QURBAAN D ORO set the pace on the inside and turned back a bid from THUNDER PRINCESS by the quarter pole and shook clear leaving the turn and then held well to the wire to prove best under a drive. BACKSEAT ROMANCE was four wide into the first turn while settled, made a four wide move on the far turn to move into contention, came five wide into the lane and finished well. THUNDER PRINCESS chased the early pace from between rivals on the first turn, moved out and tracked the pace three wide on the backstretch, made a three wide bid nearing the quarter pole to vie for command, kept on willingly to the wire but was outfinished. MICHAELA was reserved early towards the inside, two wide on the far turn and came three wide into the lane and

had a mild late rally. WHEN IN ROMA was four wide into the first turn, stalked the pace three to two wide, made a bid nearing the quarter pole to be in between rivals up on the pace but weakened in the lane. GOONIE was settled towards the inside, then two wide on the backstretch, dropped back to the inside on the far turn but faded in the drive. WEATHER LADY was settled early and on the outside down the backstretch and four to three wide on the far turn and tired. CROSSATI tracked the early pace and then chased the pace three wide and tired. ANNA JEAN was settled back early and three to five wide on the far turn and never factored. SPUN TO PURFECTION chased the early pace on the inside and tired. SUNNY MONDAY checked hard by the wire the first turn and then failed to menace.

ADMIRAL'S WAVE pressed the pace three wide, then was in between rivals on the backstretch, rated back nearing the seven sixteenths and moved out to be three to four wide on the far turn, came five wide into the lane and was put to a long drive and surged late to get up in time to prove best under a drive. LEOPARDI was four wide into the first turn, prompted the pace from the outside, then went up to press the issue four wide on the backstretch, moved in entering the far turn to vie for command two wide by the five sixteenths, then drifted out a tad leaving the quarter pole to come into the lane three to four wide, dueled for command by the furlong marker and gained a short lead in the furlong grounds and led late but was denied to just fail. GUN RIGHT was reserved early on the inside, remained towards the inside on the far turn and angled out in mid stretch and rallied to gain the show award. ESTILO MAGICO set a pressured pace in the two path, then vied for the lead on the inside midway on the far turn, cut the corner leaving the turn and battled for command by

the furlong marker but faded and lost the show award late. DIAMOND MESSA was reserved early three to two wide, advanced towards the inside on the far turn, swung out three wide leaving the turn and made a bid nearing the furlong marker, but was in traffic to the sixteenth marker and moved towards the inside to try to split rivals but hung late. BANDERO chased the pace from in between rivals, four wide by the quarter pole but had no late kick. BOUNTEOUS chased the pace on the outside and was four to five wide on the turn and had no rally. BREATH DEEPLY pressed the pace from the inside and then tracked the pace and moved out to be two wide by the quarter pole and weakened. STREET VENDOR was reserved outside and was not a threat. BRAGGADOCIOUS was rated along the inside and stopped.

TANK pressed the early pace three wide, then was rated back to stalk the leader two to three wide, made a two wide bid on the far turn to gain a short lead by the quarter pole, then repelled the bid from GOOD LONG CRY leaving the turn and kicked clear to prove best, driving. WIN WITH FAITH was bumped after the start, reserved on the inside, advanced two wide on the turn and moved out in the lane and closed well to be second best. GOOD LONG CRY was allowed to settle early, made a four wide move on the far turn and came three wide off the bend to loom boldly but flattened out in the final furlong. KOCTEL WAR set a pressured paced early, then shook clear to set the pace on the inside on the backstretch, headed leaving the five sixteenths and faded in the lane. EMMETT chased the pace and made a mild three wide bid on the far turn but weakened. BOLD N BREEZY was allowed to settle two wide, advanced two to three wide on the turn, came four wide into the lane and had no rally. LATCH THE HATCH tracked the early pace and was on the inside on the far turn and weakened. BLUE CASANOVA was reserved two wide, three wide on the far turn and came five wide into the lane and had no rally.

NOTHINGSUBTLE was settled on the inside and tired.
