DISPARATE IMPACT showed speed then chased the pace on the outside, moved from the four path to the three path early on the turn, gained to make a bid outside the quarter-pole, took the lead in the four path into the stretch, shook off WARNOCK inside the furlong marker, drifted out under a left-handed crop coming to the sixteenth-pole, swapped back to his inside lead while switched to a right-handed crop about seventy yards from the finish and held under strong handling. THE STANDARD was hustled from the gate, showed speed then chased on the outside, moved in late on the backstretch, went around the turn in the three path, was driven into upper stretch in the five path, pursued the leader on the outside into the final furlong, drifted out under a left-handed crop outside the sixteenth-pole then switched to a right-handed crop, gained to make a bid late but missed while clear for the place. WARNOCK showed speed then set the pace on the inside of a rival, dropped from the two path to the inside early on the turn, was asked under threat late on that bend, spun into the stretch in the three path then lost the advantage to the winner, battled inside that foe under a drive into the final furlong and weakened but was clear for the show. TORRE EIFFEL came out at the start then bumped with HOLDING POWER while being corrected, lacked speed while urged along towards the rear, moved from the inside to the two path late on the turn, came into the stretch in the three path and lacked the needed response while able to get the last spot in the superfecta. NORDIC FYRE was urged along off the pace, moved in late on the backstretch, went around the turn in the three then four path, came into the stretch in the six path and also lacked the needed response. HOLDING POWER was bumped at the start and forced out into another foe then pinched back, was urged near the rear before being taken in hand behind horses inside the nine-sixteenths pole, went around the turn in the two then three path while let out then roused, turned into upper stretch in the two path under a drive and failed to rally. POWER SPEED bumped with CRAZY BUSTED at

the start, was urged along off the pace, dropped back in the two path on the turn and failed to respond. CRAZY BUSTED bumped with POWER SPEED at the start, showed speed then pressed the pace on the outside, dropped back in the three then two path on the turn and tired. ZENORO bobbed ever so slightly at the start then was bumped in the hindquarters, raced at the rear under urging, rounded the turn in the two path and trailed.

PLAY WITH FIRE brushed the near side stall at the start and then brushed REINING FLOWERS, tracked the front two then three wide patiently handled until set down angled five then four wide into upper stretch, rallied to take command a furlong out, inched away to the finish kept to task. POP ART settled tracking the leader in closest aim just off the inside, came under encouragement with five-sixteenths to go, spun two to three wide into upper stretch, dug in fighting on to the finish to secure the place honors. INEFFICIENCY coaxed from the gate, showed the way in hand along the inside coming under a ride near the quarter pole, took the inside route into upper stretch, dug in and was collared a furlong out, ran on to preserve the show honors. UNREASONABLE (IRE) coaxed from the start, tracked the front just off the inside patiently handled until set down angled four then three wide into upper stretch and weakened in the late stages. REINING FLOWERS got brushed at the break by PLAY WITH FIRE, chased along the inside and then just off the inside under urging from the five-sixteenths pole, angled six to seven wide into upper stretch and made no impact. ALLAMERICANBEAUTY tracked the pace along the inside under encouragement from the five-sixteenths marker, spun two to three wide for home and weakened in the stretch.

WITH A KISS pressed the pace on the outside then in the three path on the turn, took the lead at the quarter-pole, kicked clear in upper stretch, drifted in under a right-handed crop near the furlong marker then was straightened by the rider, was switched to a left-handed crop into the final sixteenth and just held under steady urging. STAR ACTRESS was well placed down the backstretch, went around the turn in the two path, was given his cue outside the quarter-pole, moved out under a drive in upper stretch, rallied under a left-handed crop into the final furlong, closed well to make a bid in the final sixteenth, fought outside the winner to the finish and just missed. ROMAN GRACE was hustled from the gate, set the pace under pressure her outside, vied along the rail on the turn, was asked outside the five-sixteenths pole, lost the advantage to the winner at the quarter-pole and tired. LOVELY CHRISTINA veered out at the start and was a bit awkward into stride, chased the pace on the outside then in the four path on the turn, made a bid outside the five-sixteenths pole, dropped back under a drive in upper stretch and weakened. STREET VIEW stumbled at the start and was last away, settled under some urging, was roused for more in the three path on the turn, spun into the stretch in the four path and was no factor. NEXT ON STAGE tossed her head at the start but broke with the body of the field, settled off the pace, was urged along late on the backstretch, traveled around the turn in the three then four path, came into the stretch in the five path and failed to rally. ROMANTIC DANCER dropped back while urged along, moved in with about five furlongs to run, saved ground on the turn, came into the stretch in the three path, moved back to the rail around the three-sixteenths pole and failed to threaten.

