DOMESTIC AGENDA raced just off the inside through the first turn before settling three wide in aim of the leader down the backstretch, tucked to the two path through the far turn and came under encouragement with five-sixteenths to go, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, lugged in straightened away and nudged MAY DECEMBER, rallied inside the final furlong surging late to get up in the final jumps to the finish. CHARLOTTE'S BEACH established the front after the break and was a bit keen and pulling early on while under a hold, showed the way settled in hand just off the inside and then along the inside three furlongs from home, remained patently handled until roused taking the two path into upper stretch, edged clear to the eighth pole, dug in under late threat to the inside and was caught in the final strides to the wire. SHARED SERVICES got carried in at the break by BASHFULLY, who broke inwards, chased just off the inside from near the rear of the field, came under coaxing along the inside near the quarter pole and angled four wide into upper stretch, angled out a path and rallied shying in under a right handed crop inside the eighth pole and kicked on belatedly to the finish. QUEEN PAOLA raced along the inside through the first turn, chased three then two wide coming under a ride near the quarter pole and tipped four wide into upper stretch, kept on to the end. FLAMENCO bobbed at the break and lost her lane at the start when SHARED SERVICES got carried in front by BASHFULLY, strode greenly along the inside from the tail of the field through to midway down the backstretch, continued along the inside through the far turn and spun two to three wide into upper stretch, was under vigorous hand urging when shying in inside the eighth pole seemingly in reaction to SHARED SERVICES to her outside and showed some late interest to the wire. LA PATRONNE (FR) got away last and was coaxed from the gate, raced just off the inside through the first turn and then three paths off the inside down the backstretch, went three then two wide through the far turn under urging from the three-eighths marker, angled five wide for home and had no kick. MAY DECEMBER chased forwardly placed just off the inside and then along the inside under a ride with five-sixteenths to run, took the inside route into upper stretch, got nudged by DOMESTIC AGENDA lugging in straightened away and tired. BASHFULLY broke in at the start carrying SHARED SERVICES into the lane of FLAMENCO, got steadied when pinched out lightly between foes one mile from home racing just off the inside through the first turn, tipped four paths off the rail down the backstretch in the clear, tucked three wide through the far turn before heading six wide into upper stretch and tired.

CARMEN AMALIA pressed the pace on the outside, drew even with the leader late on the backstretch, took the lead in the three path early on the turn, dropped to the two path late on that bend, responded well when asked near the quarter-pole, raced under a strong hand-ride into the final furlong then was put to a left-handed crop and held under steady urging. OKAY ANNIE broke in but came out in front then was hustled, was well placed while rated just off the pace, drafted inside early on the turn, was shuffled back behind a tiring LADY VORTEX from the five-sixteenths pole to the near the quarter-pole, tipped to the two path in the process, was asked then came in to upper stretch in the four path, angled out while gaining inside the three-sixteenths pole, rallied outside into the final furlong and closed well to just miss while able to get the place. A LITTLE PRESLEY dropped back after breaking well then settled off the pace, was asked while going from the three path to the five path on the turn, moved closer late on that bend, chased outside in the stretch and finished with good courage to get the show. ALLEGRO BRILLANT moved up under urging then was taken in hand near the nine-sixteenths pole, tugged keenly on the bit while hard held from that point into the turn, drafted in the two path on that bend, was asked with clear space in front at the quarter-pole, chased under a drive in the stretch and lacked the needed kick while able to get the final spot in the superfecta. PROMISE ME AMELODY bumped with MIDNIGHT HONOR at the start, was urged alone on the outside, chased in the four path on the turn, spun into the stretch under the crop, remained on her inside lead until inside the three-sixteenths pole then swapped to the proper lead while pulled in by the rider, pursued the winner between horses into the final furlong and weakened. SPARKS WILL FLY dropped back outside the five-eighths pole then moved in, went around the turn in the four path, turned into the stretch in the six path and lacked the needed response. MIDNIGHT HONOR bumped with PROMISE ME AMELODY at the start then dropped back, moved in at the rear inside the five-eighths pole, traveled around the turn in the two path, spun into the stretch in the four path and was no factor. LADY VORTEX showed speed then set the pace on the inside of the winner, lost the lead while inside early on the turn and stopped.

