GOLDEN MERGER settled while saving ground to the first turn, made a steady advance along the rail up the backstretch, checked while in tight and inside of runners into the second turn, re-bid along the rail into the stretch, vied for the lead in the final yards and missed for the win, while besting the rest in a good effort. WHEREDOESTHECASHGO broke out at the start, showed speed and assumed early command, set the pace to the second turn then led into upper stretch, was overtaken in deep stretch and held clearly for third. CERVEZA tracked the early pace three wide, chased into the far turn, was caught in tight while between foes into upper stretch then was outkicked in the late stages. HOLD ME ONLY settled two to three wide into the first turn, advanced up the backstretch and chased four wide heading to the far turn, spun six wide into upper stretch and flattened out. READS PET ZENON settled three to four wide into the first turn, tracked the pace four to five wide up the backstretch, tucked in and chased into the second turn then lacked the needed response late. RYDERS UP settled while saving ground early, dropped back along the backstretch, trailed to the second turn then was eased in the lane and walked off. This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate final time available.