PELICAN PRIDE was taken under a tight hold early then rated just off the pace on the inside, drafted behind horses on the far turn, shifted to the three path while asked at the quarter-pole, rallied to the lead in upper stretch, shook clear inside the furlong marker and held under strong urging. SKY LOW LOW moved in towards the rear, shifted from the two path to the four path early on the first turn, settled near the rear, was roused in the four path on the far turn, came into the stretch in the six path, rallied outside into the final furlong, drifted in while closing well late and missed while clear for the place. WHATTA WEEKEND showed early speed, dropped from the two path to the inside while keen inside of DANCING MIRACLE on the first turn, was taken back off the pace then switched to the outside and tracked, made a bid outside of the leader in the two path on the far turn, took the advantage at the top of the stretch, lost the lead to the winner inside the three-sixteenths pole and weakened but just held the show. OHONTE'S OWN got brushed at the break by ENGRAVED due to pressure from DAISY DOO breaking outwards, raced three wide through the first turn and settled three wide down the backstretch just off the pace, continued three wide through the far turn coming under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, went

three wide into upper stretch, rallied to take command near the three-sixteenths, edged clear to inside the eighth pole, dug in under late threat and repelled the rival to the wire. KOTLIKOFF three wide through the first turn, chased four wide under a ride with five-sixteenths to go, angled out seven wide into upper stretch, rallied through the final furlong but was ultimately rebuffed at the finish. TIZIO tracked the pace along the inside coming under a ride with five-sixteenths to go, took the inside route into upper stretch and got forced to pause and then briefly steady in behind MAIN THING, tipped to the two path brushing with ENGRAVED just outside the eighth pole gaining clearance just inside that station and offered up a mild kick under a light drive in the late stages to secure the show honors. TANGO TANGO raced off the heels of a rival hard held just off the inside through the first turn, tracked two to three wide in pursuit from mid pack, came under coaxing with five-sixteenths to go, tipped four wide into upper stretch and kept on under a drive to the finish. IRISH GOODBYE broke a half a beat slow, raced just off the inside through the first turn and then three wide thereafter, came under urging at the seven-sixteenths pole, went seven wide into upper stretch and improved position to the finish. DAISY DOO broke out at the start bumping MAIN THING into ENGRAVED, raced two to three wide into the first turn and was carried out four wide through that bend by MY TOGO, chased four wide thereafter coming under encouragement with five-sixteenths to go, swung six wide into upper stretch, kept on to the finish but was outfinished. MY TOGO broke out at the start and was corrected, raced briefly along the inside before floating out three wide through the first turn carrying out the aforementioned rival four wide, chased three then two wide under a ride with seven-sixteenths to run, continued three wide into upper stretch and stayed on one paced to the finish. COURAGEUX tracked the pace along the inside and then just off the inside under urging from the seven-sixteenths marker, angled seven to eight wide into upper stretch and showed late interest closing in belatedly to the end. TWENTY ONE RED raced off the heels of a rival along the inside through the first turn, then got steadied when a bit keen once getting some clearance, got taken in hand once more straightened away into the backstretch before settling, tracked the pace along the inside coming under a ride near the quarter pole, spun just off the inside into upper stretch and offered no response. ENGRAVED got bumped at the start by MAIN THING due to pressure from DAISY DOO, came under coaxing and settled just off the inside in closest aim of the leader, came under encouragement at the five-sixteenths pole, continued just off the inside into upper stretch and weakened. MAIN THING got bumped at the start by DAISY DOO breaking outwards and in turn bumped ENGRAVED, showed the way in hand along the inside patiently handled until roused taking the inside route into upper stretch, got collared with three-sixteenths remaining and weakened. NOTHINGBUTNITRO chased just off the inside and then along the inside under urging from the seven-sixteenths pole, cornered two to three wide into upper stretch and made no impact.
