TIZ DASHING tracked the pace along the inside patiently handled until tipped out three wide with five-sixteenths to go put to encouragement, rallied and angled four wide into upper stretch seizing command straightened away, edged clear under a drive to score. CARSON'S RUN got brushed at the break by CUGINO, saved ground at the tail of the field patiently handled until placed to coaxing nearing the quarter pole, got set down spinning five wide into upper stretch, dug in under a drive running on to chase the winner home safe for the place honors. CUGINO tracked the front just off the inside coming under coaxing near the quarter pole, spun three wide into upper stretch flirting with command before being displaced by the top one, kept on to the wire. CAPTURE THE FLAG lightly coaxed from the gate, established the front and showed the way just off the inside through the first turn and then along the inside down the backstretch, continued along the inside through the far turn coming under a ride near the quarter pole, yielded the front spinning just off the inside into upper stretch and weakened in the late stages.

DR. KRAFT bobbled just after the start, moved from the three path to the two path while establishing a forward position on the first turn, stalked the pace on the outside, turned up the pressure in the two path on the far turn, took the advantage outside the five-sixteenths pole, shook clear when asked at the quarter-pole, came under a left-handed crop in upper stretch and drew away under steady urging. CONCORDE SPIRIT stumbled at the start but broke with the body of the field, dropped from the four path to the three path on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along late on the backstretch, chased in the three path on the far turn, turned into upper stretch under a drive and earned the place while no match for the winner. SHADOW DRAGON lost his footing in the hindquarters at the start, dropped from the two path to the inside on the first turn, settled while last but one, was urged along late on the backstretch, went around most of the far turn in the two path then shifted to the three path, came into the stretch under a drive and lacked the needed response while just able to get the show. JACKSON HEIGHTS dropped from the five path to the two path on the first turn, settled on the inside, was urged along on the far turn, moved to the two path late on that bend, swung out to the five path into the stretch and failed to threaten. QUICK TO ACCUSE bumped with PALACE BOSS at the start then was sent hard, brushed with the aforementioned foe early on the first turn, showed the way on the inside, was asked under threat on the far turn, lost the advantage outside the five-sixteenths pole, dropped back into the stretch and tired. PALACE BOSS was restless in the gate, bumped with QUICK TO ACCUSE at the start, brushed with that same opponent early then was taken under a Tight hold, moved from the two path to the inside late on the first turn, settled off the pace, was urged along late on the backstretch, chased inside to the two path on the far turn and came up empty.

JADORLINIJA broke out at the start filling the pace left vacant by the stumbling MOONLIT, established the front and showed the way in hand just off the inside coming under coaxing near the quarter pole, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, dug in under threat a furlong out, rebuffed that challenge and edged clear to the finish to score. HYPNOTICA three wide in closest aim of the leader, remained patiently handled until let out spinning three wide into upper stretch, offered up a bid a furlong out, dug in under a drive and was repelled inside that station while running on to secure the place honors clear of the rest. FULL OF TACT raced just off the inside through the first turn and then four paths off the inside down the backstretch, tucked three then two wide through the far turn under coaxing from the seven-sixteenths pole, angled five to six wide into upper stretch and improved position to the finish. MOONLIT stumbled at the start, chased three then four wide under a ride from the five-sixteenths marker, swung four wide for home and tired. ROMALA chased just off the inside and then along the inside under encouragement from the three-eighths marker, continued in the inside route into upper stretch and tired. EPIC SELLOFF two to three wide through the first turn, chased four then five wide under a ride from the seven-sixteenths pole, swung five wide for home and faltered. MASQUERADEMISTRESS got away to a hesitant start breaking a beat slowed than the field without incident, chased three then two wide under prolonged coaxing from the half mile pole, cornered just off the inside into upper stretch and trailed throughout.

SCALENE got bumped at the start by FIRE MARSHAL, who recovered inwards from an awkward break, chased just off the inside from mid pack, came under urging near the quarter pole and was let out swinging four wide into upper stretch, got on track after a bobble near the eighth pole and closed well outside to get up in the final jumps and prevail. FIRE MARSHAL got away to an awkward start bumping the aforementioned foe, vied briefly before emerging with sole command crossing to the two path, tucked inside near the seven-sixteenths backing down the pace a bit, raced along the inside through the turn and took the inside route into upper stretch, edged clear under a drive to inside the eighth pole, dug in under lone threat and was caught in the final strides to the finish. TINIAN three wide in pursuit, came under encouragement with five-sixteenths to go and continued three wide into upper stretch, dug in over a drive running on to just secure the show honors on the wire. GOLDEN SIREN went to the front, was well rated while setting the pace on the inside, responded well when asked at the quarter-pole, came under a left-handed crop into upper stretch, drew off under a drive into the final furlong, remained under a drive into the final sixteenth then was eased up while much the best. DOVES AND HAWKS raced under restraint while between horses on the opening straightaway, jostled with BELISA nearing the first turn, raced in the three path on that bend, settled off the pace with cover, dropped back while a bit green leaving the backstretch, was roused while moving from the two path to the four path on the far turn, was a bit green again into upper stretch, leveled out inside the three-sixteenths pole and improved to get the place. BELMONT STREET was off a step slow then dropped back early, saved ground on the first turn, lagged well behind under urging, moved from the two path to the four path on the turn, came into the stretch in the six path then moved out to the eight path and also improved while up for the show. ENERGY FLOWS brushed the outside of the gate at the start, went around the first turn in the four then three path, settled on the outside but with cover, was asked while removed from cover near the seven-sixteenths pole, tucked in into the far turn, was roused for more in the two then three path on that bend, turned into the stretch under the crop and also failed to rally. HAVE HOPE was fractious in the gate, tracked the pace on the outside in the three path, was asked late on the backstretch, chased in the three path through the final turn and tired. GANDERELLA brushed with FELIXYN at the start, was taken under a tight hold early, raced a bit off the inside on the first turn, was reserved off the pace, came under urging with just a bit more then three furlongs to run, went around the far turn in the three path, came into the stretch in the five path, chased outside into the final furlong and finished willingly to just get the place. FELIXYN brushed with GANDARELLA at the start, bumped with FIFTY SHADES OF FREE early, settled on the inside, moved to the two path while roused just past the midway point on the far turn, spun into the stretch in the three path then angled out significantly and finished with good energy to just miss the place while clear for the show. ZAP THAT GHOST moved from the rail to the three path on the first turn, stalked the pace on the outside, was asked outside the three-eighths pole, vied in the two path under urging on the far turn, turned into the stretch in the three path, chased into the final furlong and weakened. AMAZING GRACER froze up and was recalcitrant leaving the paddock, moved in behind foes early, became rank off heels and steadied then altered to the outside, accelerated quickly once clear and rushed to the front, dropped to the inside early on the first turn, showed the way through moderate fractions, was asked near the quarter-pole, lost the lead while under the crop in upper stretch and tired. FIFTY SHADES FREE bumped with rivals on both sides early, settled in the two path, was roused on the final turn and failed to threaten. MAGIC IN MY EYES was fractious in the gate, bumped with FIFTY SHADES FREE early, raced in the three path on the first turn, settled on the outside without cover, was roused in the three path on the far turn, came into the stretch in the four path and failed to respond. NO NEED TO PANIC was unsettled in the gate, broke in the air and was off slow, went around the first turn in the three path, settled at the rear, was urged along late on the backstretch, rounded the far turn in the two path and faltered then was eased but walked off.
