GLINT broke in at the start bumping JUST CLARITY, chased five then four wide advancing on the front through the turn coming under coaxing near the quarter pole, swung five wide into upper stretch, took over command with three-sixteenths to go and drew clear under a drive getting geared down in the late stages to the wire. HOURS IN A DAY chased along the inside and then just off the inside coming under encouragement at the seven-sixteenths, angled out five to six wide into upper stretch and kicked on belatedly to the finish. RIDE UP cut the pace from the two path under some pressure from SHIPMAN to the outside, got ridden along three furlongs out, spun three wide into upper stretch and yielded the front with three-sixteenths remaining, then weakened in the late going. EL CORDOBES (IRE) coaxed from the gate, raced forwardly placed tracking along the inside through the first turn, settled under a rating hold and steadily lost position and some ground while on hold behind the cover of a rival while saving ground throughout, got given a notch to work with nearing the quarter pole and angled three wide into upper stretch let out for the drive, offered up a good kick following NATIONS PRIDE until tipped out a path with a stiff right rein inside the eighth pole, split foes taking command a sixteenth from home, then inched away to the finish to score. REBEL RED (GB) coaxed from the start, raced along the inside settled in mid pack, before tipping to the two path into the second turn, tracked just off the inside down the backstretch before heading three wide through the far turn coming under encouragement with five-sixteenths to go, angled five wide into upper stretch, dug in under a drive rallying with good energy willingly through to the finish and was up for the place honors in the final jumps. NATIONS PRIDE (IRE) came out coaxed from the start and traded minor bumps with FAR BRIDGE, raced three wide through the first turn and was forwardly placed tracking the front two to three wide, advanced on the leader half a mile from home given a notch to work with, seized narrow command three furlongs out and came under urging with five-sixteenths to go, swung three then two wide into upper stretch, edged clear under a drive to the eighth pole, dug in under growing threat from a pair of rival, got caught at the sixteenth pole and ran on well clear for the show honors. UTAH BEACH settled just off the inside near the rear of the field, went four then three wide into the second turn before settling once more just off the inside midway, remained patiently handled until set down angled five wide into upper stretch and improved position to the finish. EL REZEEN came inwards coaxed from the gate and traded bumps with FAR BRIDGE, saved ground near the rear of the field patiently handled until let out angled seven wide at the head of the stretch, then passed tired rivals through to the wire. near the three-eighths marker when headed for command at that station, got roused and fully extended nearing the quarter pole, took the inside route into upper stretch and weakened through to the end. PADIDDLE broke out a step at the start, raced just off the inside early on tracking from just off the pace, tipped three wide through the second turn and chased three to four wide thereafter coming under urging nearing the quarter pole, went four wide at the top of the stretch and tired.

LIMES DON'T LIE bumped hard with a rival at the start while also bumping with another foe then was squeezed back, raced towards the rear of the field, went around the turn in the three path, was roused late on that bend, swung out to the six path into upper stretch, rallied outside into the final furlong and closed strongly to get up late and prevail. ALYESKA bumped with a rival just after the start, settled off the pace, rounded the turn in the two path, was asked near the quarter-pole, rallied to makea bid inside the furlong marker. STREET VIEW came outward just after the start, tracked the pace on the outside then in the three path on the turn, took the lead outside the quarter-pole, was asked for her best in the four path in upper stretch, led into the final furlong, lost the advantage to the runner-up outside the sixteenth-pole, fought on well to the finish and just missed while clear for the show. PRACTICAL LOV bumped hard with a rival at the start, was well placed down the backstretch, shifted from the two path to the four path on the turn, chased in the five path into upper stretch and tired. NEXT ON STAGE broke out at the start, settled on the far outside, was roused in the five then six path on the turn, dropped inward in upper stretch and failed to rally. FIDELIGHTCAYUT settled tracking the leader in closest aim from the two path patiently handled until placed to coaxing near the quarter pole, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, rallied to take command a furlong out, dug in gamely to inched away to the wire kept to task. TERMINAL VELOCITY coaxed from the start, showed the way in hand along the inside, got let out taking the inside route into upper stretch, dug in and was collared a furlong out, fought on to the finish and just lasted on the wire for the place honors. CHARLES J lunged at the gate as the latch was sprung, chased along the inside coming under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, spun just off the inside into upper stretch and offered up a mild kick. AMPLITUDE got bumped at the start by SKYLER'S STARSHIP and in turn bumped FINDANAME and pinched that rival back, tracked the pace along the inside from mid pack, came under coaxing at the three-eighths pole, angled four wide into upper stretch and kept on to the wire. EL DE LARRY settled just off the inside near the rear of the field, came under urging near the quarter pole and took the inside route into upper stretch, kicked on belatedly to the finish. ORTUS chased two to three wide coming under encouragement at the three-eighths marker, angled five wide into upper stretch and stayed on one paced through to the finish. A LISTER bobbled after the

break, went three wide through the first turn, chased three wide patiently handled until set down angled six wide into upper stretch, weakened in the drive. SKYLER'S STARSHIP broke out at the start bumping AMPLITUDE into FINDANAME, who got pinched back, chased just off the inside coming under a ride three furlongs out, tipped three wide at the head of the stretch and weakened. TONY O coaxed from the gate, chased three wide under a ride from the seven-sixteenths, angled six wide into upper stretch and tired. FINDANAME got bumped at the start by AMPLITUDE due to pressure from SKYLER'S STARSHIP and was pinched back at the start, chased along the inside coming under a ride at the three-eighths marker, went eight wide into upper stretch and made no impact.
