WORTHY CHARGE bobbled at the break, recovered to duel from the two path and then three path with MOMENTUM FILES early on widening away as a pair from the rest before easing off to prompt that rival midway down the backstretch, had the field take closer order, and went three wide through the far turn advancing to take command with five-sixteenths to go, spun three wide into upper stretch, edged clear under a drive and was kept busy to the finish. CHILLAX stumbled at the start, took to the rail and impeded LIMO forcing that rival to check off his heels just after the break, raced along the inside and tipped out and was forced to steady with six and a half furlongs to go, chased three then two wide coming under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, angled four to five wide into upper stretch, ran on to chase the winner home well clear of the rest and along second best. ROGER ROGER stumbled at the start and was bumped by PEAK PERFORMER due to pressure from PARTY WITH SMARTY, chased just off the inside and then along the inside under a ride from three furlongs out, angled five to six wide into upper stretch and improved position to the end. MOMENTUM FILES struck the near side stall at the start, established the front shortly after and dueled with WORTHY CHARGE to his outside widening away from the rest to the midway point on the backstretch when WORTHY CHARGE eased off a bit, took a little breather and had the field take closer order half a mile from home, came under urging near the five-sixteenths under challenge and yielded the front at that station, took the inside route into upper stretch and weakened in the drive. PEAK PERFORMER broke out at the start and came together with PARTY WITH SMARTY, who broke inwards and was bounced around between foes when initiating contact with ROGER ROGER, chased four then three wide through the first turn and then six paths off the rail down the backstretch, steadily tucked to be four wide heading into the far turn, went four then three wide through that bend under a ride from the half mile pole, angled seven wide at the top of the stretch and tired. LIMO broke a half a beat slow, then got checked off the heels of CHILLAX heading into the bend with seven and a half furlongs to run, chased along the inside and then just off the inside coming under encouragement at the seven-sixteenths, angled five wide into upper stretch and made no impact. FUN TO TAP bobbled at the start, chased three then two wide before tucking inside through the far turn, came under urging three furlongs out, took the inside route into upper stretch and tired. PARTY WITH SMARTY broke in at the start and came together with PEAK PERFORMER and bounced that foe around briefly in tandem with ROGER ROGER, raced three wide through the first turn and then four then three wide down the backstretch before tucking to the two path into the far turn, came under motivation with seven-sixteenths to run, spun two to three wide at the head of the stretch and faltered.

LE GRIS was hustled from the gate, showed speed on the inside of a rival, was eased back along the rail on the first turn then switched outside the leader to the two path, stalked the pace on the outside, was asked some at the seven-sixteenths pole, took the advantage just inside the three-eighths pole, moved clear outside the quarter-pole, responded well under one tap of a down-turned whip in upper stretch, drew away while flagged with the crop under a solid hand-ride into the final sixteenth and proved much the best. LEFTEMBEHIND broke in and bumped with a foe, was caught in the four path on the first turn, moved in early on the backstretch, settled under some restraint, was roused in the two then three path on the far turn, came out to the five path into upper stretch and finished willingly for the place. TIMAEUS was hustled from the gate, showed speed on the outside of a foe, dropped from the two path to the rail while moving clear early on the first turn showed the way down the backstretch, was asked while inside early on the far turn, lost the advantage to the winner just inside the three-eighths pole and stopped. FIRST OF HIS NAME was bumped at the start then urged early, raced in the three path on the first turn, settled outside in third position, dropped back late on the backstretch, faltered in the four path on the far turn, came out into upper stretch and was eased but walked off.

WARALO coaxed from the gate, established the front near the nine-sixteenths and showed the way in hand three then two wide under pressure from TAP TO MISCHIEF early on, shook off that rival midway on the turn and came under coaxing near the quarter pole, took the inside route into upper stretch, edged away under a drive to the eighth pole, dug in under threat and gamely fended off the runner up to score. INNATE (IRE) coaxed from the start, came outwards bumping GREAT LILO, showed the way early on before easing off to chase along the inside, tipped to the two path near the five-sixteenths, swung three wide into upper stretch, traded a bump with TAP TO MISCHIEF at the three-sixteenths, rallied to issue a challenge inside the final furlong getting on near even terms just inside the sixteenth marker, dug in gamely but was repelled and denied to the wire. AFTER TAXES (IRE) chased five then four wide down the backstretch before heading three wide through the turn coming under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, swung four wide into upper stretch and offered up a mild kick. GREAT LILO got bumped at the start by INNATE, chased just off the inside and was bumped and forced to steady briefly just inside five furlongs to go, chased along the inside and was forced to steady once more just inside the five-sixteenths when IRISH GENT came inwards, swung three wide into upper stretch and offered up a mild bid. IRISH GENT (IRE) chased four then three wide down the backstretch, tucked to the two path half a mile from home, came inwards just inside the five-sixteenths when placed to urging and forced GREAT LILO to steady along the rail, spun two to three wide for home, offered up a bid but was outkicked. TAP TO MISCHIEF forwardly placed from the start, ranged up in tandem with WARALO and came inwards bumping GREAT LILO and forcing that rival to briefly steady inside the five furlong marker before overtaking the early leader inside the nine-sixteenths in concert with the new leader, pressed that rival just off the inside and then from along the inside, scraped the paint literally brushing the temporary rail just outside the five-sixteenths, spun just off the inside into upper stretch and traded a bump with INNATE with three-sixteenths to go, then weakened through to the finish.

