CLUB REIGN bobbled at the break under coaxing, pressed the pace of ROLL WAVE from the outside four then three paths off the rail down the backstretch before tucking to the two path through the turn, remained patiently handled until roused taking command spinning just off the inside at the quarter pole, drew clear under a drive and was geared down in the late stages. SUBJUGATION bobbled at the break under coaxing, chased just off the inside and then briefly inside before tipping back to the two path, got let out spinning three wide into upper stretch, proved no match for the top one while keeping on to just secure the place honors on the wire. BEAU VALOR bobbled at the start, chased four to five paths off the inside down the backstretch and then three wide through the turn coming under coaxing three furlongs out, angled five wide into upper stretch and kept on to just miss for the place honors on the line. UP TO THE TASK chased three then two wide under urging from the seven-sixteenths marker, spun just off the inside into upper stretch and stayed on one paced to the finish. MISSION INTEGRITY chased five paths off the inside down the backstretch and then three wide through the turn under encouragement from three furlongs out, tipped four wide at the top of the stretch and tired. ROLL WAVE bobbled at the break and came under coaxing to advance inside and seize command five furlongs from home, showed the way along the rail under pressure from CLUB REIGN to the outside, came under light coaxing near the quarter pole and was displaced from the front at that station, cut the corner into upper stretch and tired. EXHIBIT coaxed from the start, chased two to three paths off the inside down the backstretch, tucked inside half a mile from home, came under urging with seven-sixteenths to go, cornered just off the inside into upper stretch and tired.

DR. KAPUR was hustled from the gate then urged along just off the pace, dropped back late on the backstretch and early on the turn, saved ground under strong encouragement on that bend, turned into upper stretch under a drive, rallied under a right-handed crop while finding his best stride in the final furlong and closed with great determination to get up in the final strides and prevail. ANYWAY was well placed down the backstretch, drafted in the two path for most of the turn then dropped to the inside, shifted back to the two path while asked with a clear opening at the quarter-pole, gained to make a bid outside of SCULCOS FOLLY in upper stretch, drifted out some while on even terms for the lead near the furlong marker, took the advantage outside the sixteenth-pole, fought side by side with SCULCOS FOLLY until the final strides, bested that opponent at that juncture but was nailed by the winner. SCULCOS FOLLY broke out and bumped GUN RANGE, moved in while going to the front, set the pace under pressure to his outside, dropped from the two path to the inside early on the turn, was asked at the quarter-pole, began to drift out when put to a left-handed crop outside the furlong marker, lost the lead to the runner-up outside the sixteenth-pole, fought next to that rival until the final strides and was outfinished while clear for the show. CALDO CANDY was urged along towards the rear, went around the turn in the two then three path, came into the stretch in the five path and improved position. EMPHASIS chased the pace on the outside, moved from the four path to the three path early on the turn, dropped back into upper stretch and tired. OIL CAPITAL stumbled at the start then dropped back, moved out just inside the nine-sixteenths pole, was urged along in the five path on the turn, spun into the stretch in the six path and lacked the needed response. UNBROKEN CHAIN was a bit slow into stride, moved out while urged along at the rear, went around the turn in the four path, turned into the stretch in the seven path and was no factor. GUN RANGE was bumped at the start then hustled, pressed the pace on the outside, vied in the three then two path under urging on the turn, dropped back into upper stretch, remained on his inside lead in the drive and faded.

