DELIGHTFUL DIXIE attended the pace three deep to the turn, dueled from outside with a quarter mile remaining, put a head in front in upper stretch, drove clear midstretch and was kept busy to the wire. THEE NEW BEGINNING dueled inside LOVIELEE to the turn, inched head from a pair of rivals on the turn, dueled with DELIGHTFUL DIXIE at the quarter pole, yielded to that rival midstretch and stayed on to secure second. EUPHIMA (ARG) stalked the top trio from inside, came off the fence a bit entering the lane, finished willingly through the final furlong but failed to get by THEE NEW BEGINNING for second. GO GO STAR chased outside rivals or four wide into the turn, coaxed along while moving into the three path around the bend and could not produce a bid down the lane. CHILLING FACTOR sat off the pace in the early going keeping off the rail, angled into the two path early on the bend, steered back out and came four wide into the stretch but failed to threaten from there. LOVIELEE dueled outside a rival while between foes early, fought to the five-sixteenths pole, yielded to the top pair with a quarter mile remaining and faded down the lane. TRIPLET stalked outside a rival into the turn, got shuffled behind a weakening LOVIELEE on the turn while boxed in with nowhere to go, finally angled to the inside for a clear path and had little left for the stretch run. WHISPERING SEA lacked early quickness, trailed well off the rail then angled into the two path early on the turn, came back out to race four wide into the lane and was never a factor.

H C HOLIDAY dueled from inside, vied with outer rivals around the far turn, carried a short lead into the stretch, dueled with FORT CHARLES down the lane and gamely prevailed. FORT CHARLES hopped slightly at the start, trailed two wide approaching the first turn then angled out around the bend, ranged up four deep on the far turn, battled outside H C HOLIDAY through the stretch, could not get by but finished gamely in defeat. MISSION KEY rated along the inside behind the dueling pair, coaxed along still next to the fence on the far turn, tried to sneak through inside the leader but lacked clearance entering the lane, kept to task down the stretch and held third. CLASSIC KING stalked between rivals early, asked two wide on the second bend and could not produce a bid. FUNKENSTEIN was rank outside a pair of rivals early, chased three wide then outside a rival in the middle stages, asked still in three path on the second bend, trailed into the stretch and improved position. REDISUR broke a step slow, stalked four wide into the first turn then three deep, challenged the top pair from outside on the far turn, failed to keep up leaving the bend and weakened down the lane. TONY SMALL broke a step slow on the outside, went up to duel for command with inner rival, fought to the quarter pole, then yielded approaching the stretch and also weakened. BREADMAN got put in tight between rivals entering the first turn, tracked two wide then became a bit rank early, moved inside while dropping back in the middle stages and lacked a rally.

JUNTA was closest in pursuit three then two wide on the first turn, was keen to go on and went up to duel for command and put a head in front on the backstretch, battled two wide through the far turn before shaking free from IT'S WITCHCRAFT with a quarter mile remaining, opened up at the top of the lane and remained well clear under hand urging. IT'S WITCHCRAFT sprinted to the front from inside, showed the way in the two path then along the rail around the first turn, dueled with JUNTA up the backstretch, fought along the fence through the far turn but could not keep up with the winner at the quarter pole, came off the rail chasing into the stretch and held second. QUEEN IN THE DECK stalked the speed from inside, moved into the two path around the far turn, steered back inside in the stretch and lacked further response. NATIVE ROSE chased three wide and started to pull on the first turn, tugged the rider forward up the backstretch, chased two then three wide on the second bend and weakened. CLASSICALS FINALE went two wide into the first turn and dropped back off the pace while moving inside around the bend, trailed next to the fence on the far turn and failed to make an impact.

