FOUNDERS went around the first turn in the two then three path, settled off the pace, was roused in the four path on the far turn, rallied in the six path into the stretch, gained to make a bid outside the furlong marker, took the lead outside of two foes just inside that marker, came in outside the sixteenth-pole then bumped the un-official runner-up and prevailed under steady urging. WILL NOT BE SWAYED spun out a bit rank into the first turn three wide forcing a trio of rivals out into the first turn four and five wide, settled three wide in pursuit from mid pack, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, angled five wide into upper stretch, rallied to take command just inside the sixteenth marker, then edged clear to the finish kept busy to the end. UNDISPUTED hustled from the gate, showed the way in hand just off the inside and then along the inside under some pressure from TWOHONESTMISCHIEF to the outside, came under coaxing near the quarter pole, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, drew off under a drive to prevail. KAZ OIL CHANGER three wide through the first turn, chased five paths off the inside down the backstretch and then three wide through the far turn, got set spinning three wide into upper stretch, proved no match for the top one while keeping on to secure the place honors. TWOHONESTMISCHIEF prompted the pace of the leader from the outside, four paths off the rail down the backstretch and then from the two path through the far turn, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, spun just off the inside into upper stretch and weakened in the late stages. INSPEIGHTOFCHARLIE four then three wide through the first turn, chased four wide under a ride from the seven-sixteenths, tipped five wide into upper stretch, weakened. SOLO JIM four then three wide through the first turn, chased five wide under urging from the seven-sixteenths, angled three to four wide for home and tired. GOD GIVEN coaxed from the gate, chased just off the inside under encouragement from three furlongs out, cornered just off the inside into upper stretch and was eased home to the finish. DORMELLO raced just off the inside through the first turn and grew detached at the tail of the field, went three to four paths off the inside down the backstretch and through the far turn before heading six wide into upper stretch eased up, then got pulled up inside the eighth pole and was attended to before being walked off under his own power. STATE OF READINESS lunged at the break, chased three then two wide before tucking inside into the far turn, came under coaxing with five-sixteenths to go, suffered an injury nearing the quarter pole, took the inside route into upper stretch and was placed to a protective hold straightened away, then got pulled up near the eighth pole, got attended
