LEAVE THEM BEHIND sent to assume early command, showed good speed and set the pace to the turn, was pressured along the bend by LET HIM BE, met the bid of that rival into upper stretch then battled to the final sixteenth, yielded to the winner in deep stretch and just held for the place at the wire.
