CACTUS CLOSER broke out but came out in front then was corrected by the rider, showed the way under pressure to his outside by LOU'S ROOM, was asked at the quarter-pole, came under a left-handed crop in upper stretch, dueled gamely with the aforementioned foe to the finish and narrowly prevailed. LOU'S ROOM broke out at the start, pressed the pace on the outside then in the two path on the turn, was given his cue at the quarter-pole, dueled outside of the winner under a right-handed crop in the stretch, came in closer to that opponent at the sixteenth-pole, fought head and head to the finish and was denied while clear for the place. FOOLIN was well placed just off the pace under light restraint, came under some urging at the seven-sixteenths pole, drafted behind horses while saving ground on the turn, was asked in the two path at the quarter-pole, moved out in upper stretch and lacked the needed kick while clear for the show. FLOWLINE was hustled from the gate, bumped with FEAR NO ONE early, moved out while settling off the pace, was asked leaving the backstretch, chased in the three path on the turn, was driven into the stretch in the four path, moved further out in the drive and tired. SONGBIRD PRINCE (IRE) broke a half-step slow then dropped back, raced greenly around the five-eighths-pole, was rated near the rear while a bit keen, dropped back leaving the backstretch, saved ground while put to urging on the turn, came into upper stretch under a drive and failed to rally. FEAR NO ONE was hustled from the gate, bumped with FLOWLINE early, bucked and lost action just after making contact with that foe then dropped back, was urged along at the rear, went around the turn in the three path and was no factor.

MOMENTUM FILES bobbled at the break and came under coaxing to the front, showed the way in hand along the inside under pressure from GYPSY DREAMING to the outside, shook off that rival nearing the quarter pole and spun three wide into upper stretch, dug in under threat to the outside from TIGER TWENTY FOUR, got brushed by that rival a sixteenth out and held well to the finish to rebuff the challenge to the wire. TIGER TWENTY FOUR coaxed from the gate, chased four then three wide and was given a nudge inside the five-sixteenths marker and advanced outside rivals to swing five to six wide into upper stretch, came under a left handed crop and rallied to loom boldly a furlong out heads apart for command, had the rider switch to the right hand with the crop and shied in slightly and then came in brushing MOMENTUM FILES a sixteenth from home and was ultimately repelled to the finish. CELESTIAL GLAZE chased just off the inside and then along the inside coming under coaxing near the quarter pole, tipped three to four wide into upper stretch and weakened in the late stages. TRIPP'S PROMISE hit the off side stall at the start getting away last, chased two to three paths off the inside down the backstretch, got out into the turn despite being flashed a right handed crop and went five wide three furlongs from home, angled nine wide into upper stretch and made no headway. GYPSY DREAMING bobbled at the break and came under coaxing, prompted the leader from the outside three then two wide under a ride with five-sixteenths to go, got shaken off and went seven to eight wide into upper stretch and tired.

KIPROS broke in and bumped with WARRIOR AT HEART, jostled with HETCH HETCHY early, saved ground while reserved off the pace, tipped to the two path about midway through the far turn, angled out while asked and bumped with HETCH HETCHY outside the quarter-pole, lost some momentum in the process, was roused in the three path straightening into upper stretch, moved out while rallying inside the furlong marker and closed fast to get up late and narrowly prevail. AREQUIPE displayed speed on the inside of GENEVA LAKE, moved clear along the hedge when that foe was taken back on the first turn, opened up a sizable advantage on the backstretch, saw the lead shrink while relaxed into stride near the seven-sixteenths pole, raced inside on the far turn, responded well when asked outside the quarter-pole, led under a drive into the final sixteenth, was guided out closer to two threats late and was denied while just able to save the place in a good effort. TICKET TO FAME settled in the two then three path with cover, was asked on the far turn, came into upper stretch in the four path, rallied outside into the final furlong, closed strongly to make a bid between the top two late and just missed while clear for the show. JACKPOT JACKIE angled in early, saved ground while reserved along the hedge but without cover in front, moved closer with three furlongs to run, was roused on the final turn, turned into upper stretch under a drive and lacked the needed kick. WARRIOR AT HEART hit the outside of the gate then was bumped, saved ground on the first turn, was reserved towards the rear, moved from the two path to the four path on the final turn, was jostled nearing the quarter-pole, came into upper stretch in the five path and lacked the needed response. MAPPED lunged at the start and was off slow, angled in at the rear, saved ground while unhurried at the back, moved out under urging on the far turn, hesitated behind the troubled HETCH HETCHY approaching the quarter-pole then swerved out to the seven path and failed to threaten. GENEVA LAKE showed speed on the outside of the runner-up then became very rank, tossed his head while fighting the rider, was taken back off the pace in the two path on the first turn, switched off some while rated off the pace on the backstretch, moved back closer to the leader around the seven-sixteenths pole, ranged up to make a bid with five-sixteenths of a mile to run, dropped back into upper stretch and came up empty. HETCH HETCHY jostled with KIPROS just after the start, was taken back between horses nearing the first turn, raced in the two to three path under reserve with cover, was bumped by KIPROS outside the quarter-pole and jostled with WARRIOR AT HEART then checked and dropped out.

