MISS NIGHTFALL (GB) settled just off the inside at the tail of the field, came under coaxing with five-sixteenths to go, angled five to six wide into upper stretch, rallied outside rivals to issue a challenge inside the final furlong, seized command a sixteenth out and edged away to the finish under a vigorous hand drive to score. ACCENT (GB) settled tracking the front just off the inside from mid pack, came under coaxing near the quarter pole and angled five wide into upper stretch, rallied to issue a challenge a furlong out, took brief command inside the eighth pole before being displaced a sixteenth from home and ran on to secure the place honors. MAJAZ (GB) tracked the leader in closest aim from the two path, got let out angled four wide into upper stretch, took over command straightened away, dug in under threat and was collared inside the eighth pole, then kept on to preserve the show honors. CANDY MOONSHINE a bit fractious in the gate prior to the start, got coaxed from the gate and showed the way in hand along the inside, came under encouragement with five-sixteenths to run, spun just off the inside into upper stretch under threat and yielded straightened away, then weakened in the late stages. TWO MARTINI'S got brushed at the break by LADY RIVER LILY, tracked the pace along the inside under a ride from the five-sixteenths pole, spun three wide into upper stretch and weakened in the late going. LADY RIVER LILY broke out a step at the start brushing the aforementioned foe, raced a bit rank off heels along the inside past the stands and then unsettled and a bit keen under restraint through the first turn and into the backstretch, settled midway, came under coaxing near the quarter pole and spun three wide into upper stretch, then tired in the drive.

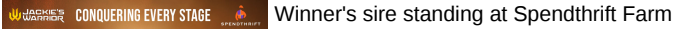

RESCUE DAWN leaned out at the start then was hustled to the front, showed the way off the inside, controlled the action in the two path on the turn, responded well when asked at the quarter-pole, came under a drive in upper stretch and held under steady urging. HEIRSUTA stalked the pace on the outside, made a bid in the three path on the turn, moved to the four path coming to the quarter-pole, chased the winner on the outside in the stretch and was outfinished while clear for the place. SAINTLY VILLAIN was well placed just off the pace, saved ground while asked on the turn, turned into upper stretch under a drive and lacked the needed kick while keeping on to safely secure the show. EIGHT ROSE'S broke out a tad then was hustled, raced under urging while off the pace, dropped back late on the backstretch, moved from the two path to the inside on the turn and improved for the last spot in the superfecta. NORAH BEGORRAH broke a step slow then dropped back, angled in while advancing under urging, moved out in the vicinity of the five-eighths pole, gained in the five path on the turn, chased into upper stretch, dropped back while remaining on her inside lead into the final furlong, swapped to the proper lead outside the sixteenth-pole and tired. READY SET ROLL broke a bit slow, moved up while settling into stride, was roused near the nine-sixteenths pole, steadied outside the half-mile pole and lost some position, saved ground on the turn, came off the rail nearing the quarter-pole, spun into the stretch in the three path and failed to rally. JETSETTER broke a bit slow then bolted towards the outside fence, remained well out in the sealed portion of the track for over a sixteenth of a mile before angling back into the harrowed part of the surface, moved further in while getting closer to the rest late on the backstretch, went around the turn in the two to three path and failed to threaten. TOOKENETTE was forced out at the start and off a half-step slow, raced off the pace under urging, dropped back with five furlongs to run, went around the turn in the six then five path and failed to respond. CALL ME broke out and hit the gate and was off a half-step slow, moved up on the outside under urging, chased in the four path on the turn, moved to the three path coming to the quarter-pole and capitulated. FOURTEEN ROSES broke out at the start, settled off the pace, dropped back leaving the backstretch, was urged along in the three path on

the turn and retreated.

LITTLE THUNDER pressed the pace of TWENTY FOUR MAMBA from the outside five then four paths off the rail down the backstretch and then three wide through the turn, got let out spinning three wide into upper stretch, seized command with three-sixteenths to go, inched away to inside the eighth pole, dug in and gamely got the bob on the wire. TWO EAGLES RIVER chased along the inside and then just off the inside patiently handled until set down angled four wide into upper stretch, dug in under a drive rallying between foes inside the final sixteenth and lost the bob on the line. BARB broke out at the start, chased three to four wide coming under a ride from the three-eighths pole, angled five wide into upper stretch, offered up a mild kick latching on the top pair as they hit the finish. GATE TO WIRE brushed the near side stall at the start, chased just off the inside and then along the inside under urging from three furlongs out, angled six wide into upper stretch and kicked on belatedly to the finish. TWENTY FOUR MAMBA cut the pace from the two path in hand and under pressure from the top one to the outside, came under coaxing spinning just off the inside into upper stretch, yielded the front with three-sixteenths to go and weakened in the late stages. SHARP SWINGER coaxed from the start, chased four wide under a ride with seven-sixteenths to go, went seven to eight wide into upper stretch, weakened. PERFECT FORCE coaxed from the gate, chased five paths off the inside down the backstretch and then just off the inside through the turn under encouragement from three furlongs out, went three to four wide into upper stretch and weakened.

MY LIL ARMY GIRL went to the front then showed the way, raced inside on the turn, responded well when asked at the quarter-pole, remained clear under

a drive into the final sixteenth and just held under strong urging. TICKET TO RIDE made light contact with a foe at the start, settled off the pace, shifted from the inside to the three path on the turn, came into the stretch in the five path, rallied outside into the final furlong, drifted in while gaining approaching the sixteenth-pole and closed well to just miss while narrowly able to get the place. MDTOWN MISCHIEF stumbled at the start but broke at the front, was rated off the pace, rounded the turn in the two path, was roused outside the quarter-pole, spun into the stretch in the three path, steadied some while blocked behind traffic at the three-sixteenths pole, altered out for room outside the eighth-pole, rallied in the final furlong and closed well to just miss while clear for the show. COPPER CADUCEUS broke out and brushed the gate, settled on the far outside, was asked in the four path on the turn, chased under a drive into the final furlong, was carried in nearing the sixteenth-pole then steadied and weakened. DAYLIGHT DREAMER brushed with a rival at the start, settled towards the back, saved ground on the turn, moved out in upper stretch and improved without threatening. SASSY SATS brushed with a rival early, settled between horses, dropped back late on the backstretch, lugged out into the turn and lost position, went around the turn in the three then four path and lacked the needed response. ADROIT was fractious in the gate, hit the outside of the gate lightly at the start, angled in at the rear under urging, went around the turn in the two path, came out to the four path into upper stretch, drifted in around the sixteenth-pole and failed to threaten. YOU KNOW BETTER chased the pace, went around the turn in the three path, dropped back under a drive into the final furlong and tired. QUELL raced well back on the outside, angled in late on the backstretch, stumbled near the seven-sixteenths pole, rounded the turn in the three path, came into the stretch in the five path then was fanned out, bumped with ADROIT inside the three-sixteenths pole and was no factor. LIVELY PAL brushed with a foe early, tracked the pace, went around the turn in the three then two path, was asked outside the quarter-pole, chased into upper stretch and came up empty.
