BET U MONEY allowed to settle early on, got caught in tight approaching the quarter pole, shifted out into upper stretch then was unable to make a late impact. HES HIGH OH SILVER pressed the pace two wide and between rivals then gave way in the stretch. LUCKY MONEY disputed the pace three then two wide into the turn, could not keep pace into upper stretch then tired in the drive. SLEEPY EYES well placed in the early stages, stalked the pace from the rail heading to the turn, lacked a response into the stretch and came up empty in the drive. JAZZY RED tracked the early pace from the second flight, chased four then three wide along the turn, stopped in upper stretch, was eased through the lane and walked off under his own power. FEIST tracked the early pace from the second flight, lost action then was pulled up nearing the half-mile pole and was transported off of the track via the equine ambulance.
