LITTLE CARLEY quickly moved to the fore, set the pace from off the rail, shook clear of the nearest pursuer entering the turn, extended the advantage into upper stretch, held sway while being kept to the task. FINAL NOTE settled mid-pack stalking, went two wide into the turn, moved nearer the rail, closed the gap in the stretch but was only second best. PRACTICAL VALE stalked the winner from outside, went three wide on the turn, had no extra for the stretch. HUGE G lunged at the start, moved forward outside going three wide into the turn, floated five to six wide out of that bend, lacked the needed late bid. NOUVEAU RICHE switched out off the rail in the early going, raced well back off the inside, swung seven deep into upper stretch, was never a threat. COSMIC SYMPHONY chased briefly inside, came out four wide at the top of the stretch, was not a factor.

LIZZIE BABY set a pressured pace inside racing on or just off the rail, was headed briefly up the backstretch, retook command before the far turn, edged clear by the top of the stretch, was put to urging and extended the advantage then held safe while being kept to the task late. ANNA JEAN settled off the pace, saved ground near the inside, advanced on the far turn but was in tight lacking room coming to the quarter pole, angled out three wide at the top of the stretch, lugged out in upper- to mid-stretch, finished well to be second best. THUNDER PRINCESS broke outwardly, settled outside off the pace, advanced four to five wide on the far turn, was carried out by a drifting foe in upper stretch, ran on. WINNING SHOT was urged forward from the start, stalked the leading pair three to four wide, lost ground dropping back a bit into the far turn and was encouraged along, floated six wide turning into upper stretch, kept on late to improve position. BAJA DE ORO was reserved at the back, swung seven wide into upper stretch, was never near enough to threaten. SHE STOPPED SHORT stalked from outside, was within range four to five wide into the far turn, flattened out. ENDLESS FASHION prompted the pace two to three wide between, came up empty.

INDULGE settled toward the rear, swung six wide turning for home advancing on the leaders, drifted out through upper stretch, edged past in late stretch under steady handling. BRAGGADOCIOUS settled outside off the pace, advanced four to five wide on the far turn, lugged in past the quarter pole when in front, led till late stretch but was outfinished. ADMIRAL'S WAVE bumped a rival after the start, tracked from inside the second flight mid-pack, edged nearer on the far turn, steadied just slightly when in tight past the quarter pole, ran on inside. ESTILO MAGICO stalked from outside runners, advanced mildly three to four wide on the far turn, steadied slightly at the top of the stretch, failed to menace thereafter. CHASENTHONE was bumped after the break, contested the pace inside runners on or just off the rail, dropped back and faded. KALINBA was prominent three wide into the first turn, taken back off the leading pair, stalked from between runners in the second flight up the backstretch, failed to rally. STREET VENDOR hopped at the start, trailed racing off the inside, was never a threat. FENWICK moved forward outside five then four wide on the first turn, engaged the leader dueling outside two to three wide up the backstretch, dropped back late on the far turn and continued to retreat. FOLLOWING AN OBJECTION BY THE RIDER OF ESTILO MAGICO AGAINST BRAGGADOCIOUS ALLEGING INTERFERENCE AT THE TOP OF THE STRETCH NO ACTION WAS TAKEN.

ETERNAL GLORY was bumped hard after the start, nevertheless moved forward and forced the pace from outside, edged clear midway up the backstretch, was still clear turning for home and lugged out when asked for more with a left-handed use of the crop, switched right-handed by the furlong grounds and straightened out then kept on to hold sway. HOLDER CLOSE settled between runners at the rear early, moved out and advanced outside foes steadily and willingly heading into and on the far turn, struck the lead just past the three-sixteenths, moved clear by mid-stretch and held while being kept to the task. PALACE LIGHTS tracked inside a runner in behind and well back of the early leader, edged closer on the far turn racing in behind, found room on the rail at the top of the stretch, made a mild bid for the lead, kept on and got the nod for place. FAR ABOVE was well-placed between runners about mid-pack into the first turn, edged nearer heading into the far turn, waited briefly seeking room in behind foes then abruptly altered out five wide while rapidly advancing on the leaders navigating the seam, loomed a threat in upper stretch, kept on but needed more and missed second. TERRIE T was a bit hard to load, settled off the pace inside, steadily advanced on the far turn now off the rail, angled out a path at the top of the stretch, loomed a threat in behind in upper stretch but lacked the needed late kick. FOREVER AGAIN was caught four to five wide in the early going stalking the pace into the first turn, dropped back losing position into and on the far turn still wide but kept on in the stretch to regain a better placing. A FANCY SOLUTION was caught four to five wide in the early going while mid-pack, dropped back and shifted in, saved ground on the far turn with much to do but improving and kept on to garner a better finishing position. SUNNYRIDGE JAIME stalked from outside a rival two to three wide early, was still within range coming into the far turn going three to four wide on that bend but weakened after. DOWHATEVERITTAKES settled three to four wide early, made a steady advance on the far turn, checked in behind runners coming to the quarter pole, ran on. FORTUNE DREAMS was caught wide in the early going racing at the back and was never a factor. GAMBI set the pace inside but just off the rail, sped clear early up the backstretch, was overtaken at the top of the stretch having come out a bit further turning for home, faltered and faded. FIREDINI was forwardly-positioned early, chased the loose leader up the backstretch, steadily retreated. ALTHENA was always far back, pulled up in the stretch and transported off the track via equine ambulance.
