THE CLOSER bumped with a rival at the start and was off a half-step slow, moved up while urged along early then tracked the pace on the outside, gained in the four path on the turn, made a bid near the five-sixteenths pole, took the lead coming to the quarter-pole, spun into the stretch in the five path, kicked clear near the three-sixteenths pole, was put to a right-handed crop outside the furlong marker, continued under the crop until inside that marker then was put to a hand-ride before being eased up late while much the best. DARK DEVIL was hustled from the gate, established a good position just off the pace, moved from the two path to the rail very early on the turn, saved ground while asked on that bend, chased the winner under a drive into the final furlong and proved no match while well clear for the place. FISCAL DRAG went to the front, set the pace under pressure to his outside, vied in the two path on the turn, was given his cue inside the five-sixteenths pole, lost the advantage approaching the quarter-pole, dropped back in upper stretch and tired while able to get the show. SPIRIT DOLL stumbled at the start but only conceded a length to the front, chased six paths off the inside down the backstretch and then four wide through the turn coming under encouragement near the quarter pole, swung three then four wide into upper stretch, dug in under a drive issuing a challenge inside the final furlong, came in to look the leader in the eye when taking command seventy yards from home and was flashed the crop to the right side to prevail by a head on the wire. REVEL TOAST four wide in pursuit, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, spun just off the inside into upper stretch and seized command straightened away into upper stretch, inched away under a drive to the eighth pole, dug in under threat, got collared seventy yards from the finish and fought on to the end. STARS AND STRIDES tucked in while taken in hand early, was rated on the inside, shifted to the three path while asked outside the quarter-pole, chased under a strong hand-ride into upper stretch then was given one pop of a left-handed crop, had the rider drop his reins near the three-sixteenths pole then lugged in and bothered an opponent, moved out while chasing the leader and attempting to gather the reins back up, made a bid outside the sixteenth-pole while able to regain some use of the right-rein, took the lead into the final sixteenth and prevailed under a hand-ride to the finish. GRIFFIN'S WHARF settled on the inside, was roused on the far turn, turned into upper stretch under a drive, chased into the final sixteenth, moved out while gaining fast late and finished well but missed while narrowly able to get the place. WINNEBAGO (IRE) broke out and brushed the gate, angled in towards the rear, rounded the first turn in the two path, settled towards the back, was roused in the two then three path on the far turn, swung out to the six path into the stretch and finished with good energy to just miss the place while narrowly able to get the show. VALUATION METRIC was taken in hand early then reserved in the two

path, came under urging on the far turn, was driven into the stretch in the three path and finished willingly to just miss the show. STATES' RIGHTS broke a step slow, went around the first turn in the two then three path, settled towards the rear, was roused in the two path on the far turn, swung out to the five path into the stretch, moved further out around the three-sixteenths pole and improved with late energy. LANDING CRAFT was hustled to the front, showed the way on the inside, was given his cue on the far turn, came under a right-handed crop in upper stretch, led until the sixteenth-pole then was headed by the winner and weakened. CYCLONITE went around the first turn in the two to three path, was reserved off the pace, came under urging in the three path on the far turn, was driven into the stretch in the five path and lacked the needed response. CANDYTOWN was hustled from the gate, raced in the three path on the first turn, was rated on the outside without the benefit of cover, came under urging in the three path on the far turn, moved to the four path late on that bend, chased into upper stretch, dropped back into the final furlong and tired. INSUBORDINATION (IRE) tracked the pace on the outside in the two path, was asked on the far turn, chased into upper stretch, was carried in by the winner inside the three-sixteenths pole then checked, dropped back into the final furlong and capitulated. SOLO VENTURI hesitated and was off a bit slow, was urged along at the rear early, dropped from the three path to the two path on the first turn, lagged at the back, saved ground on the far turn and was no factor. INAMORATA tracked the leader along the inside from just off the pace patiently handled, spun just off the inside into upper stretch and was set down straightened away, tipped out a path three-sixteenths from home, rallied to issue a challenge inside the final furlong and was up in the last seventy yards to prevail. SARATOGA SNOW coaxed from the gate, showed the way in hand along the inside, came under coaxing just off the inside at the five-sixteenths, continued in the two path into upper stretch, dug in under threat and was caught in the final seventy yards and forced to settle for the place honors on the wire. ALITTLEBITNAUGHTY got bumped at the start by HEART COLLECTOR, who recovered outwards from a stumble, saved ground in pursuit from mid pack, came under encouragement at the five-sixteenths, angled five wide for home and offered up a mild kick. PRINCESS SUMMER settled tracking the front just off the inside from mid pack, came under encouragement at the five-sixteenths, went seven to eight wide into upper stretch and offered up a mild kick. LADY DELILAH along the inside through the first turn, chased two then three paths off the inside down the backstretch before heading four wide through the far turn under coaxing from three furlongs out, went six to seven wide into upper stretch and passed tired rivals to the finish. LUCY PLAYA broke out a step at the start, chased two then three wide in closest aim of the leader coming under urging nearing the quarter pole, angled four wide into upper stretch set down for the drive, weakened in the final furlong. KISSED BY KARMA coaxed from the start, chased along the inside under urging from the three-eighths marker, angled five wide into upper stretch and offered no response. MISCHIEVOUS TRICK three then two wide through the first turn, chased two then three wide coming under a ride with five-sixteenths to run, angled six wide into upper stretch and weakened in the drive. HEART COLLECTOR stumbled at the start recovering outwards and bumping ALITTLEBITNAUGHTY, chased along the inside patiently handled until roused taking the inside route into upper stretch and tired through to the finish. DAYTIME DRAMA three then two wide through the first turn, chased three to four paths off the inside down the backstretch, tucked three then two wide through the far turn ridden along from the seven-sixteenths, angled five wide into upper stretch and made no impact.
