ONE MORE FREUD moved out under urging early then dropped back in, was well placed just off the pace, saved ground for most of the turn then was roused while moving to the two path, rallied under a left-handed crop into the stretch, gained the lead inside the three-sixteenths pole then went clear while drifting down to the inside, was given one final light top on the shoulder with a left-handed crop inside the furlong marker and was geared down while widening with the rider poised like a statue in the irons. WHATAREWEDOING broke fast and quickly went clear, controlled the action in the two path for most of the turn then dropped to the rail, was given her cue coming to the quarter-pole, lost the advantage to the winner inside the three-sixteenths pole and proved no match while clear for the place. GOLDENEYE stumbled at the start conceding two to three lengths to the front when away last, raced three paths off the hedge past the stands the initial time before tucking inside through the first turn, tipped four paths off the inside down the backstretch before tucking to the two path into the far turn, came under coaxing nearing the quarter pole, angled six wide at that station before tipping out two additional paths straightened away, rallied to take command just inside the sixteenth pole, then edged away to the finish to prevail. WOLFIE'S DYNAGHOST five paths off the inside past the stands the first time under a hard hold in closest aim of the leader, went three then two wide through the first turn before heading back to be five paths off the hedge down the backstretch, advanced on the leader tucking to the two path seven-sixteenths from home and intensified the pressure on that rival through the turn patiently handled until set down spinning four wide into upper stretch, took over the front straightened away, dug in under a drive coming out a path just inside the eighth pole, got collared just inside the sixteenth pole and kept on to preserve the place honors safely on the wire. SIGNATOR five paths off the inside past the stands the first turn, tucked to the two path into the first turn before heading back five paths off the hedge down the backstretch, tucked to the two path into the far turn, came under encouragement at the five-sixteenths, angled five wide into upper stretch and kept on to the finish. MONEY SUPPLY raced three paths off the inside early on before tucking to the inside through the opening bend, chased three paths off the inside down the backstretch, tucked inside placed to coaxing with seven-sixteenths remaining, angled four wide at the head of the stretch and weakened. PREVENT bobbled at the break but broke on top despite it, showed the way three paths off the inside past the stands the first time and then just off the inside through the first turn, tipped out four paths off the hedge down the backstretch and remained in hand, came under pressure and tucked inside at the seven-sixteenths and faced ever increasing prompting by WOLFIE'S DYNAGHOST through the far turn coming under urging with five-sixteenths to go, swung three wide into upper stretch and yielded the front straightened away, then weakened through to the end.

FORTUNA MIA pressed the pace between horses, dropped back just off the leaders nearing the half-mile pole, drafted in the three path on the turn, was given her cue near the five-sixteenths pole, angled to the five path outside the quarter-pole, came out to the seven path into upper stretch then drifted further out, chased outside under a right-handed crop while remaining on her inside lead, gained to take the advantage at the furlong marker, swapped to the proper lead outside the sixteenth-pole and prevailed under strong urging. KADENA was hustled from the gate, disputed the pace on the outside of three foes, vied in the four path while outside of two rivals on the turn, led passing the five-sixteenths pole, spun into upper stretch in the five path while under the crop, drifted out under a left-handed crop outside the furlong marker, lost the advantage to the winner at that marker and was outfinished while able to get the place. MARGAUX TREASURE came outward at the start, dropped well behind while settling at the rear, went around most of the turn in the two path then shifted to the three path, gained in the four path into the stretch, moved in while chasing outside the eighth-pole, held a good striking position into the final furlong but flattened out and settled for the show. LUTHER (GB) clipped heels just after the start then dropped back, was coaxed along inside of TIZ DASHING early, bumped very hard with that rival nearing the first turn then checked while hitting the rail, settled well off the pace on the inside, began to move up quickly with a half-mile to run, rushed up along the rail then steadied when CLEVER AGAIN took his path near the seven-sixteenths pole, was roused while inside on the far turn, cut the corner into the stretch, pursued the un-official winner in the drive and finished with good courage to get the place in a tough trip. COMPETITIVE THREAT (IRE) broke in at the start bumping LIFE ADVICE, tracked the pace along the inside coming under a ride near the quarter pole, spun three wide into upper stretch, rallied to take command a furlong out, dug in and was caught in the final strides to the finish. LIFE ADVICE bobbled at the start, then got bumped by the aforementioned foe and in turn brushed SAUCY SIX, showed the way in hand just off the inside spurting away briefly before the field took closer order, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, got set down three-sixteenths from home, dug in and was caught a furlong out, kept on to the finish. LESLIE'S STAR broke out a step at the start brushing ADRIAN, chased two then three wide under a ride from the five-sixteenths, angled five wide for home and improved position to the end. LUCKFORYOU three then two wide through the first turn, chased three then two wide in aim of the leader, got set down

spinning three wide into upper stretch, weakened in the drive.
