STARSHIP TANGO set the pace from off the rail shadowed by an outside foe, turned back that one's bid at the five-sixteenths retaking command by the top of the stretch, faced a new challenger to the outside and now under urging, held that rival at bay while being kept to the task. MIDNIGHT ONYX tracked in behind racing off the rail, moved out turning for home, loomed a threat just off the flank of the winner but could make no headway late. ETERNAL GLORY stalked from outside just off the leaders with good position racing four to five wide, floated a bit wider turning for home, kept on well to secure show honors. SHIPWRECK settled off the pace in the two to three path early, moved nearer the fence cutting the corner into upper stretch, made a mild rally up the rail to improve. MAMA BANNED ME settled at the back tucking in a bit on the first turn but still off the inside, advanced up the backstretch into the far turn, altered out in upper stretch nearing the eighth pole for room, came back in and was bumped lightly late but ran on. COLORS shadowed then pressed the eventual winner from outside racing three to four wide, was encouraged closer past the three-eighths, made a brief bid at the five-sixteenths, dropped back leaving the far turn while drifting out, drifted in through upper stretch, bumped a rival late, lacked the needed late kick. PICCATATA PRINCE bumped a rival at the start, chased from inside near mid-pack early, failed to menace. KOHAKU pursued the leaders from outside four to five wide through th turns, came up empty. BIG TOBY was bumped at the start and in tight soon after along the rail, raced at the back and was not a factor.

BALTASAR advanced outside on the turn, raced four to five wide, struck the lead past the quarter pole, kicked clear in upper stretch, held safe. LIEUTENANT STAN was bumped at the start, settled off the pace racing removed from the rail, swung wider still coming into upper stretch five deep, chased the winner home but was only second best. TEST PILOT switched out off the inside clearing the gap then was forced out a bit further soon after, moved forward taking closer order stalking the leaders, was within range four wide when put to urging coming to the quarter pole but failed to rally. KING MIANO bumped a rival at the start, chased in behind moving out off the inside past the gap, ran on in the lane. CALL ME ICE MAN was urged from the break and soon led, set the pace from off the rail, was overtaken leaving the turn, weakened in the stretch. PAYNTED WARRIOR stalked up close, was three wide through the turn, came up empty. ALL THE RAGE lacked early speed, trailed racing well back and was not persevered with late.

SPARKLING RUBY exchanged a light bump at the start, shifted in early saving ground on the first turn, moved out early up the backstretch and advanced between runners, moved out four to five wide commencing a bid leaving the far turn, took the lead and forged clear under steady handling. MIA VITA stalked just off the pacesetter from outside, advanced willingly on the far turn, bid between runners at the top of the stretch, was no match for the winner but saved the place. CLASSICALS FINALE was unhurried at the back, advanced willingly inside, swung out six deep coming into upper stretch, gained mildly outside late but missed second. KANJENG was a bit rank inside early in behind the leader, finally settled down tracking in behind not too far back, angled five wide turning for home, needed more. ALIEN PRINCESS exchanged a bump at the start, was coaxed to the lead, set the pace, was challenged turning for home, gave way a furlong out. O K TO DANCE was between runners early, raced up close three to four deep up the backstretch and far turn, came up empty. STEP LIGHTLY chased from outside mid-pack, was mostly four to five wide, had no late bid.

MISS MOTTLEY was a bit keen in behind the leading pair and inside runners in the second flight but just off the fence heading up the backstretch, finally settled down bidding time through the far turn into upper stretch, came out a bit finding room between runners with aim on the leader, took over past the eighth pole, held a rival at bay. MRS. KATZ settled off the pace inside saving ground, angled six wide at the top of the stretch, rallied outside but couldn't quite reach the winner while clearly second best. VERIFIABLE exchanged some bumps at the start, made an early advance outside runners up the backstretch five to six deep, moved in a bit in range of the lead on the far turn, kept on evenly in the stretch. VICTORY GIRL was just a bit fractious in the gate, stalked between the second flight racing mostly two to three wide, came out in late stretch and ran on without threatening. HOLDER CLOSE exchanged bumps between runners at the start, raced well back early, fanned eight deep turning for home, was never near enough to threaten. NURSEKRINGLEDANCES exchanged some bumps after the start, moved out and advanced three to five wide up the backstretch, was within range coming into the far turn, dropped back and came up empty.

SKIPPERINI had some minor bumps at the start and was slightly squeezed back then settled into stride while tucking in early, saved ground toward the rear early, advanced willingly still along the inside into and on the far turn, cut the corner into upper stretch, got through inside in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole and edged by to get the nod. MONGOLIAN APPLE moved forward into the first turn pressing from outside two to three wide, prompted the leader before taking over outside the five-eighths, was clear past the half, led them into the stretch racing off the rail, challenged by an inside foe in mid- to late-stretch and outfinished by that one. DENYING settled well back of the leading pair, advanced with others into the far turn saving ground inside, moved out midway on that bend, came into upper stretch five deep, was gaining late. EDDIE THE GREAT settled outside at the rear, advanced while forced outside foes on the far turn, fanned eight deep into upper stretch, drifted in a bit, gained late but needed more. INDY LYON was quickly clear to set the pace but soon found pressure by an outside rival, was overtaken by that one and switched outside leaving the backstretch, went three then four wide on the far turn and into upper stretch, ran on evenly. BURNIN TURF had some minor bumps after the start, was forced three to four wide on the first turn outside rivals, moved up and shifted in a bit early up the backstretch, lost some ground in behind two to three deep on the far turn, moved out just briefly in upper stretch before coming back in for room, ran on evenly near the inside. MORE THAN WORK settled in the back half three to four wide early, was forced wide coming out of the far turn fanning seven deep, ran on mildly. LEO MONTE had some bumps then was squeezed back a bit at the start, settled at the back, saved ground inside through both turns, was guided out past the quarter pole, came into upper stretch seven deep, improved position. DEAR SANTA came in a bit after the start, was forced four to five wide in the early going, floated nine deep into upper stretch, failed to rally. THE BEST DISTANCE had minor bumps after the start, was well-placed for a while in the early going racing mid-pack two to three wide, dropped back and tired.