GRAZIE broke out a step at the start and was corrected, prompted the pace outside the top pair four then three wide advancing on the leader nearing the quarter pole, spun three wide into upper stretch and seized command straightened away, went clear under a drive and was geared down in the late stages. CENTRAL TO SUCCESS chased just off the inside coming under encouragement with three furlongs to run, angled four wide into upper stretch, proved no match for the top one and kept on to secure the place honors. LIBERTY'S SECRET buckled at the break, chased three then two wide coming under a ride near the quarter pole, took the inside route into upper stretch and improved position to garner the show honors. FEDUPWITHTHEFED pressed the pace of LIGHTNING STRIKE from the outside three then two wide between rivals coming under urging with five-sixteenths to run, spun three wide into upper stretch and weakened in the final furlong. DANIELLA MARIE broke out at the start and bumped LIGHTNING STRIKE, grew rank along the inside and just off the inside facing kickback from rivals in front, tipped out from the rail to be four wide three furlongs out and then came under urging near the five-sixteenths pole, went eight wide into upper stretch and passed tired rivals to the finish. LIGHTNING STRIKE got bumped at the start by DANIELLA MARIE, showed the way in hand just off the inside and then along the inside under pressure from a pair of rivals, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, yielded the front straightened away and tired. K GUN stumbled at the start, chased two to three wide coming under a ride near the quarter pole, went seven wide into upper stretch and tired. FABIAN'S PRINCESS brushed the off side stall at the start, chased four then three wide under a ride with five-sixteenths to go, went six wide into upper stretch and tired. CLOUDY CHANCE stumbled at the start pecking the ground, chased just off the inside and then along the inside under encouragement from the five-sixteenths marker, angled four to five wide at the head of the lane and tired.

LEADING CHANGE away well from the gate, led early on before easing off to concede the front to NAPOLEON SOLO under the wire the first time, raced along the inside through the first turn and then just off the inside down the backstretch tracking the leader in close range, tucked inside through the far turn and came under coaxing at the three-eighths pole tipping back once more to be just off the inside, angled four then three wide into upper stretch, dug in under a drive to wear down the leader inside the final sixteenth and was up in the final jumps to the finish to score. NAPOLEON SOLO away without incident, raced four paths off the rail past the stands the initial time forwardly placed and narrowly seized the front under the wire the initial time, raced three wide into the first turn and through most of it before tucking briefly to the two path before heading back three paths off the rail down the backstretch, tucked

to the two path into the far turn and remained patiently handled through that bend under hounding from SEA STRIKE to the outside, got set down spinning just off the inside into upper stretch, dug in under a drive edged away to the eighth pole, came under growing threat to the outside and was nailed in the final strides to the wire in a good effort. GOLDEN TEMPO broke in at the start bumping BABY VINO, raced three wide through the first turn growing detached at the rear of the field in tandem with RENEGADE, went three to four paths off the inside down the backstretch before tucking to the two path into the far turn, came under urging with seven-sixteenths to go, angled in and cut the corner nearly scraping the paint on the fence, closed in through to the finish angling out late near the wire. THE PUMA raced just off the inside through the first turn before tipping four paths off the rail down the backstretch, continued four wide through the far turn ridden along from three furlongs out, angled six wide into upper stretch, lugged in a sixteenth from home and kept on to the finish. EMERGING MARKET was a bit eager under a firm hold just off the inside and then along the inside through the first turn and got brushed by BABY VINO from the outside, tracked two then three wide under a ride from three furlongs out, angled five wide into upper stretch, was in behind rivals a furlong out and then drifted out just inside the sixteenth marker and weakened in the late stages. SEA STRIKE broke in at the start and was corrected before making contact with OCELLI, raced three wide through the first turn and then prompted the leader from the outside three then two wide coming under encouragement near the quarter pole, spun three then two wide into upper stretch, dug in prominent to the eighth pole, then weakened in the late going. BABY VINO got bumped at the break by GOLDEN TEMPO breaking inwards, chased just off the inside through the first turn brushing with EMERGING MARKET midway, chased three then two wide under encouragement from the three-eighths pole, angled four wide into upper stretch and weakened in the stretch. RENEGADE lunged at the break and then got pinched back after the start by OCELLI and THE PUMA, raced just off the inside through the first turn growing detached near the tail of the field in concert with GOLDEN TEMPO, chased five then four paths off the inside down the backstretch before tucking three wide through the far turn coming under coaxing with seven-sixteenths remaining, cornered two to three wide into upper stretch and made no headway. OCELLI shied in at the start from SEA STRIKE breaking inwards and pinched out RENEGADE against THE PUMA after the break, raced just off the inside through the first turn and then chased five then four wide coming under urging with seven-sixteenths to run, faded and took the inside route into upper stretch and tired. SILENT TACTIC three wide through the first turn, chased four paths off the rail down the backstretch and then five wide through the far turn and began to retreat from the three-eighths pole, cornered five wide into upper stretch under a light protective hold and was eased home through to the finish well behind, then walked off under his own power.
