MY FINE AQUILINE was well placed behind the vying leaders two wide, made a three wide bid leaving the turn and took over nearing the furlong marker and drew off to prove much the best while under crop urging. TARIBA DREAM was rated between rivals on the first turn, two wide on the far turn and was along for the place award while no match to the winner. CAJUN GAL vied for the lead three wide and made a two wide bid to gain a short lead approaching the quarter pole, then was headed by the winner leaving the turn and came up empty in the final furlong losing the place award late while besting the rest. WINNING SHOT was off a step slow and chased the pace from the inside and weakened. WALL STREET MAGIC vied for the lead on the inside and gave way the final quarter of a mile. TO MUCH STYLE stumbled at the break, recovered and tracked the leaders four wide on the first turn, continued on the outside and was three to four wide on the far turn and tired. CHICA CATHOLIC chased the pace on the outside and stopped and was eased late, walked off.

MADAM PROSECUTOR stalked the leader three to four wide, made a four wide bid to go on even terms for command by the quarter pole, roused nearing the furlong marker and drew clear while drifting in, switched to left handed crop urging in the furlong grounds and widened the margin to prove much the best. IHAVEISSUES showed good early speed to set the early pace while clear and racing off the inside, three path on the turn and was headed nearing the quarter pole, relented the lead nearing the furlong marker and could not go with the winner in the final furlong while keeping on to be clearly second best. MY LITTLE WILDCAT chased the early pace on the inside, moved to the two path on the turn and came three wide into the lane and had no rally while besting the rest. LA VECCHIA SIGNORA chased the early pace two wide and dropped to the inside on the turn and weakened. TAPIT SMILES was settled early while moving to the outside, four wide on the turn and was not a threat, got loose pulling up but was caught and walked off.

PEACHES POINT was a bit fractious in the gate, unhurried early towards the inside, saved ground on the far turn to b=nearing the quarter pole and moved out and then swung out six wide leaving the turn and made a bid to be clear leaving the sixteenth marker and then remained clear to the wire to prove best in a measured margin. PRETTY THING (IRE) prompted the early pace three wide, then went up to vie for command two wide, made a three wide bid leaving the turn to gain a short lead, was outfinished by the winner while saving the place award gamely. ACT VIOLENTLY was settled early on the inside while throwing a head a bit, then moved out to be two wide on the backstretch, advanced two to three wide on the far turn, came four wide and loomed boldly but was out-kicked while just missing the place award and clearly besting the rest. PRINCESS HONOR set the pace pace making way to the inside, then vied for command on the backstretch and onto the far turn, cut the corner leaving the bend and weakened in the final furlong. WILLFUL ROSE tracked

the pace from the inside and swung out three wide leaving the turn and weakened. WEATHER LADY tracked the early pace from between rivals into the first turn, then three wide on the backstretch and to the far turn and tired. YLANA was reserved early towards the inside, inside to the two path on the far turn and had no rally. WILD PRINCESS chased the pace from the outside, four wide on the far turn and stopped.
