MIGGI attended the early pace from off the rail but inside, eased back off the leader and switched outside that one about the five-eighths, advanced willingly now to the outside, took over nearing the three-eighths, edged away through the far turn, was given mild hand urging in upper- to mid-stretch at which point the rider looked back for competition and found none then was eased up late. SECORD moved out off the inside on the first turn, advanced between foes about three wide early up the backstretch, continued to chase from outside swinging five to six deep, was no match for the winner but was clearly second best. WOMANS PEROGATIVE was outpaced early and ridden along near the half well back, saved ground on the far turn, improved position inside. NOBLY brushed a rival lightly at the start, moved forward outside three deep to the lead, dictated the tempo through the first turn and early up the backstretch shifting a bit nearer the rail, was overtaken entering the far turn, weakened in the stretch. FORTUNE DREAMS was bumped at the break, shifted in on the first turn pursuing from mid-pack near the inside, angled eight wide into upper stretch, failed to rally. TRUE HONEY was bumped inward bumping the inside foe hard at the start, was caught four wide on the first turn, dropped back steadily, was not persevered with in the stretch.

SECURITYLIGHTNING attended the pace from outside, lost some ground on the leader in upper stretch and was asked for more at that point, kept on grinding away and edged past the final sixteenth. MADAM PROSECUTOR broke inwardly a bit, was coaxed forward and quickly made the lead, set the pace inside shadowed by rivals, edged clear in upper stretch, weakened a sixteenth out and just saved place. ART NOUVEAU settled off the leaders, advanced outside three to four wide on the turn, kept on in the stretch but missed second. ATOMIC HABITS shifted in entering the turn saving ground on that bend about mid-pack, angled six wide at the top of the stretch, needed more. MT. D'ORO pressed from between the pacesetter and eventual winner for three-eighths, steadily weakened. E COMPLICATO bumped with a foe at the start, moved out racing off the rail on the turn and well back off the leaders, failed to menace. SUNNY MONDAY exchanged a bump at the start, was outpaced.

MISS INTERPATATION chased from outside, went three to four wide on the turn, drifted seven wide coming out of that bend, was engaged in a long drive and kept on to edge past late. WILDCAT MINNY quickly moved clear to set the pace from off the rail, led them into the stretch maintaining a daylight advantage but weakened late and was reeled in nearing the wire. RAN THE RED settled into stride off the leaders, advanced four to five wide on the turn, was carried eight deep turning for home by a drifting foe, ran on evenly late. LADY COLLECTED was bumped into a rival at the start, raced in behind two to three wide, was put to urging past the five-sixteenths but failed to rally. CANTAFIO was bumped and steadied slightly at the start, lacked early speed but soon advanced on the turn forced outside runners five to six wide, shifted inside drifting rivals coming to the top of the stretch, evened out in the lane. LITHICA bumped a rival at the start, chased in behind inside, was asked to keep up nearing the quarter pole but failed to do so.

IT'S A FACT tucked in early saving ground on the first turn, was guided out past the three-quarter, advanced outside four wide on the far turn, fought on in the stretch a bit wider still and got the nod. KARTANO settled well back inside, moved out and was still far back while off the rail on the far turn, rallied four wide in the stretch improving between runners late in a blanket finish. HAPPYISASHAPPYDOES came in a bit at the start but was quick to lead shifting in but setting the pace just off the rail, was challenged leaving the far turn, fought on gamely in the lane but was denied. LUCKY CURLIN settled off the pace racing just off the rail, advanced near the inside late on the far turn, angled out past the quarter pole bothering an outside foe, moved between foes at the top of the stretch.