TOO HOT TO STOP showed early foot in the two path inside rivals into the first turn then took a stalking position between rivals, traveled three deep up the backstretch, bid three deep on the far turn, took over at the quarter pole, drifted into the stretch and held safely. CLASSIC BALLAD vied in the three path into the first turn then stalked three deep around the bend, was closest in pursuit early on the backstretch, challenged from outside at the half-mile pole, took over midway around the far turn but relinquished the lead to the winner at the quarter pole, stayed in range into the final furlong and came back on to whittle the gap late. SHAMU tracked along the inside, suffered a mild shuffle early on the backstretch, drew closer along the fence, angled out on the second bend, spun five wide into the lane, lacked a bid but was able to hold the show. WONDERFULVENEZUELA got put in a bit tight between rivals into the first turn, angled down to the inside while dropping off the pace, started to gain on the far turn but had to pause behind a rival, gained an opening and continued on from the fence, stayed on the inside through the lane and produced a mild rally to round out the superfecta. UPSTREET vied in the six path into the first turn then angled down to the two path dueling outside a rival, cleared early on the backstretch, took pressure at the half-mile pole, lost command midway around the far turn, started to weaken leaving that bend and flattened in the drive. MYA C tracked two wide around the first turn and had to pause behind a rival late on the bend, continued a bit off the rail through the second turn and weakened. ALMA PURA tracked in the four path early, raced outside a rival on the backstretch while out of range, chased three deep turning for home and had little left for the stretch run. FUTURE FORTUNE vied five wide into the first turn then angled over to the rail, took a stalking position early on the backstretch then followed between rivals, lost ground while angling out on the far turn, came five wide into the stretch and faded. TOURIST STYLE trailed in the three path on the clubhouse turn, went two wide around the second bend, angled out

approaching the stretch and was never a factor.

HEAVEN RULES raced up close on the inside, ridden along through the turn, put to the left hand at the top of the stretch and outfinished TWIZZLE for second. TWIZZLE pressed the pace between foes to the turn, chased after the leader in the two path around the bend, finished willingly down the lane but got outkicked for the place honors. SUMMER'S COMIN lost her path at the start,

chased from off the pace to the turn, gained along the fence then tipped to the two path late on the bend, ran into traffic behind a trio of rivals in upper stretch, tipped out into the clear and kept on for a minor award. MISCHIEVOUS HAN unhurried from the far outside, traveled in the three path into the first turn, drew closer from outside up the backstretch, came with a four deep move on the far turn to take over at the quarter pole, emerged clear approaching the stretch, was ridden out into the final sixteenth and won going away. AUTHENTIC HONOUR stalked the pace early while moving to the fence, took over early on the backstretch, vied inside rivals past the half-mile pole, lost command with a quarter mile remaining, could not kick on with the winner in to the stretch, kept trying down the lane and bested the rest. GRAND LIAM sat off the pace in the two path before finding the rail, pulled the rider forward between runners on the backstretch, got blocked from the seven-sixteenths pole to the three-eighths marker, tipped four wide for a clear path, kept on down the lane and gained third. COW CREEK KID raced up close three deep, bid five, four then three deep in the middle stages, fought three deep to the quarter pole and folded. NEOTERIC got bumped hard from outside leaving the gate, went up to duel from inside, inched ahead around the clubhouse turn, took hold early on the backstretch and dropped back between rivals, went two wide

around the far turn and could not rally. PALACE REVOLT reluctant loading into the gate, followed three deep out of range then moved into the two path around the clubhouse turn, drew closer three deep between rivals on the backstretch but got shuffled back at the half-mile pole, had to pause behind a rival near the three-eighths marker and could not make an impact down the lane. ITS JUST MATH got knocked into inner rival in the beginning, chased in the two path, bid between foes on the backstretch, got outkicked into the far turn, started to weaken around the bend and faded. NORA'S FIREBALL allowed to settle next to the rail in the early going, was coaxed into a close up position on the backstretch, lost ground through the second bend and came up empty in the drive. TRAFALGAR'S HERO veered in and bumped at the start, dueled from outside, vied four, three, then two wide on the backstretch, fought between foes on the far turn and folded. WAR FIRE broke a step slow and lost a clear path leaving the gate, trailed in the early going and never got involved.

ATTRAYANT stalked in the two path, raced up close three deep between in the middle stages, fought three deep around the far turn, carried a short lead in the four path into the lane, relinquished the lead back to MAX SWAGGER while continuing to battle into the final furlong and also weakened in deep stretch. PHRASEOLOGISM settled off the pace, went four then five deep while drawing closer on the far turn, went three deep into the second bend, spun five wide into the lane, lacked room in upper stretch and could not rally. NOBLE STAR unhurried in the beginning, traveled three deep into the first turn then moved forward four deep leaving the bend, fought four deep around the far turn and in the five path coming into the stretch, battled to midstretch then weakened in the last sixteenth. IMMENSE FAITH raced up close to the outside of the pacesetter, applied pressure on the backstretch, vied between rivals on the far turn, could not kick on with the leaders in upper stretch and weakened. FAKE CELEBRITY traveled along the rail inside a rival at the back, saved ground through the far turn as well and could not make an impact. GRAND PARK VIEW raced outside FAKE CELEBRITY at the back, went two wide around the far turn before angling out approaching the stretch and was never a factor.
