left-handed crop into the final furlong, drifted in while gaining coming to the sixteenth-pole and finished well but was too late while able to get the place. TARPAULIN had his path taken just after the start, established a forward position under some urging, made a bid at the seven-sixteenths pole, vied in the four path on the turn, lost touch with the winner while drifting in behind that foe in upper stretch, chased into the final furlong and weakened but was clear for the show. NORTH END LADY raced three wide through the first turn and then three wide down the backstretch and through the far turn coming under coaxing near the quarter pole, swung six to seven wide into upper stretch, rallied with good energy to seize command inside the three-sixteenths, edged away under a drive and held safe to prevail over a late closing rival. SAIL WITH THE WIND coaxed from the gate, tracked the pace along the inside, got let out continuing in the inside route into upper stretch, paused briefly just inside the three-sixteenths, then ran on willingly to secure the place honors. TONGUE TWISTER coaxed from the start, settled tracking the front just off the inside from mid pack, came under encouragement at the five-sixteenths, angled six wide into upper stretch and kicked on belatedly to the finish. SOVEREIGNTY raced forwardly placed just off the inside through the first turn before tipping three paths off the rail down the backstretch, had BAEZA tip out from the two path five and a half furlongs from home and floated four wide, then had MO PLEX begin to come outwards steadily from the two path to be three wide and was carried to the five path near the half mile pole and briefly dropped to the tail of the field as the back two rivals advanced on the now open two inner paths, tucked four wide into the far turn, came under coaxing with five-sixteenths to go and advanced outside the top pair, got floated seven wide into upper stretch by BAEZA but had his measure seizing command straightened away, dug in under a light drive and inched away being flashed the crop to the right side before coming under a light hand ride through the final sixteenth to prevail comfortably on the wire. BAEZA raced along the inside through the first turn and then just off the inside in behind the leader into the backstretch, tipped to the three path with five and a half furlongs to run nudging SOVEREIGNTY four wide, then got carried out by the leader four wide floating his main danger five wide nearing the half mile pole, tucked three wide into the turn and came under encouragement between foes with five-sixteenths to run, engaged the leader at the quarter pole and floated out six wide into upper stretch carrying SOVEREIGNTY seven wide as that rival took over the front, lightly brushed with that foe at the three-sixteenths, dug in under a drive to the finish but was along well clear of the rest and second best. HILL ROAD buckled at the break when losing his rear footing, raced three wide into the first turn before tucking to the rail, chased just off the into the backstretch, began to advance in concert with SANDMAN when the top trio went outwards three, four, and five wide, and briefly moved into contention half a mile from home before those rivals tucked back inwards, came under encouragement at the five-sixteenths, took the inside route into upper stretch and weakened while along for the show honors just besting the remaining rivals on the wire. MO PLEX broke on top despite stumbling at the start, showed the way in hand along the inside through the first turn before taking to the two path down the backstretch settling into a comfortable rhythm, had BAEZA advance midway and began to float steadily outwards carrying that rival and SOVEREIGNTY out four and five wide respectively half a mile from home as SANDMAN and HILL ROAD advanced inside given the opportunity, tucked back to the two path inside that station and came under coaxing near the five-sixteenths under threat, spun two to three wide into upper stretch and was displaced from the front straightened away and weakened to the finish. NONNA LYNNE broke out and bumped with a foe, was taken in hand early, went around the first turn in the two path, was reserved off the pace, came under urging while moving from the rail to the two path on the far turn, angled to the five path while gaining late on that bend, rallied in the six path into the stretch, closed strongly to get the lead inside the furlong marker, disposed of a foe near the sixteenth-pole, swapped back to her inside lead while challenged by the runner-up late and held under strong urging. OFF SCRIPT was unhurried while saving ground at the rear, moved off the rail while roused on the far turn, shifted to the three path while gaining later on that bend, rallied in upper stretch, closed well to make a bid inside of the winner in the final sixteenth but missed while clear for the place. SASSETTI raced in the three path on the first turn, tracked the pace on the outside, was given her cue in the two path on the far turn, took the lead at the top of the stretch, led under a drive into the final furlong then was headed by the winner, dropped back into the final sixteenth and weakened but held the show. WILL OF A WOMANNE rounded the first turn in the two path, was rated just off the pace, drafted inside on the far turn, was roused while swinging into the four path entering the stretch, chased the leader into the final furlong and tired. HEDGE THE RISK raced just off the inside through the first turn, then tracked the front three then two wide down the backstretch settled near the rear of the field, got given a notch to work with into the far turn and was steadied briefly in traffic near the three-eighths pole, came under light coaxing near the quarter pole, continued in the two path into upper stretch, rallied with good energy to take command just outside the sixteenth pole, then edged away to the finish to score. SUSPICIOUSLY NAMED got bumped by MAJESTIC MICHAEL with eight and a half furlongs to run and in turn bumped CAPTCHA into MCHALE, vied with a quartet past the stands the first turn before emerging with sole command in the two path through the first turn, settled along the hedge into the backstretch and began to steadily widen away, opened up a commanding lead with five-sixteenths to go when put to coaxing, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, dug in under threat and was collared just outside the sixteenth marker, ran on to preserve the place honors on the wire. BATTLE DRUM (FR) got floated four wide into the first turn and tucked three wide through that bend, chased three then two wide coming under coaxing with five-sixteenths to run, continued three wide into upper stretch, offered up a bid a furlong out, kept on to procure the show honors. FATEFUL LIGHTNING broke a half a beat slow, chased three wide under a ride from the three-eighths marker, tipped three to four wide for home and kicked on belatedly to the finish. GOT STRIPES raced three wide through the first turn, chased three then two wide under encouragement from the three-eighths pole, spun three wide into upper stretch, offered up a bid, then flattened out in the late stages. CAPTCHA got bumped with eight and a half furlongs to run in a chain of bumps begun by MAJESTIC MICHAEL coming inwards, chased just off the inside and then along the inside under a ride from the five-sixteenths, continued in the inside route into upper stretch and tired. LAIRD OF MAGNOLIA chased along the inside and then just off the inside under urging from the three-eighths marker, angled five wide for home and made no impact. MCHALE bobbled at the break, then got bumped in the chain of bumps with eight and a half furlongs to go, vied inside a quartet and was eased off one mile from home before taking the two path through the first turn, chased four then three wide thereafter coming under coaxing three furlongs out, angled five to six wide into upper stretch and tired. MAJESTIC MICHAEL coaxed from the gate, came inwards bumping SUSPICIOUSLY NAMED into CAPTCHA and in turn MCHALE with eight and a half furlongs to run, vied between foes briefly before easing off to chase just off the inside through the first turn and then three then two wide down the backstretch, tucked inside into the far turn and was taken hold as HEDGE THE RISK went by near the five-sixteenths, cornered three wide into upper stretch and was eased home to the finish.