BRUNCH WITH AMY bobbled at the start, moved up with five furlongs to run, chased while going from the two path to the four path on the turn, rallied outside to make a bid coming to the furlong marker, took the lead inside that marker, went clear in the final sixteenth and was eased up late. POCKET QUEENS was hustled from the gate, dropped back early, angled in near the three-quarter pole, went around the turn in the four then five path, swung out to the seven path into the stretch then dropped in some, was guided back out around the furlong marker and improved with late energy to garner the place. MIDNIGHT CONCERTO settled towards the rear on the inside, was asked near the quarter-pole, tipped to the two path into upper stretch then steadied awaiting room at the three-sixteenths pole, squeezed through between foes then made a bid, took the lead just inside the furlong marker, battled gamely to the finish and narrowly prevailed under strong urging. BEING BETTY acted-up just as the gate opened and was off slow, saved ground at the rear while inside to the two path, moved out to the four path late on the far turn, swung out to the seven path into upper stretch, rallied outside to make a bid in the final sixteenth, fought outside of two foes to the finish and just missed while narrowly able to get the place. SAIL WITH THE WIND was reserved in the two path, swung out to the five path into upper stretch, rallied to make a bid inside the furlong marker, battled between the top two late and just missed while clear for the show. AWESOME CZECH moved in towards the rear early, became rank behind a foe under restraint nearing the first turn, was reserved in the two to three path, lacked room behind a wall of horses while under urging in upper stretch, angled out while on her inside lead coming to the furlong marker, swapped to the proper lead while chasing behind horses outside the sixteenth-pole, came into the final sixteenth between horses and improved to just get

the last spot in the superfecta. MARVELOUS MADISON went around the first turn in the two path, settled outside without cover, was asked in the three path on the far turn, came out to the six path into upper stretch, chased in the drive and just missed the superfecta. BERNIETAKESCHARGE dropped from the two path to the inside early on the first turn, settled in third position, was asked in the two to three path on the far turn, gained to make a bid in upper stretch, battled under a drive into the final sixteenth and was out-kicked. SPINNING COLORS showed speed on the inside of BROKEALLTHERULES, was taken back along the hedge early on the turn then moved to the two path, stalked outside on the backstretch, was given her cue in the two path on the far turn, made a bid between horses near the three-sixteenths pole, dropped back into the final sixteenth and weakened. BROKEALLTHERULES showed speed on the outside of SPINNING COLORS, went clear while dropping from the two path to the inside early on the first turn, showed the way while in hand, was asked near the quarter-pole, lost the advantage in upper stretch and gave way.

PEPPERMINT TWIST raced along the inside through the first turn, and then three to four paths off the inside down the backstretch pulling eager when put to a firm hold as the once spurting leader slowed down drastically in front taking a hard hold, got nearly on even terms at the nine-sixteenths marker before the leader got a length clear once more, tucked to the two path through the far turn, got set down spinning two to three wide into upper stretch and seized command near the three-sixteenths pole, then drew clear under a drive to score. MAJESTIC MOONLIGHT settled just off the pace tracking three then two wide, came under coaxing near the quarter pole and spun three wide into upper stretch, proved no match for the top one and ran on to secure the place honors. MISS TWITTER led early on before easing off as ONE BAD HABIT went on with it, tracked that rival just off the inside and then along the inside coming under coaxing near the quarter pole, got stymied when stuck behind that rival taking the inside route into upper stretch unable to tip out, gained clearance as the inside opened up inside the three-sixteenths marker and ran on willingly through to the finish to just get up for the show honors in the final jumps. INDOMIKNOW (IRE) raced two to three wide through the first turn, chased three wide coming under a ride near the quarter pole, swung four wide into upper stretch and kept on to the finish. DELTA CODE chased just off the inside from near the rear of the field, came under urging near the quarter pole and spun three wide into upper stretch, improved position to the wire. LEGAL SQUEEZE raced three then four wide through the first turn, chased four then three wide patiently handled until set down angled five wide into upper stretch, then offered no response. GOOD GHOST raced just off the inside through

the first turn and then chased three wide coming under a ride at the five-sixteenths pole, angled five wide into upper stretch and passed tired rivals. PORTIXOL raced just off the inside through the first turn, chased along the inside and then just off the inside coming under a ride near the quarter pole, spun two to three wide into upper stretch and weakened. NO DIFFERENCE chased along the inside coming under a ride with five-sixteenths to go, took the inside route into upper stretch and made no impact. ONE BAD HABIT coaxed from the gate, knocked heads briefly with MISS TWITTER before spurring away three then two wide through the first turn, came under hard hold into the backstretch getting throttled down and having the field take quick closer order, got given a nudge when PEPPERMINT TWIST got on near even terms and opened back to a safe command down the rest of the backstretch, tucked inside through the far turn coming under coaxing near the quarter pole, took the inside route into upper stretch, yielded the front straightened away and tired.
