

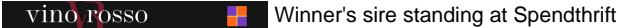

MISS INTERPATATION set the pace and was in the two path on the turn while being well handled, came off the bend two to three wide and dug in determinedly and held on gamely to prove best under a drive. UNBRIDLED PEACE prompted the pace and made a three wide bid leaving the turn but hung in the final furlong while being second best. SECURITYLIGHTNING tracked the pace along the inside and cut the corner leaving the bend but needed more while saving the show award. DEETZ was rated along between rivals, two path on the turn and came two wide into the lane but had no kick while just missing the show award. MADAM MITOLE broke outwardly at the start, tracked the pace on the outside and was four wide on the turn but lacked the needed winning bid. PRAYED FOR GIRL was settled early, three to four wide on the turn and came six wide into the lane and had no rally.

ATOMIC HABITS bumped with MAMAS LULLABYE at the break, advanced on the inside and eased out on the turn and came three to four wide into the lane, was sent down and surged late to get up late to prove best. STARFALL tracked the pace and made a three wide bid in hand to gain a short lead leaving the quarter pole, then was clear by the furlong marker but was caught in deep stretch while holding on to the place award. JAANTJE was squeezed back at the start, settled early, advanced three to four wide midway on the turn, moved in leaving the quarter pole and finished well up the inside. MAMAS LULLABYE bumped at the break, set the pace on the inside and drew out by the three eighths marker but was headed leaving the quarter pole and weakened in the drive. PIGEON CAY was reserved early on the outside, moved in to be three to two wide on the turn and then improved position in the lane. BONITA DIAMOND chased the pace and made a four wide move on the turn but weakened. ALGEBRAINTHEDARK chased the early pace and tired. REIGN IN MY HEART was a bit fractious in the gate, bumped at the break and chased the early pace three wide and stopped.

BELOUNI (FR) was allowed to settle two wide under a nice hold, dropped to the inside on the far turn and inched clear leaving the five sixteenths and moved out by the quarter pole and made a three wide bid leaving the turn to go on even terms for command with his barn mate by the furlong marker, then was given one tap left handed and gained a short lead and then one pop again left handed by the sixteenth marker to edge clear under confident handling. EXACT ESTIMATE set the early pace while clear and under a good hold, was well handled throughout and came two wide off the bend and was confronted by the winner, dug in gamely and fought on to the wire but was out-kicked while clearly second best. IT CAN BE DONE tracked the early pace in between rivals into the first turn, then prompted the pace two wide by the half mile marker and onto the far turn, came three to four wide off the bend and could not go with the top two while staying on to best the rest. PALAZZI was three wide into the first turn, moved to the inside and saved ground on the far turn and improved in the lane on the inside. NINJA STAR tracked the early pace on the inside, moved out and was three to four wide on the far turn, came five wide into the lane and weakened. OISHI was settled back early and lacked a rally. BENVOLIO bobbled at the break, chased the pace on the outside, four to five wide on the turn and came six wide into the lane but tired.

EDDIE THE GREAT was settled two wide early, advanced four wide by the quarter pole, came five wide into the lane and made a bid to vie for command by the furlong marker, led late and then held off the fast closing NOBLE FACTOR to prove best under a drive. NOBLE FACTOR was reserved early on the inside, coaxed along on the far turn and moved off the inside and swung out four wide leaving the turn, moved out in the furlong grounds and closed fast to just miss. KANSAS CAT (ARG) was bumped at the break, settled on the inside, ridden along and made a three wide bid by the quarter pole, vied for command in between rivals by the furlong marker, fought on to the sixteenth marker but was out-kicked late. OSKAR MARTINEZ (IRE) was well rated along the inside, made a two wide bid leaving the turn to gain a short lead and then vied for command by the furlong marker but faded late. DENYING was

reserved early, two to three path on the far turn, came five wide into the lane and had a mild late kick. UNCLE TRULY was reserved early, advanced four wide on the far turn, angled in leaving the quarter pole to be on the inside in the lane but needed more. SESAME SEED BAGEL bumped at the start, then vied for the lead on the inside and then set the pace and shook clear on the backstretch, headed by the quarter pole and weakened in the lane. BIG Z OG vied for the early lead three wide into the first turn, then tracked the leader two wide and tired the final quarter of a mile. PEACE NOT WAR was settled early, advanced three to five wide on the far turn, came widest into the lane and had no late kick. SPECIALAGENTJONSON was off slowly and trailed throughout.
