SHABAM set the pace under pressure along the inside, cleared on the backstretch, remained unchallenged through the far turn, opened up when asked right handed at the top of the lane, was ridden out to the sixteenth and in hand approaching the wire. FABULOUS CANDY tracked four deep into the first turn then angled to the inside around the bend, moved closer in the middle stages, tipped out on the far turn and took aim three wide turning for home, drifted to the inside through the lane and was no match for the winner while clearly second best. JENAS MERCY stalked in the five then four path early, three deep up the backstretch, chased three, two, then four wide on the second bend and weakened. VIKING QUEEN raced up close six deep then moved into the five path, settled off the pace, rounded the far turn in the four path and failed to menace. BULLET ON TAP also raced up close three deep into the first turn then took a stalking position to the outside of the top pair., chased between foes then suffered a mild shuffle behind CINDY'S SONG in the middle stages, traveled three then two wide around the second bend and lacked a rally. AUGER broke a step slow, stalked the top pair inside rivals, came under a ride but had to wait for room at the quarter pole behind the leader, gained a clear path and launched a bid from the fence, took over midstretch and inched ahead from outer rivals in the late stages. LITIGANT shifted out and bumped leaving the gate, stalked three deep to the turn, crept closer still in the three path on the bend, challenged from outside past the quarter pole, fought three deep in the furlong grounds and got outkicked by the winner. TOP RECRUIT dueled from inside, cleared MAKIZAN at the five-sixteenths pole, met the bid from LITIGANT late on the bend, resisted to midstretch, then relinquished the lead to AUGER and got outkicked for the place honors. MAKIZAN bumped with ARAK at the start, went up to duel from outside, could not kick on with the leader midway around the bend, chased in the two path approaching the stretch and weakened. JOHN'S PROMISE chased from off the rail, got shuffled back to last near the three-eighths pole, angled to the rail then steered back out late on the turn, spun three wide into the lane and lacked a rally. ARAK got pinballed and pinched back at the start, trailed early then went outside a rival, traveled three wide through the turn, moved out at the top of the lane and could not overcome the rough start. DESANTIS stalked between rivals, lost ground in the two path then found the rail on the turn and weakened down the lane. THE RIDER OF ARAK LODGED A CLAIM OF FOUL AGAINST THE RIDER OF MAKIZAN AT THE START. FOLLOWING A REVIEW, NO CHANGE WAS MADE.

LOW KEY IN LOVE brushed with outer rival at the start, tracked in the two path, launched a bid three deep then fought on even terms outside the leader leaving the bend, put a head in front in upper stretch, cleared approaching the sixteenth pole and padded the margin late. ELITE HEAT (GB) stepped to the front and moved inside, took pressure from ENCHANT on the far turn, put that rival away on the far turn but was quickly challenged by LOW KEY IN LOVE, dueled with that rival to the stretch, lost command outside the eighth pole, was no match for the winner in the late stages but stayed on for a clear second. SHARE REPURCHASE stalked along the fence, got boxed in around the second bend, failed to produce a bid once in the clear and managed to hold third. MISHKA settled off the pace and moved inside, crept closer while angling three wide on the far turn, lacked a rally down the stretch and failed to get by SHARE REPURCHASE for third. MR. SWEETS showed the way under pressure from a pair of rivals to the turn, dueled with MY PAL MAX around the bend and into the lane, put that rival away midstretch and stayed clear to the wire. MY PAL MAX pressed three deep to the three-eighths pole, moved up on even terms outside MR. SWEETS around the bend, fought to the eighth pole, then could not match strides with the winner midstretch, drifted in late and held second. WE CALLED SOL chased from inside, dropped out of range on the turn, cut the corner into the lane, finished well along the fence but had his path taken by MY PAL MAX and had to check late. HIGHS N LOWS away quickest then pressured the leader from the between rivals, could not stay with the top pair past the three-eighths pole but remained in range two then three wide to the stretch and weakened. THE RIDER ABOARD WE CALLED SOL LODGED AN OBJECTION AGAINST MY PAL MAX FOR ALLEGED INTERFERENCE LATE IN THE STRETCH. THERE WAS ALSO A STEWARDS INQUIRY INTO THE SAME INCIDENT. FOLLOWING A REVIEW, THE STEWARDS RULED THERE WOULD BE NO CHANGE.

KEEN SURGE was off a bit slow from the far outside, sat off the pace in the two path, advanced 4deep on the second bend, closed into the final furlong, ducked in then back out near the sixteenth pole and got up in the final moments. AMERICAN WIND took control early and moved inside, felt some early pressure then cleared around the first turn, took pressure from rivals late on the backstretch, kicked clear once more around the far turn, corned nicely into the lane, padded the lead in upper stretch, led well clear into deep stretch but got run down by the winner. BLUE SKY'S SYL broke a step slow, traveled

three then two wide around the first turn, moved into range on the backstretch, chased four wide into the second bend, angled down to the two path then spun three wide into the lane, showed a mild response to move into the third and had to steady behind an erratic KEEN SURGE in deep stretch. OCEAN SOUL pressed from outside early then stalked in the two path around the clubhouse turn, was closest in pursuit up the backstretch, put in a mild bid at the seven-sixteenths pole, failed to keep up with the leader, got crowded along the rail midway around the bend, kept on down the lane and rounded out the superfecta. MUCHOMACHOMAC trailed in the two path into the clubhouse turn then went outside a rival, made a middle move outside rivals up the backstretch, chased three then two wide around the far turn and weakened. DOMINATOR C. tracked between rivals or in the two path, got shuffled back around the far turn and could not rally. NOBLE HERO broke a step slow, tracked from off the rail, drew closer four deep on the backstretch, bid three deep approaching the far turn, could not sustain the challenge and angled to the rail chasing around the far turn, then flattened out in the stretch. kADAR INDY reserved early along the inside, moved into range on the backstretch, chased three deep between foes into the far turn, lost ground and spun four wide into the stretch and came up empty in the drive. STOW ON THE WOLD stalked the pace along the fence, got crowded and shuffled back on the far turn and faded in the lane. VITTORIANO traveled along the inside near the back, trailed up the backstretch, continued at the rear around the far turn, eased in the lane and walked off.

AURELIA'S MISCHIEF broke a step slow, chased three deep between foes, went four then three wide around the turn, angled out and bumped CHOSEN FACTOR entering the lane, chased within striking distance in the final furlong but finished evenly late. CHOSEN FACTOR tracked four deep, went five wide into the turn, moved into the four path around the bend, got bumped and pushed out into the lane, kept trying down the stretch but needed to find more. PERKY bumped leaving the gate, tucked inside at the back of the pack, picked up the stride in the middle stages while moving off the fence, angled out around the bend, swung five wide into the lane, challenged in upper stretch, dueled with NOTABLE EXCHANGE and disposed of that rival in deep stretch. wide into the lane and weakened. MAGICAL MARRIAGE stalked along the fence, hugged the rail to the stretch and lacked a rally. I'M ON FIRE stalked in the two path, chased between rivals, had to wait two then three wide on the far turn, got crowded a bit at the eighth pole and failed to rally. TATANKA dueled from outside then pressed the leader in the early going, moved up on even terms again leaving the backstretch, fought between runners through the far turn, yielded in upper stretch and weakened.
