CONMAN coaxed from the gate, settled just off the inside in pursuit from mid pack, came under coaxing three furlongs from home, angled five wide into upper stretch, dug in under a drive and was up in the last jumps to prevail. ICE CHOCOLAT (BRZ) coaxed from the start, showed the way in hand just off the inside and then along the inside coming under a ride near the quarter pole, spun two to three wide into upper stretch, dug in under a left handed crop and shied out just outside the eighth pole, dug in under a drive and was caught in the final strides to the finish. CLEAR CONSCIENCE coaxed from the gate, chased along the inside coming under encouragement near the quarter pole, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, offered up a mild bid. PRESIDER bobbled after the break for a stride or two, chased just off the inside in closest aim of the leader, came under urging five-sixteenths from home, angled three to four wide into upper stretch, got altered slightly out when ICE CHOCOLAT shied in front near the eighth pole, kept on to the finish but was outfinished in the late stages. BELOUNI (FR) raced a bit keen and off heels of a rival along the inside through the first turn, the rider taking a series of three brief steadying holds to throttle down his charge and take some eagerness out of his stride to settle into the backstretch, chased just off the inside until tucked inside into the far turn, came under coaxing near the quarter pole and angled six to seven wide into upper stretch, kicked on belatedly to the finish. CLASSIC CREATION raced just off the inside through the first turn and then two to three wide thereafter, came under urging near the three-eighths marker, spun just off the inside into upper stretch and came up empty. SARA'S SHAMAN raced just off the inside through the first turn and then three wide thereafter coming under encouragement three furlongs from home, angled six wide into upper stretch and tired.

CHIEF OF PEACE broke in and bumped with AND THE RUNNER IS then leaned on a foe, moved up before the first turn, saved ground while rated just off the pace, was asked with a clear opening at the quarter-pole, chased while coming off the inside in upper stretch then was straightened by the rider, rallied to make a bid inside of foes outside the sixteenth-pole and surged to get up in the final strides and narrowly prevail. AND THE RUNNER IS broke in and hit the gate soundly then bumped with foes, stalked the pace on the outside in the three path while traveling comfortably, turned up the pressure on the far turn, was carried into the stretch in the five path, dueled outside of HARBAUGH into the final furlong then brushed with that foe, fought on into the final sixteenth, battled outside of two rivals late and was denied while just able to get the place. HARBAUGH brushed the gate at the start then bumped lightly with AND THE RUNNER IS, went to the front, showed the way on an easy lead while inside to the two path, came under coaxing while needing extra left-rein pressure to navigate the second turn, spun into the stretch in the four path, dueled inside of AND THE RUNNER IS into the final furlong then brushed with that foe, fought on well into the final furlong, battled between horses late and just missed while able to get the show. BROADCAST tucked in early, rounded the first turn in the two path, was rated outside but with cover, went around the far turn in the three path, swung out to the six path while roused into the stretch, chased outside in the drive, gained gradually late and missed while able to get the last spot in the superfecta. HYPERSCALER broke in then leaned on an opponent and dropped back, was reserved in the two path, moved to the three path late on the far turn, came out to the seven path into the stretch and lacked the needed response. OBLITERATED dropped back while in tight quarters early then moved in, settled towards the rear while inside to the two path, was roused on the final turn and lacked the needed kick. BROADWAY GUY was off slow and spotted the front a few lengths, moved in at the rear, saved ground on the turns and was no factor.

TENNESSEE BELLE chased two to three paths off the inside down the backstretch before tucking inside through the turn, came under coaxing near the quarter pole and spun three wide into upper stretch, closed in angling inwards under a right handed crop to overthrow the leader seventy yards from home, then prevailed going away at the end. VEKOMA'S DIVA hustled from the gate, pressed the pace of CHATTER from the outside in the two path through blistering splits, spun three then two wide into upper stretch seizing command straightened away, shied out under a left handed crop, dug in and was overtaken seventy yards from the finish and kept on to safely preserve the place honors on the wire. TAQDEER lunged at the break and was away last, chased five then four wide under urging from the five-sixteenths marker, tipped six wide into upper stretch and offered up a mild kick. MEG'S FOXY GREY two to three wide in pursuit, came under encouragement three furlongs from home, angled five wide into upper stretch and stayed on one paced to the finish. HOT CURRENCY struck the off side stall at the start, chased inside early on and then two to three wide thereafter coming under coaxing near the quarter pole, swung three to four wide into upper stretch, offered up a bid a furlong out, then weakened in the late stages. MY FIRST DINAH struck the off side stall at the start, chased just off the inside and then along the inside under urging from the seven-sixteenths marker, took the inside route into upper stretch and made no impact. CHATTER brushed the off side stall at the start while under coaxing, cut the pace lightly coaxed along the inside under pressure from VEKOMA'S DIVA to the outside, came under urging near the quarter pole and took the inside route into upper stretch, yielded the front straightened away and tired through to the wire.

Following a twenty minute delay due to inclement weather, ALDER broke a half a beat slow, chased four to five paths off the inside down the backstretch and then just off the inside through the turn coming under coaxing with five-sixteenths to go, angled seven to eight wide into upper stretch, offered up a good finish to close stoutly on the outside and was just up on the wire. FRANKLIN DELANO brushed with a rival at the start then was hustled, drifted out some early, dropped from the four path to the three path on the first turn, tracked the pace on the outside, gained in the three path on the far turn, took over late on that bend, moved clear outside the quarter-pole, spun into the stretch in the four path, drifted out after being put to a left-handed crop outside the furlong marker, was straightened by the rider inside that marker while putting the crop away and held under a strong hand-ride to the finish. EVENLY ALERT went around the first turn in the six then five path, moved in at the rear of the field, saved ground on the far turn, came off the inside in upper stretch and closed with good energy but was too late while up for the place. SALVATION broke out then was hustled, dropped from the five path to the two path on the first turn, was well placed in third position, chased in the two path for most of the far turn then moved to the three path and weakened while well clear for the show. INSTANTLY moved in early, saved ground on both turns, was driven into the stretch in the four path and failed to respond. MELODY MAN was hustled from the gate then came outward some early, dropped in to save ground on the first turn, showed the way down the backstretch, vied two path to the inside on the far turn and faltered then was eased but walked off. ALLEY OOP was restless in the gate, broke a bit slow, went around the first turn in the three to four path, was urged along towards the rear, dropped well behind while going from the two path to the four path on the final turn, came out into upper stretch and was also eased but walked off.
