BUBSTER broke out at the start, went to the front while dropping from the three path to the two path on the first turn, went clear early on the backstretch then dictated terms, controlled the action in the two path on the far turn, responded well when asked at the quarter-pole, drew off under a left-handed crop in upper stretch, drifted out into the final furlong and widened under strong urging to prove much the best. TERM PREMIUM moved from the four path to the three path on the first turn, tracked the pace on the outside, was asked near the seven-sixteenths pole, chased in the three path on the far turn, turned into upper stretch under a drive and safely secured the place while no match for the winner. UNCLE BARRIE bumped with MODEST MACLEAN at the start then dropped back, rounded the first turn in the two path, settled well off the pace, was roused in the three path early on the far turn then dropped to the two path, remained in the two path under a drive into upper stretch, drifted out under a left-handed crop near the furlong marker, was guided further out approaching the sixteenth-pole and got up for the show. MODEST MACLEAN bumped with UNCLE BARRIE at the start, tossed his head some early, raced in the three path on the first turn, settled while isolated in the middle of the field, moved closer to the front bunch around the nine-sixteenths pole, chased in the four path on the far turn, turned into the stretch under a strong drive, remained on his inside lead while dropping back into the final furlong, swapped to the proper lead when thrown in by the rider outside the sixteenth-pole and weakened. JUST TIPSY bumped with IMPERIAL ANTHEM at the start, showed speed on the inside, was eased back off the pace early on the backstretch, raced just behind the leader, took an awkward stride against the rail outside the five-eighths pole, was asked while saving ground midway through the final turn, chased into the stretch and came up empty. IMPERIAL ANTHEM bumped with JUST TIPSY at the start, dropped back early, saved ground on the first turn, settled at the rear, was urged along late on the backstretch, raced inside to the two path on the far turn, drifted out in upper stretch and was eased in the final furlong but walked off.

ROTHSCHILD broke out at the start under coaxing, showed the way rated along while loping along the inside uncontested until nearing the half mile pole when a pair of rivals made an advance outside, got put to light coaxing and went just off the inside through the far and final turn coming under urging three furlongs from home, spun just off the inside into upper stretch under threat, rebuffed that challenge to surge away inside the eighth pole, then held game to the finish to repel the runner up. ASBURY PARK (GB) saved ground in pursuit from mid pack, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths pole, spun three wide into upper stretch, tipped out two additional paths straightened away, rallied inside the final furlong to latch on the winner as he hit the finish ultimately being repelled to the wire. ARKHIPOV broke in at the start pinching back THE HIDDEN CHAMBER in tandem with SARDIS, raced three wide through the first turn forwardly placed, tracked along the inside past the stands the first time before tracking two to three wide thereafter, advanced on the leader half a mile from home and went three wide through the far turn, continued three wide into upper stretch looming to the outside, got rebuffed inside the eighth pole and kept on to secure the show honors on the wire. MUTAAWID tossed his head at the start, saved ground near the rear of the field, came under encouragement three furlongs out, continued in the inside route into upper stretch and kicked on belatedly to the finish. SARDIS broke out at the start pinching THE HIDDEN CHAMBER in concert with ARKHIPOV, tracked the front just off the inside from just off the pace coming under a ride with five-sixteenths to go, swung four wide into upper stretch and weakened. THE HIDDEN CHAMBER got pinched out between foes who each broke his way, chased along the inside early on and then three wide thereafter coming under urging at the five-sixteenths pole, angled five wide into upper stretch and tired. L'IMPERATOR (FR) saved ground at the tail of the field, came under encouragement three furlongs from home, continued along the inside into upper stretch and made no impact. This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate time.

