RAPPING RUMOR lost his path at the start and was off slowly, trailed into the turn, swung five to six wide into upper stretch and improved position through the lane. BYE BYE RUSS tracked the early pace from the second flight, chased two wide and between runners nearing the quarter marker then lacked the needed response in the stretch. BEETHOVEN J prominent early, pressed the pace from the outside heading to the turn, vied between rivals while two to three wide nearing the quarter marker, was outkicked into upper stretch then weakened in the drive. CHARLIE THYME close up in the early stages, tracked the decent pace while saving ground to the turn, lost position along the bend, could not muster a response into the stretch and gave way. ADIEL sent to assume early command, set a decent pace from the inside heading to the turn, was overtaken into upper stretch then tired in the final furlong. CALL ME HOLLYWOOD allowed to settle early, chased four then five wide nearing the quarter marker then lacked a response in the stretch.
