HIDDEN PATH saved ground at the tail of the field early on, jumped well to maintain range with the front, tipped out two to three wide in the final turn once in the flat and bid through the latter portion of that bend issuing a challenge to take command a furlong out, then edged away to the finish to prevail. ST JAMES THE GREAT three wide through the first turn, tracked five then four wide briefly early on before tucking back three wide after jump three, went three wide through the third turn, jumped well to maintain his position, advanced in the flat to take command midway on the last turn with two and a half furlongs to run, dug in under threat and was collared a furlong out, ran on willingly for the place honors. BRIE'S MISSION two to three wide in pursuit from near the rear of the field, kept his position jumping well, came under urging once in the flat and offered up a mild kick. AWESOME STRIKE two to three wide in pursuit from just off the pace, raced three wide through the third turn, advanced on the leader to take command after the final flight, dug in under threat and was collared by ST. JAMES THE GREAT with two and a half furlongs to run, kept on under a drive through to the finish. ST. JOHN'S tracked the pace along the inside in pursuit from mid pack, came under coaxing after clearing the final jump, dug in under a drive and tired through to the end. SA'AD (FR) settled tracking from just off the inside just off the pace, jumped well to maintain position, came under urging after clearing the final flight, faltered in the flat, then got pulled up after the finish and was vetted with attention focusing on the left front leg and was transported off the course via the equine ambulance. MEMENTO (FR) showed the way just off the inside and then along the inside after jump three wide, jumped late at fence eight and yielded the front after clearing fence nine, then retreated under a drive to midway on the turn and was eased home to the finish. HOLEY MOLEY tracked the pace along the inside, jumped late at fence three making contact with the jump and again at fence five albeit without contact, came under coaxing after clearing fence seven, jumped awkward at fence eight and then left the course after that flight, got attended to on the main track in the backstretch for heat and vetted and was escorted by outrider before walking off under his own power.

RACING COLORS was urged along on the outside then dropped back, angled in outside the five-eighths pole, dropped to the rail leaving the backstretch, saved ground early on the turn, shifted to the three path while gaining late on that bend, moved to the four path at the quarter-pole, chased the leader into the final furlong, gained to make a bid outside the sixteenth-pole, battled with the runner-up to the finish and narrowly prevailed under steady urging. EMBRACEABLE GAL broke in then brushed with a foe and was off a half-step slow, moved up under urging between foes then pressed the pace on the outside of two rivals, dropped back under urging leaving the backstretch, chased while moving a bit further behind the leader in the four path on the turn, turned into the stretch in the five path while under the drive, chased outside into the final furlong, gained to make a bid outside the sixteenth-pole, fought outside of the winner to the finish and just missed while clear for the place. TRUE EMPRESS was brushed at the start, pressed the pace on the outside of the leader, drew even with that foe late on the backstretch, took a short lead in the three path outside the three-eighths pole, moved clear at the quarter-pole then was asked, came under a right-handed crop in upper stretch, led until outside the sixteenth-pole then was headed and weakened while able to get third purse money. MITOLE'S GIRL was reluctant to load then hustled from the gate, set the pace under pressure to her outside, was urged along late on the backstretch, lost the advantage while in the two path outside the three-eighths pole, continued in the two path while vying inside of a foe through the turn, dropped back at the quarter-pole then came out into upper stretch, chased the leader into the final furlong then dropped in and tired.

SUNSET SIZZLE broke out at the start, chased four wide coming under coaxing near the quarter pole, angled six wide into upper stretch, shied out a furlong out under a left handed crop, got corrected inside that station and seized command a sixteenth from home, then edged clear to the finish to score. CHOCOLATECHOCOLATE chased three then two wide coming under a ride nearing the quarter pole, angled four wide into upper stretch, offered up a mild kick. LAUGHING LADY dueled briefly early on with STIRRED UP before shaking off that rival and was confronted by CONTRACT LAW to her inside, knocked heads with that rival until shaking off that foe with seven-sixteenths remaining, got let out spinning three wide into upper stretch, dug in under threat and was collared a sixteenth from home, kept on to the wire to preserve the show honors. STIRRED UP dueled briefly from the four path with LAUGHING LADY to her inside before chasing three wide coming under coaxing just outside the quarter pole, went five wide into upper stretch and weakened in the late stages. CONTRACT LAW bobbed at the break, advanced inside after the start and dueled with LAUGHING LADY from just inside five furlongs to run until shaken off near the seven-sixteenths, came under urging with five-sixteenths to go, spun just off the inside into upper stretch and weakened in the drive. TIZALLMINE broke out a step at the start, chased four paths off the inside down the backstretch before tucking to the two path through the turn, came under a ride with seven-sixteenths to go, spun three to four wide at the head of the stretch and trailed throughout.

KIGALI got bumped at the start by OTTAWATERBURY, who broke outwards, led early on before being displaced on the front past the stands the initial time and settled tracking along the inside from just off the pace, remained patiently handled and briefly tipped to the two path when the new leader began to stop into the far and final turn and tipped back inside midway, came under coaxing near the quarter pole, spun three wide into upper stretch, rallied to take command just inside the three-sixteenths and inches clear under a drive to prevail. SALTED CARMEL saved ground in pursuit from mid pack, dropped back to near the rear of the field, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, ran on willingly to procure the place honors.