COMMUTED chased three to four wide coming under a ride three furlongs from home, angled six wide into upper stretch, bumped the backing away TRUST ISSUES in concert with BABY YODA straightened away, rallied with a rush to overthrown the leader inside the eighth pole, then prevailed geared down going away at the end. MISCHIEVOUS M hustled from the gate, cut the pace just off the inside and then along the inside under pressure from PAIR OF SOCKS to the outside, took the inside route into upper stretch, got caught inside the eighth pole and ran on to safely preserve the place honors on the line. PAIR OF SOCKS coaxed from the gate, pressed the pace of the aforementioned foe from the outside three then two wide coming under encouragement with five-sixteenths remaining, spun three wide into upper stretch, ran on to procure the show honors. BABY YODA a bit fractious in the gate prior to the start, chased along the inside and then just off the inside under a ride from three furlongs out, angled five wide into upper stretch and kept on to the finish. RUN CLASSIC chased five wide under a ride from three furlongs out, went eight wide into upper stretch, made no headway. INEXORABLE brushed the off side stall at the start, chased just off the inside under urging from the seven-sixteenths marker, angled four to five wide for home and made no impact. TRUST ISSUES brushed the off side stall at the start, chased five then four paths off the inside down the backstretch before tucking three wide through the turn coming under coaxing three furlongs from home, angled five to six wide into upper stretch, was in the midst of backing away when bounced around between BABY YODA and COMMUTED, then continued weakening through to the finish.

TIGER LINE broke in under coaxing at the start and was corrected, showed the way in hand along the inside under increased pressure from NIGHT SKY to the outside, came under coaxing near the quarter pole before being set down spinning just off the inside into upper stretch, inched away to the eighth pole, dug in and held well to the finish. MADLINE'S PROMISE coaxed from the gate, chased briefly inside before tipping three paths off the rail down the backstretch, tucked to the two path through the turn and remained patient while the leader widened away, came under coaxing with five-sixteenths to go, swung four wide into upper stretch, rallied to take command straightened away, edged away to inside the eighth pole, dug in under threat from a pair and held on to prevail on the line. NONNA LYNNE broke through the gate prior to the start and inspired her barn mate CONSENSUS VIEW to do the same, got brought back around and reloaded, tracked the front just off the inside from just off the pace coming under coaxing near the quarter pole, continued in the two path into upper stretch set down for the drive and offered up a mild bid. GUM saved ground in pursuit from mid pack, came under urging with five-sixteenths to go, took the inside route into upper stretch, ran on through to the finish but was outfinished. CONSENSUS VIEW (GB) broke through the gate just after NONNA LYNNE did, tracked the front from the two path from mid pack patiently handled until roused angled five wide into upper stretch, then stayed on one paced through to the end. PRIME CONNECTION grew a bit fractious in the gate just after a pair of rivals broke through their stall doors, broke in at the start trading a bump with SO DARN PRETTY, settled tracking that rival in closest aim from the outside in the two path, came under coaxing near the quarter pole and continued just off the inside into upper stretch, drifted out slightly to the three path opening a seam in to the inside with three-sixteenths to go, then weakened in the final furlong. LADY FIREFOOT three wide through the first turn, settled three wide tracking from just off the pace down the backstretch, continued three wide through the far turn under coaxing from three furlongs out, continued three wide for home and weakened in the stretch. TRAIL OF GOLD saved ground at the tail of the field coming under coaxing with five-sixteenths to run, angled four wide into upper stretch and offered no response. CELESTIAL EXPRESS broke out at the start and was corrected, raced four then three wide through the first turn, chased three wide coming under a ride with three furlongs to go, angled seven wide at the top of the stretch and tired.
