RUN CURTIS RUN lunged at the break, chased just off the inside from near the rear of the field, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, spun three wide into upper stretch, rallied tucking to the two path a furlong out and overthrew the leader nearing the sixteenth pole, then edged clear to the finish. BERGEN coaxed from the gate, chased three to four wide under a ride from the five-sixteenths, angled six wide into upper stretch, ran on to secure the place honors in a blanket finish behind the bursting away winner. FINAL VERDICT prompted the pace four wide outside a pair of rivals coming under coaxing near the quarter pole, tipped five wide into upper stretch, kept on to secure the show honors on the line. WORLD BEATER dropped from the three path to the two path on the first turn, settled with cover, rounded the far turn in the two path, was roused inside the five-sixteenths pole, tipped out after turning into the stretch, rallied outside into the final furlong and closed well to get up late and prevail. JUWELIER (IRE) bumped with a rival a couple times at the start, quickly sped to the front then opened up a clear advantage, raced in the three path on the first turn, showed the way with a sizable lead, rounded the far turn in the two path, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, came under a right-handed crop in upper stretch, led under a drive into the final sixteenth but was denied while able to get the place. TEST SCORE was fractious in the gate, saved ground on the first turn, came out entering the backstretch, settled off the pace, was given his cue at the seven-sixteenths pole, went around most of the far turn in the three path under urging then shifted to the four path, turned into upper stretch under a drive, gained to make a bid into the final furlong, battled with two foes to the finish and missed while able to get the show. HOTAZHELL (GB) was taken back early then tucked in, went around most of the first turn in the two path, was forced out to the three then four path later on that bend then dropped back to the two path, raced towards the rear under a hold, navigated the far turn in the three path while inside of a foe, was asked outside the quarter-pole, tried to get out while in the four path into the stretch but was kept in by NEW CENTURY, was urged along behind foes into the final furlong, moved out to get clear space in front outside the sixteenth-pole and finished with good energy but was too late while up for the last spot in the superfecta. FINAL GAMBIT bumped with rivals on both sides at the start then was pinched back, raced inside for most of the first turn then moved to the two path, was unhurried at the rear of the field, angled from the three path to the five path while roused on the far turn, turned into the stretch in the six path and improved position. NEW CENTURY (GB) tucked in before the first turn while taken under a snug hold, went around most of the first turn in the two path then shifted to the three path, was reserved towards the rear, rounded the far turn in the three then four path, was asked outside the quarter-pole, kept HOTAZHELL in behind horses into upper stretch then came out some and lacked the needed response. CAPITOL HILL was taken back along the hedge early, saved ground while reserved off the pace, was roused near the five-sixteenths pole, came under the crop in upper stretch and also lacked the needed response. TIBERIUS THUNDER (IRE) established a forward position early, dropped from the three path to the two path on the first turn, followed the clear leader from second without the benefit of cover, was asked near the seven-sixteenths pole, chased in the three path on the far turn, pursued the leader under a drive into the final furlong and tired. TIZTASTIC hit the outside of the gate then bumped with a rival, was taken up between foes in the two path near the seven-eighths pole, raced in the back half of the field under reserve, saved ground while

roused on the far turn, was driven into the stretch in the three path and failed to respond.

KILWIN stumbled badly at the start pecking the ground and conceding six to seven lengths to the front before settling into stride, chased two to three wide detached at the tail of the field but patiently handled until called upon swinging four to five wide into upper stretch, tipped out four paths from the three-sixteenths to the eighth pole to the farthest outside, then offered up a good finish to issue a challenge inside the final sixteenth and was up in the shadow of the wire to prevail. RAGTIME chased along the inside down the backstretch, waited for BEAUTY REIGNS to advance and tipped out inside the three-eighths marker three wide following that rival, angled eight wide into upper stretch, rallied to issue a challenge taking command nearing the sixteenth marker, dug in under threat to the outside and was caught in the final jumps to the line and forced to settle for the place honors while clear of the rest. BEAUTY REIGNS five then four wide in pursuit, began to advance on the top trio three furlongs out stacking outside those rival at the five-sixteenths, angled six to seven wide into upper stretch set down for the drive, took command just inside the three-sixteenths, dug in under threat and was collared on his way to the sixteenth pole, then kept on to preserve the show honors. LOOK FORWARD broke out at the start bumping CASH CALL, chased just off the inside until tucked inside half a mile from home, came under coaxing tipping back to the two path to move around the backing away ME AND MOLLY MCGEE, continued just off the inside into upper stretch and weakened in the late stages. CASH CALL got bumped at the start by LOOK FORWARD, who broke outwards, chased three then two wide, got let out spinning three wide at the head of the stretch, weakened in the drive. ECHO SOUND broke in at the start brushing ME AND MOLLY MCGEE, pressed that rival from the outside four paths off the inside down the backstretch and then from the two path through the turn coming under urging near the five-sixteenths, took command at that station and took the inside route into upper stretch, got displaced from the front just inside the three-sixteenths and weakened through to the finish. ARTISMA bobbled at the break, prompted the pace five then three wide outside the top pair coming under encouragement with five-sixteenths remaining, angled five wide into upper stretch and weakened in the stretch. ME AND MOLLY MCGEE got brushed at the start while under coaxing from ECHO SOUND, showed the way four then three paths off the inside down the backstretch under pressure from a pair of rivals to the outside, tucked inside into the turn and vied inside a trio and then briefly a quartet before yielding the front with

five-sixteenths to run, spun three wide into upper stretch in retreat, got eased home to the finish, then got pulled up after the finish, was vetted and transported off the track via the equine ambulance.