DREAM ON CARA got bumped and pinched lightly at the start by DANNEEL due to pressure inside from CDAKHATH, chased along the inside down the backstretch before heading three wide into the turn coming under coaxing at the seven-sixteenths, swung three wide into upper stretch, tipped out two paths straightened away and closed outside to issue a challenge inside the final sixteenth and was just up on the wire. MY TWO SOPHIA'S coaxed from the gate, advanced to vie briefly from the two path with a trio before emerging to a sole command, tucked inside into the turn and remained patiently handled until set down spinning three wide into upper stretch, edged clear under a drive to the eighth pole, dug in under growing threat and was nailed on the line. VALENTINE GIFT bobbed at the break, vied briefly from the five path before easing off five furlongs out, tucked three wide into the turn, then tucked to the

two path impeding CDAKHAT and forcing that rival to steady and in turn an additional pair of foes to alter outwards with five-sixteenths to run, swung four wide into upper stretch, kept on to preserve the show honors. HARLAN'S BOND hustled from the gate, got brushed and leaned on after the start by FIVE TO TWO due to pressure from DANNEEL, chased three to four wide coming under coaxing at the three-eighths, altered out at the five-sixteenths following the alter of MOONLIT WEEKEND when CDAKHAT steadied in front, went seven wide into upper stretch and offered up a mild kick. DANNEEL got bumped at the start by DASHING DELLA due to pressure from CDAKHAT breaking outwards and was lightly pinched between foes then came out after the start and placed FIVE TO TWO in tight against HARLAN'S BOND, tucked in and chased along the rail coming under coaxing near the five-sixteenths, took the inside route into upper stretch and weakened. SPICED UP got coaxed from the gate coming inwards and forcing JET SWEEP JOE to steady, chased along the inside and then just off the inside coming under encouragement at the five-sixteenths, angled seven wide into upper stretch, offered up a good kick to close stoutly on the outside and was up with seventy yards to the finish, then prevailed going away at the end. GOVERNOR SAM coaxed from the start, chased two to three wide from just off the duel, got let out swinging four wide into upper stretch, rallied to take command a furlong out, dug in under threat and was caught seventy yards from the finish and forced to settle for the place honors. NO EVIDENCE coaxed from the start, chased along the inside coming under a ride at the five-sixteenths, angled five wide into upper stretch, offered up a mild bid. INNOVATOR chased along the inside coming under urging with five-sixteenths to go, spun three wide at the head of the stretch, offered up a bid a furlong out, kept on to the end. GABALDON coaxed from the gate, dueled three then two wide with ORTLEY AVENUE to his inside, spun three then two wide into upper stretch, seized command near the three-sixteenths, lugged in forcing his main pace rival to pause, got displaced from the front at the eighth pole, then weakened in the late stages. ANCIENT WORLD three wide in pursuit, got coaxed along with

five-sixteenths remaining, angled six wide into upper stretch, weakened in the drive. ORTLEY AVENUE (IRE) fractious in the gate prior to the start, dueled from the two path with GABALDON to his outside down the backstretch, tucked inside through the turn, continued in the inside route into upper stretch, yielded the front straightened away and then paused as his main pace rival came inwards, then weakened through to the finish. JET SWEEP JOE got steadied at the start when SPICED UP came inwards under coaxing, chased just off the inside and then along the inside under urging from the three-eighths marker, cornered just off the inside into upper stretch, trailed throughout.

NO BIEN NI MAL (BRZ) tossed his head at the start then stumbled in the hindquarters, moved up into the first turn, raced in the four path on that bend, settled on the outside, ranged up in the four path on the far turn, made a bid at the five-sixteenths pole, was put to a drive in upper stretch, dueled outside of the runner-up to the finish and gamely prevailed under strong urging. HOP SING was hustled from the gate then angled in while going to the front, showed the way in the two path, was asked under threat on the far turn, came under the crop in upper stretch, dueled gamely inside of the winner to the finish and was denied while well clear for the place. TUSCAN GOLD moved around just before the start then lost his footing slightly, saved ground on the first turn, settled well off the pace, was urged along in the two to three path for most of the far turn then shifted to the four path, was driven into the stretch in the six path and got up for the show. PANDAGATE went around the first turn in the two path, settled well out in the track on the backstretch, was urged along passing the five-eighths pole, traveled around the far turn in the five path, turned into the stretch under a drive and lacked the needed response. MIKEALICIOUS was hustled from the gate, raced in the three path on the first turn, chased the pace on the outside, went around the far turn in the three path and tired. CHILENO was hustled from the gate, rounded the first turn in the two path, settled off the pace, was urged along in the three path on the far turn and failed to respond. TURN AND COUNT navigated the first turn in the three path, settled at the rear, moved from the rail to the three path on the far turn, came out to the eight path into the stretch then drifted further out, raced just off heels into the final furlong then dropped in and was no factor.
