DESPO'S DREAM coaxed from the gate, dueled from just off the inside and then along the inside coming under coaxing with five-sixteenths to go, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, dug in stubbornly to repel her main pace rival and score safely on the wire. LIKA ROLLING STONE dueled from the outside three then two wide coming under a ride near the quarter pole, spun three wide into upper stretch, dug in under a drive and was ultimately repelled inside the final sixteenth while just holding for the place honors on the line. TOUGH STREET chased just off the inside coming under encouragement near the quarter pole, swung four wide into upper stretch, dug in running on and just missed for the place honors at the finish. ADRIAN just off the inside through the first turn, chased three wide under a ride from the seven-sixteenths marker, angled seven wide into upper stretch and kept on to the finish. BABY SASSICAIA broke out at the start bumping MURSAL and then got pinched back by PINK ROSE breaking outwards, chased along the inside coming under urging three furlongs out, took the inside route into upper stretch and stayed on one paced through to the end. MURSAL got bumped at the start by BABY SASSICAIA, chased four wide under a ride from the three-eighths pole, tipped five wide into upper stretch and weakened in the final furlong. PINK ROSE broke out at the break pinching back BABY SASSICAIA against MURSAL, chased four then three wide just off the duel up front, came under encouragement three furlongs from home, swung four to five wide into upper stretch and weakened.

SLICKBACK bumped lightly with KNEE HIGH at the start, settled towards the front on the outside, was given his cue in the five then four path on the turn, gained to make a bid at the quarter-pole, battled outside of two foes into the final furlong then duelled with the runner-up, lugged in under extra right-rein pressure coming to the sixteenth-pole then swapped back to his inside lead, fought with the runner-up to the finish and narrowly prevailed. TROCA pressed the pace on the outside, vied in the four then three path on the turn, was asked for his best in upper stretch, battled with two opponents into the final furlong, duelled with the winner to the finish and just missed while clear for the place. BORAGO angled in while urged along at the rear, moved from the inside to the three path on the turn, swung out to the seven path into upper stretch and improved to get the show. CRYPTO KING was urged along towards the rear, went around the turn in the three then four path, came into upper stretch in the six path and also improved but missed the show while just up for the last spot in the superfecta. BARDEN chased the pace on the outside, went around the turn in the two path, came into upper stretch in the four path and tired. RUFUS THE RED was hustled from the gate, moved up just off the pace, raced off heels near the seven-sixteenths pole, saved ground on the turn, came through along the rail to make a bid approaching the five-sixteenths pole, was roused for his best into upper stretch, battled inside of the top two under a drive into the final furlong and weakened. KNEE HIGH made mild contact with SLICKBACK at the start, was urged along on the outside, moved in behind horses around the half-mile pole, traveled around the turn in the two then three path, swung out to the five path into upper stretch and lacked the needed response. BE IN MONTY'S MIND was urged along towards the back, checked between horses in the two path early on the turn then bobbed while dropping back, shifted to the three path shortly thereafter, came out to the five path into the stretch, moved further out while well out in the course near the furlong marker

and was no factor. HYPERBOREAN SPIRIT broke a step slow, settled well back under some urging, raced off heels under extra left-pressure early on the turn, was roused while saving ground on that bend, turned into upper stretch under a drive and failed to threaten. BLACKJACK showed speed and went to the front, set the pace under pressure to his outside, vied in the two path on the turn, lost the lead late on that bend, dropped back into upper stretch and tired.

FATEFUL LIGHTNING broke a beat slow without incident, chased along the inside and then just off the inside under prolonged urging from the half mile pole, swung four wide into upper stretch, rallied to take command a furlong out, edged clear to the finish kept to task. EZ ROLL chased along the inside under encouragement from three furlongs out, angled six wide into upper stretch, offered up a mild kick to secure the place honors. GET A JOB broke out at the start and was corrected, led along the inside early on before being displaced from command by NUANCED into the backstretch, tipped out to chase four paths off the inside down the backstretch before tucking three then two wide through the far turn coming under coaxing near the quarter pole, spun just off the inside into upper stretch and seized command straightened away, got collared a furlong from home, then weakened in the late stages while just preserving the show honors on the line. BARKER coaxed from the gate, chased three then two wide until tucked inside through the far turn, came under a ride with five-sixteenths to go, spun two to three wide into upper stretch, weakened in the late stages, then got attended to and vetted after unsaddling seeming to be effected by the heat and was cooled down on the walk back with ice and water while walking off under his own power. LUZ DE GUIA chased four to five paths off the inside down the backstretch, went four then three wide through the far turn under coaxing from the seven-sixteenths marker, angled seven wide into upper stretch, offered up a bid a furlong out, then made no late headway. NUANCED struck the off side stall at the start getting away near the rear of the field, pulled keenly five then four wide through the first turn tucking briefly three wide before seizing command with six and a half furlongs to run, showed the way three paths off the rail down the backstretch under a rating hold, got given some rein nearing the far turn and tucked to the two path through that bend before coming under coaxing near the quarter pole, took the inside route into upper stretch under threat to the outside, yielded the front straightened away and tired through to the finish. FIDDLING FELIX chased three wide down the backstretch and then five wide through the far turn under prolonged urging from the half mile pole, went eight wide into upper stretch and tired.