AMERICAN HISTORY came inward at the start then was hustled, raced off the pace under urging, gained in the five path on the turn, rallied in the four path to make a bid outside of the leader in upper stretch, took the advantage inside the three-sixteenths pole and drew away while kept to the task. ART MUSEUM dropped back early then settled at the rear, was urged along in the six path on the turn, dropped to the five path into the stretch and earned the place while no match for the winner. SHOCKED went straight to the front then was guided in quickly under urging to take the inside from opponents, showed the way down the backstretch, was asked in the two path on the turn, lost the lead to the winner while under a drive in upper stretch and proved no match then was caught for the place but held the show. POWERLINE stood in the gate at dispatch and was off very slow, spotted the front many lengths, started to toss his head about the three-quarter pole, continued to toss his head repeatedly while rank behind horses, went around the turn in the four then five path, was asked just inside the five-sixteenths-pole then checked off heels outside the quarter-pole, was held up behind horses for a few strides then roused in the six path into the stretch and lacked the needed response. BARREL ROLL broke a bit awkwardly and was bumped at the start, settled under some urging, raced between horses passing the five-eighths pole, went around the turn in the three then two path and came up empty. GOT TOUGH bumped with an opponent at the start, rushed up under urging then steadied behind horses around the eleven-sixteenths pole, raced behind traffic, dropped back in tight quarters into the turn then moved from the two path to the inside, steadied at the five-sixteenths pole, went back to the two path while roused coming to the quarter-pole, raced under a drive in upper stretch, dropped back to the rail inside the furlong marker and failed to threaten in a tough trip. NO TIME TO LOSE broke out and brushed the gate, chased the pace on the outside then in the four path on the turn and capitulated. PASS ON BY broke in and bumped with BARREL ROLL, moved up then pressed the pace on the outside of the leader, chased in the three path on the turn and tired. LOUDEN rushed up under urging then checked near the eleven-sixteenths pole when the pacesetter crossed in front, was rated under a strong hold while just behind the leader, came under urging inside the half-mile pole, saved ground on the turn and dropped out.

STIMULATE broke awkwardly then came outward, established a forward position in the three path on the first turn, altered on the lead from the outside, vied in the three then two path on the far turn, moved clear outside the quarter-pole, was put to a drive in upper stretch, drifted out under a left-handed crop into the final furlong, switched to a right-handed crop outside the sixteenth-pole then drifted in and held under steady urging. AND ONE MORE TIME broke out at the start bumping SEGESTA, established the front and showed the way along the inside, the rider adjusting his right side iron briefly under the finish line the first time, raced along the inside through the first turn and then just off the inside down the backstretch settling into a comfortable rhythm through sensible splits, tucked inside three furlongs out and rode the rail through the far turn coming under coaxing with five-sixteenths to go, spun just off the inside into upper stretch and was placed to crossed reined encouragement at the three-sixteenths and began to come outwards under just left handed urging while being flashed a right handed crop, herded out SUNLIT UPLANDS four paths and SEGESTA three paths from the eighth pole to inside the sixteenth marker, got corrected with urging from both hands and then continued being shown the crop through to the wire holding on by a neck when keeping a straight course. PRIME CONNECTION a bit keen early on under restraint just off the heels of HOME WRECKER early on, tracked the pace along the inside until tipped to the two path near the five-sixteenths just after RIYAH AL NIL retreated, angled four wide into upper stretch, rallied to take command three-sixteenths from home, edged clear under a drive to prevail. STAND THE RAIN saved ground near the rear of the field coming under coaxing near the quarter pole, spun two to three wide into upper stretch, closed well to secure the place honors in the late stages. MARY LOIS (IRE) tracked the pace along the inside coming under a ride near the quarter pole, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, ran on through to the finish willingly for the show honors. HOME WRECKER coaxed from the gate, showed the way hard held early on along the inside and was given a notch when RIYAH AL NIL advanced outside into the first turn, got briefly headed for command into the backstretch before advancing once more to take over with half a mile to run, remained along the inside through the far turn and came under coaxing with five-sixteenths to go, spun three wide into upper stretch, got collared with three-sixteenths to run and weakened in the late stages. OSMOSIS (FR) raced just off the inside through the first turn, chased two to three wide from near the rear of the field, came under urging at the five-sixteenths marker, angled out seven wide into upper stretch and passed tired rivals. SECRETLY DELIGHTED tracked two to three wide from mid pack, came under encouragement with five-sixteenths remaining, angled five to six wide into upper stretch and weakened. FANGO CREEK forwardly placed two to three wide, tipped out briefly four wide with seven-sixteenths to go before tucking three wide through the far turn, went four wide into upper stretch and weakened. RIYAH AL NIL broke a beat slow getting away last, then advanced under the wire the first time when the pace was dawdling and went four then three wide into and through the first turn now on even terms for the front, seized command six furlongs from home and held a narrow advantage until headed half a mile out, began to fade at the seven-sixteenths and tucked to the two path and retreated as rivals passed to the inside and outside, swung

four wide for home and was eased home to the finish.
