NINE LIVES ELMER tracked the early pace from the inside, pressed inside of GIULIANO'S SONG into the turn, dueled that rival to upper stretch, dug in through the lane and held well late to prevail. GIULIANO'S SONG showed speed, set the pace from the two path into the turn, met the bid of NINE LIVES ELMER then dueled that foe to upper stretch, was game through the lane but was denied for the win in deep stretch, and just held for the place. WEST IS WEST close up to the early pace while between rivals, chased three wide into the turn, made a sustained rally into the stretch, finished well and just missed for the win and place, while well clear of the rest for the show. YOU N HOW MANYMORE chased the early pace from between rivals, got caught a bit in tight entering the turn and was shuffled back into the bend, ran in pursuit of the leaders nearing the top of the lane, could not find more into upper stretch, gave way in the drive. RINGO forwardly placed in the early running, tracked between rivals into the turn, coaxed two to three wide to the stretch, no late rally. NO MASK REQUIRED squeezed back at the start, coaxed along the inside nearing the top of the stretch, no late rally. KAT'SUNCLEJIMMY chased the early pace from the second flight, ran in pursuit four wide into the turn, lost ground nearing the top of the lane and weakened. DELIGHTFUL RESERVE off slow to begin, advanced while widest into the turn, could not sustain that run to the stretch and dropped back.

EMOTIONAL RUNAWAY close up to the early pace, caught four wide to the first turn, maintained a four wide path to the backstretch, tracked from the second flight then rallied to the far turn, vied for the lead and took command to upper stretch, kept to task through the lane, proved best late. ATTILA STYLE hustled to contest the early pace three wide, took command into the backstretch, showed the way from the inside into the far turn, battled into the lane, was outkicked by the winner into the stretch, held well late for second. OSCAR NIGHT hustled to be prominent early on, chased the pace three wide to the backstretch, pressed two wide and between rivals into the far turn, vied to upper stretch, was outkicked into the lane and just missed for second at the wire, while well clear for third. PLEASIN N TEASIN settled leaving the start, trailed to the backstretch then gained ground into the far turn, continued to advance while saving ground to upper stretch, could not sustain that run to deep stretch and flattened out. KAYCE'S GONNA RIDE broke in at the start and bothered inner rival, hustled to be prominent early, stalked the pace from the inside along the backstretch, chased two then three wide to upper stretch, weakened in the drive. DANJERUS CLOUD was a bit slow into stride away from the start then caught in tight heading to the first turn, settled mid-pack, tracked three wide along the backstretch, chased to the far turn then steadied along that bend, could not find more to upper stretch and gave way. MICHIGA crowded at the start and off a bit slowly, settled in the two path in the early going, chased two wide and between foes into the far turn, spun three to four wide to upper stretch then tired in the drive. FLY BECKY fractious prior to the start, broke alertly, contested the early pace from the inside, lost ground into the backstretch, trailed to the far turn, empty in the late stages.

POQUITO LADY hustled to contest the early pace, engaged with HOTSHOT LUK and pressed that rival from the inside heading into the turn, battled from the inside to upper stretch, was turned away then outkicked in the late stages and held safely for second. RUNAWAY GODDESS off slowly, settled in the early going then advanced along the inside heading to the turn, angled three wide along the bend, chased the leading pair into the stretch, could not reel in those two in the late stages and held safely for third. BONIFIED WILDCAT settled off of the early pace, got shuffled back a bit into the turn, chased from the inside then the two path to upper stretch, no final kick. FLAQUITA broke alertly then ceded the early lead, tracked from the second flight and between rivals heading to the turn, chased three wide to upper stretch, weakened in the drive. SWAYING LASSIE lunged at the start and off slowly, advanced while widest along the backstretch, chased three to four wide into the turn, could not find more to upper stretch and gave way. SCOTTIE JO unhurried in the early running, trailed and lagged to the turn then did not factor in the stretch drive.