SUNNY BIRD bumped with a rival at the start, moved in while establishing a prominent early position, saved ground while rated just off the pace, was asked on the far turn, moved to the two path late on that bend, gained to get the lead into upper stretch, shook clear inside the three-sixteenths pole, raced under the crop into the final furlong then had the rider put the crop away and drew away under a strong hand-ride to prove much the best. NEVER GONNA STOP (IRE) moved in while going to the front, showed the way while two path to the inside, was asked late on the far turn, lost the advantage to the winner into

upper stretch and proved no match while clear for the place. ALL SHOW angled in early, tucked into the two path for the run around the first turn, settled near the middle of the field, was roused in the three path on the far turn, turned into upper stretch under a drive and lacked the needed response while along for the show. KUPUNA broke out at the start bumping PASS THE HAT, showed the way in hand just off the inside through sensible splits patiently handled until roused angled four wide into upper stretch, edged away and shied out three paths under a left handed crop to the sixteenth pole, then drifted out a path when under correction inside that station and dug in straightened and just lasted on the wire. PASS THE HAT got bumped at the break by the aforementioned foe, settled three wide in closest aim of that rival coming under encouragement with five-sixteenths to go, angled four wide into upper stretch, dug in under a drive and just missed on the wire. UNCLE'S GOLD got bumped at the start by RISK TOLERANCE breaking inwards, raced three then two wide through the first turn before heading four then three paths off the inside down the backstretch, went three wide through the far turn coming under coaxing near the quarter pole, angled five wide into upper stretch, dug in under a drive and very briefly paused as KUPUNA drifted out safely clear just inside the sixteenth marker, then missed at the finish. RISK TOLERANCE (IRE) broke in at the start bumping UNCLE'S GOLD, chased just off the inside under a ride from the five-sixteenths pole, continued just off the inside into upper stretch and kicked on belatedly to the end. TAKING CANDY raced just off the inside through the first turn and then three wide thereafter patiently handled until set down angled six to seven wide into upper stretch, then offered up a mild bid but was outfinished. FORT WASHINGTON settled at the tail of the field along the inside through the first turn before tipping three paths off the rail down the

backstretch, tucked to the two path through the far turn and came under encouragement with five-sixteenths to run, swung four wide into upper stretch, offered up late foot to close in but could not impact the top spots before the finish. SALAMIS settled tracking just off the inside from just off the pace, came under urging with five-sixteenths to go, spun three wide into upper stretch and weakened in the late stages. RUNNING BEE raced just off the pace three wide through the first turn and then four wide thereafter, came under urging near the quarter pole and continued four wide into upper stretch, then weakened in the stretch.

FOTO went around the first turn in the four path, settled with cover, was roused while going from the three path to the five path on the far turn, brushed with

OSIRIS LAW outside the quarter-pole, rallied outside in upper stretch, closed strongly to make a bid at the furlong marker, took the lead outside the sixteenth-pole and held under strong urging. BEFORE THE WIND was caught out in the five path on the first turn, settled outside without cover, was asked in the four path on the far turn, rallied in upper stretch, closed well to get the lead inside the furlong marker, lost the advantage to the winner outside the sixteenth-pole, fought with that foe to the finish and missed while able to get the place. GILBANE was taken under a strong hold early, tucked from the three path to the two path on the first turn, was reserved with cover, navigated the far turn in the three path, steadied behind traffic coming to the quarter-pole, was roused in the four path into the stretch, moved out around the furlong marker and improved with good energy to get the show. FRESH START jostled with SURFSIDE DAN early, was rated on the inside, came under intermittent urging on the final turn, was roused at the quarter-pole then turned into upper stretch under a drive and finished willingly for the last spot in the superfecta. BEAU CHEVAL was taken under a tight hold early then rated while saving ground, rounded the second turn in the two path, raced behind horses coming to the quarter-pole, was roused into upper stretch, moved out in the vicinity of the furlong marker and lacked the needed kick. SURFSIDE DAN was hustled from the gate then jostled with foes on both sides early, went to the front, showed the way on the inside, was asked on the far turn, led under a drive into the final furlong then was headed by BEFORE THE WIND and gave way. MO CURLS jostled with SURFSIDE DAN early then was taken under a snug hold, became rank nearing the first turn, moved from the inside to the three path while continuing rank on that bend, tracked outside on the backstretch, chased in the three path on the far turn, made a bid between horses outside the quarter-pole, battled under a drive into the final furlong and tired.
