KING MIANO set a pressured pace early two wide, shook clear and then drew clear on the turn on the inside, drew out leaving the turn and remained well clear to prove much the best under right handed crop urging. RUSSIAN HAMMER tracked the early pace four wide and made a three wide bid on the turn but proved to be no match for the winner while staying on to be second best. DIAMOND MESSA was reserved early between rivals, advanced two to four wide on the turn and came five wide into the lane then won the show battle while failing to gain on the winner. MR JACK tracked the pace two wide and advanced two to three wide on the turn and ranged up four wide off the bend but failed to gain and was out-kicked for the show award while clearly besting the rest. FEDERAL EXCHANGE was off a step slow and settled in the back, two wide on the turn and passed the tiring rivals. MINTENON prompted the early pace from the outside, three to two wide on the turn and weakened in the drive. WALT WHITMAN (IRE) rushed up the inside to press the pace and tracked the pace on the inside on the turn then came up empty in the lane. HAKKIMI (CHI) chased the early pace on the outside, four wide on the turn and

had no rally. PAPA KATZ was reserved early, four to five wide on the turn and angled out in the lane and was not a threat. FAST N STEADY was settled back early and three wide on the turn and was not a factor. AMBULANTE chased the pace between rivals and weakened on the turn and was eased the final furlong, walked off. NO PROBLEM JOE was settled on the inside and dropped back and was eased the final furlong, walked off.

CAPTIVATING SOUND was well placed on the inside, two wide into the lane and then dived back to the rail to make a bid and vie for command by the furlong marker and edged clear to prove best under a drive. SCORED stalked the pace and was in between rivals on the turn, made a three wide bid leaving the turn to vie for command by the furlong marker but was out-kicked by the winner in a game effort. CRYSTAL REIGN vied for the lead on the outside, two wide on the turn and then was in between rivals by the furlong marker and was outfinished. MYA C tracked the pace on the outside and was three to four wide on the turn and faded in the drive. OOPS HAHA was settled early and three wide on the turn and came five wide into the lane and had no rally. JENAS MERCY was reserved early, three wide on the turn and came four wide into the lane and was not a threat. ZIPPY ZINNY was off a step slow and settled in the back early, inside to the two path on the turn and was not a factor. STAR OF SARAH dueled for the lead on the inside and came up empty in the stretch. AMERICAN PEACHES was reserved early and then fell over fallen foe nearing the five furlong marker, walked off. OUR MAGIC PRINCESS was settled

early and clipped heels approaching the five eights marker and fell, was loaded on to the equine ambulance to be evaluated. STEWARDS INQUIRY concerning the incident around the five eights marker, after reviewing the replays the race was left as is.

ACCELERIZE got away alertly and quickly moved clear, gradually shifted in heading up the backstretch while dictating the tempo, continued to set the pace from just off the rail into the turn with rivals in close pursuit, was set down for the drive at the top of the stretch then under vigorous hand-urging, received one mild tap of the crop in upper stretch followed by the rider looking back for competition but finding none, continued to draw away under moderate hand urging followed by just mild riding late. NATIVE ROSE chased the early pace and advanced three wide on the far turn, came four wide off the bend and ran on willingly and drifted out sharply leaving the sixteenth marker under left handed crop and got up in time to prove best. LADY AUTHENTIC stalked the pace three wide and made a two wide bid on the turn and shook clear by the furlong marker but was denied on the wire to just miss. GUM was settled early making way to the inside, two path on the backstretch, advanced two to three wide on the far turn and swung out five wide leaving the turn and rallied well. POWER DANCE chased the early pace towards the inside, two path on the far turn and came three wide into the lane and kept on but needed more. OPEN LANE was settled back early on the inside, cut the corner leaving the turn and angled out in the lane and had a good late rally. CURRANE vied for the lead three wide early, then went on to set the pace and move to the inside, headed leaving the five sixteenths and faded in the lane. CHANNEL CHECK (GB) was reserved on the inside under a

good hold, saved ground on the far turn and swung out four wide leaving the turn and had no significant rally. POR VOCE was reserved early three wide, advanced three to four wide on the far turn and came six wide into the lane but flattened out in the final furlong. PEACHES POINT stumbled 2nd jump out of the gate, reserved early, two wide on the far turn and had no rally and never threatened. EVELYN LOUISE was reserved early on the outside, three wide on the far turn and came four wide into the lane and lacked a rally. EASILY SIDETRACKED was void of early speed, three to four wide on the far turn and swung out six wide leaving the turn and was no factor. GOLD STAMP showed the way and then was rank into the first turn and vied for the lead while being hard to handle, finally settled nearing the five furlong marker while tracking the pace on the inside and saved ground on the far turn and tired.
