ROZAY SUMMER stalked the early pace on the outside, made a three wide bid nearing the quarter pole, took over leaving the turn and drew out in the final furlong to prove best under mild pressure. LADYS CHANT was well placed on the inside, saved ground to the quarter pole and eased out came three wide into the lane and finished willingly to be clearly second best. LAUGHINTOTHEBANK was allowed to settle on the inside, eased out leaving the five sixteenths and came six wide into the lane, then was up for the show award. SPECIAL AFFAIR stumbled badly at the start, settled on the outside on the first turn and advanced on the backstretch, three to four wide on the far turn and faded in the lane. NUMERIC set the pace while in the two path, dropped to the inside on the far turn and weakened in the final furlong. SHINING SKYE was settled three wide on the first turn, dropped to the inside on the far turn and swung out three wide leaving the turn but weakened. VINO VELOCE was reserved early and failed to respond.

TIZ A BEAST was well rated towards the inside, eased out on the turn and came five wide into the lane, was put to a .long drive and surged late to get up to prove best. LEOPARDI vied for the lead two to three wide and ran on to the wire but was out-kicked late to just fail. BRAGGADOCIOUS was four wide into the first turn, tracked the pace from the outside, four wide on the far turn and came six wide into the lane and rallied but needed more. ESTILO MAGICO vied for the lead on the inside and dug in gamely in the lane but faded late. BREATH DEEPLY was bumped at the break, tracked the pace three to four wide, three path on the far turn and then was in between rivals leaving the turn and was a bit in tight, angled in to the inside by the three sixteenths and weakened.

GHOST STALKER was settled three wide early, dropped to the inside on the far turn and weakened. POLITICAL RIOT stalked the pace four to three wide and tired on the far turn. BRYCE CANYON was reserved on the inside and failed to menace.

LAMPLIGHTER JACK was hard held early to be reserved on the inside, advanced towards the inside and was two wide by the quarter pole, angled out by the furlong marker and finished well to be clearly second best. JUSTINTIMEFORWINE prompted the pace three wide, then went up to vie for command two wide on the far turn and was in between rivals nearing the quarter pole and faded in the lane while saving the show award. ESCAPE KEY was settled early making way to the inside, advanced two to three wide on the far turn and came four wide into the lane and had a mild late rally. UNSPOKEN REQUEST chased the pace four to three wide, then was three to four wide on the far turn and came five wide into the lane and weakened. MIDNITE MUSKET set a pressured pace two wide, then vied for command on the inside on the far turn and weakened in the drive.
