OUR LIBERTY BELLE raced just off the inside through the first turn, chased four paths off the inside down the backstretch and through the far turn coming under coaxing near the five-sixteenths, continued four wide for home, dug in under a drive issuing a challenge through the final furlong and was up in the last jumps to prevail. COQUITO coaxed from the start, raced three wide through the first turn, chased three wide in closest aim of the leader in a spread out field, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, took command near the quarter pole and continued three wide into upper stretch, dug in under a drive inching away, came out to get a look at her threat to the outside near the sixteenth marker and was nailed in the final strides. COLONIAL ROSE chased just off the inside under a ride from the five-sixteenths, continued just off the inside into upper stretch, offered up a bid a furlong out, then weakened in the late stages. ENNIS TOWN was sent hard from the gate, bumped lightly with a foe leaving the chute, dropped from the two path to the rail on the first turn, showed the way down the backstretch, controlled the action while inside on the far turn, responded well when asked coming to the quarter-pole, came under a right-handed crop in upper stretch, switched to a left-handed crop outside the sixteenth-pole and held under strong urging. SALVATION went around the first turn in the four path, was forwardly placed on the outside, came under urging in the three path on the far turn, was driven into the stretch in the four path, pursued the winner in the drive and safely secured the place. IRON SIGHT lunged at the start and was off slow, spotted the front a few lengths, tugged on the bit while saving ground through the first turn, settled towards the rear, raced inside on the far turn, was roused inside the five-sixteenths pole then moved off the rail outside the quarter-pole, swung out to the five path into upper stretch, drifted out outside the furlong marker then was straightened by the rider and got up for the show. POLICY CHANGE came in early and bothered a foe, bumped lightly with the winner leaving the chute, dropped from the three path to the two path on the first turn, tracked the pace on the backstretch, chased in the two path on the far turn, was driven into the stretch in the three path and tired then lost the show. PROVE checked when shut-off early, rounded the first turn in the two path, was rated off the pace, moved from the rail to the three path while roused on the far turn, spun into the stretch in the five path then drifted in and had nothing left. NANTZ rounded the first turn the five path, settled on the outside, was urged along in the four path for most of the far turn then moved to the five path, turned into the stretch in the six path and faltered. STARSHIP TITAN tossed his head and was off a bit slow, was caught in the six path for most of the first turn then dropped to the five path, settled on the outside, was urged along passing the nine-sixteenths pole, moved from the three path to the two path on the far turn and also faltered. ELKO COUNTY was hustled from the gate, raced in the three path on the first turn, was urged along on the backstretch, went around most of the far turn in the two

path, shifted to the three then four path late on that bend, turned into the stretch in the seven path and had nothing left.
